TRITON UPDATES

TRITONS SET FOR 13TH STRAIGHT CCAA CHAMPIONSHIP: UCSD's come-from-behind, 3-2 victory at Cal State East Bay last Friday night clinched outright an 11th California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) South Division title in 13 years. Having concluded the regular season, next on the schedule this week is a 13th straight CCAA Championship appearance since joining the conference for the 2000 season. UCSD will travel to Carson on Wednesday, hold one 55-minute training session on Thursday at 11 a.m., attend the annual CCAA Championship banquet that night at 6:30 p.m. on the eve of their semifinal match-up as the third seed against second-seeded Cal State Stanislaus on Friday, Nov. 2. Kickoff at Toro Stadium is set for 1:30 p.m. The first semifinal, pitting top-seeded Sonoma State and fourth seed Cal Poly Pomona, will begin at 11 a.m., with the winners facing off for the 2012 CCAA crown at 12:30 p.m. on Sunday, Nov. 4. The Tritons are making a second trip to Carson this year, after a 3-1 win over tournament host Cal State Dominguez Hills there back on Oct. 14.

WHAT'S AT STAKE: The winner of Sunday's CCAA Championship final earns automatic entry into the 2012 NCAA Championship. The 48-team NCAA Division II Championship field will be announced the day after the CCAA final, on Monday, Nov. 5, at 4:30 p.m. PT. UCSD has made seven consecutive NCAA Championship tournaments and 11 of 12 since moving up from Division III to Division II.

CCAA CHAMPIONSHIP HISTORY: The Tritons will be in search of their eighth CCAA title this weekend in Carson, with the last one coming in 2008. UCSD is 13-3-3 over its 12 previous appearances at the event. The Tritons have been eliminated in the semifinal round of each of the past three CCAA tournaments, all in Turlock, with the first two via penalty-kick tiebreakers, since that most recent 2008 success in La Jolla. They are 4-2 in four previous installments in Carson, lifting the trophy there in 2000 and 2003 to book-end UCSD's run of four straight tourney titles after first joining the CCAA for the 2000 season.

CCAA CHAMPIONSHIP TICKETS: Single-day tickets for the 2012 CCAA Championship are \$8 for general admission, \$5 for students and seniors and \$2 for children under the age of 12. Two-day tournament passes are \$15 for general admission, \$8 for students and seniors and \$3 for children under 12. A family pass can also be purchased for \$25 for a two-day admission for two adults and two children.

CCAA CHAMPIONSHIP COVERAGE: All games of the 2012 CCAA Championship will have both streaming video and live stats available, free of charge with no registration required, for fans and families unable to make the trip to Carson. A live video feed for Friday's semifinal at 1:30 p.m., with no commentary, and a full Internet TV broadcast of Sunday's final at 12:30 p.m. should the Tritons advance, can be accessed via the women's soccer Schedule/Results page at UCSDtritons.com. The video feeds are courtesy of the Toro Sports Network, with David Smock (play-by-play) and Jim San Martin (analyst) on the call Sunday beginning at 12 p.m. with the CCAA Today pregame show. For live stats, fans can click on Live Stats under the Fan Zone tab off the front page at UCSDtritons.com.

RANKINGS REPORT: The Tritons moved back into the NSCAA/Continental Tire national poll this Tuesday following a pair of road wins over the weekend, now up to No. 13. CCAA North Division champion Sonoma State also moved back into the poll at No. 7, with UCSD's Friday opponent, Cal State Stanislaus, down from No. 8 to No. 25 this week. Regionally, UCSD remained in third in Wednesday's third release of the all-important NCAA West poll, with the top six sides earning one of 48 berths into the 2012 NCAA Division II Championship. Sonoma State and Seattle Pacific are first and second, with Cal Poly Pomona fourth and Stanislaus fifth. The NSCAA/Continental Tire West poll has UCSD in second, behind Sonoma State and ahead of Seattle Pacific and Stanislaus. Cal Poly Pomona is sixth.

MS. OCTOBER IZZY POZURAMA: Forward Izzy Pozurama completed an incredible October with two more goals, both game-winners, in a pair of road victories last weekend. She now shares the team lead of eight goals scored on the year with fellow sophomore Cassie Callahan. Each goal has come over the past seven matches since Oct. 7, with all of them coming in six victories as UCSD has gone 6-1 over its last seven. Four of Pozurama's eight goals were of the game-winning variety in those six triumphs. The Lake Forest product has a pair of two-goal performances during this run. Pozurama earned the team's only Wilson/CCAA Player of the Week recognition for 2012 on Oct. 15.

BRODSKY DOING WONDERS IN NET: The Tritons have not missed a beat following the departure to graduation of two-time All-American goalkeeper and 2011 CCAA Most Valuable Defensive Player Kristin Armstrong, thanks to the play of Kelcie Brodsky. The true freshman out of Agoura Hills has started all 17 games thus far and posted league-leading numbers of a 0.51 goals-against average and .886 save percentage. Her goals-against average ranks her 10th in the nation in the NCAA Division II, and first among freshmen.

2012 TOURNAMENT FIELD OVERVIEW: UCSD has gone 2-1-1 this season against the three other participants of the 2012 CCAA Championship. The Tritons have a pair of wins over South foe Cal Poly Pomona (1-0 at home, 5-1 in Pomona), which were followed by a scoreless draw at then-13th-ranked Sonoma State on Oct. 5, and a 1-0 home defeat to then-No. 20 Cal State Stanislaus on Oct. 19. UCSD is an unbeaten 8-0-1 outside of La Jolla so far on the year.

SCOUTING THE WARRIORS: Cal State Stanislaus (15-3, 11-3 CCAA) was the North runner-up behind Sonoma State after dropping a narrow 2-1 decision at home to the Seawolves last Sunday in what was effectively the North title match. The Warriors, who earned their first CCAA crown a year ago in Turlock, are led for the third year in a row by junior forward Karenee Demery, a two-time All-American and three-time Wilson/CCAA Player of the Week this season following each of three hat tricks. While leading the league with 18 goals scored and 39 points, she also is tied for first nationally in Division II in goals. Emily Relles, herself a junior, has provided a single-season program-record and CCAA-leading 12 assists. Senior Millie Brown (0.99 GAA, 61 saves, eight shutouts) is the Warrior goalkeeper. Gabriel Bolton is in his eighth season as the Cal State Stanislaus head coach.

SERIES HISTORY: UCSD is 10-3-1 all-time against the Warriors, including 0-1 at the CCAA Championship. That one tournament loss came a year ago, in fact, a 2-1 decision in a semifinal in Turlock, with Stanislaus going on to its first conference crown two days later, 4-0 over Chico State.

SCOUTING THE SEAWOLVES: Sonoma State (15-2-1, 11-2-1 CCAA) claimed its first CCAA North Division title since 2008 with that 2-1 win at Cal State Stanislaus last Sunday, getting goals from Ashley Martin and Shayla Mellenthin. The top-seeded Seawolves are led offensively by junior forward Cara Curtin, who ranks only behind Stanislaus' Demery in the conference in goals (13) and points (32). Senior goalkeeper Alexis Sciacqua is second to UCSD's Kelcie Brodsky with a 0.54 goals-against average. Emiria Salzmann Dunn is in her second year at the helm.

SERIES HISTORY: UCSD is an undefeated 15-0-2 all-time against the Seawolves, including 2-0 at the CCAA Championship. The Tritons edged Sonoma State, 1-0, to lift their first CCAA trophy in 2000, and also took a semifinal meeting by that same score in 2003. Both matches were in Carson.

SCOUTING THE BRONCOS: Cal Poly Pomona (10-4-3, 8-4-3 CCAA) placed second behind UCSD in the CCAA South. The Broncos are unbeaten over their last 11, completing the regular season on an 8-0-3 tear following a 2-4 start to achieve their first postseason qualification since 2004. Junior midfielder Samantha Stiles tops the team's goals chart with seven, while senior Cindy Paez has seven assists. Isabelle Harvey is in her seventh season in charge of Cal Poly Pomona.

SERIES HISTORY: UCSD is 31-9-4 all-time against the Broncos, including 2-0 at the CCAA Championship. The Tritons knocked off Cal Poly Pomona on the way to each of their first two CCAA crowns in 2000 (2-1 in OT in semis in Carson) and in 2001 (2-0 in final in La Jolla). They have won eight straight going back to 2008.

WRITE THEM IN INK: Senior defenders Hayley Johnson and Ellen Wilson have each started all 84 games that UCSD has played since they stepped foot onto the La Jolla campus. Johnson has generally played at left back, with Wilson a center back in head coach Brian McManus' traditional three-defender alignment. Alongside forward Gabi Hernandez, the three fourth-year seniors are tri-captains this season. Wilson is the only Triton to have played every minute in 2012. She has led UCSD field players in minutes played in each of her four years.

JOHNSON ON ASSISTS CHART: Hayley Johnson is now up to fifth place on the program's all-time assists list, with 31 over her stellar four-year career. She is tied for third on the team in 2012 with four assists after back-to-back team-leading double-figure season totals of 10 in 2010 and 14 in her All-America 2011 campaign. Earlier this year, Johnson passed current UCSD assistant coach and former Triton All-American Kristin Jones' total of 29 assists from 2000-03. She is five helpers away from tying a trio of former program greats in second.

HEAD COACH BRIAN McMANUS: Brian McManus is in his 26th season as the head coach of the UC San Diego women's soccer program. He has led the Tritons to all seven of their national titles, with five in the NCAA Division III and two in Division II. McManus' overall record currently stands at 430-65-42, for a career win percentage of .840. He trails only Gabe Mejail of Merrimack (431) for the most victories among current Division II coaches. All-time regardless of division or active status, McManus ranks fifth in wins and seventh in winning percentage.

SENIOR-LADEN SENIOR DAY: UCSD's game against Chico State on Sunday, Oct. 21, was Senior Day for 10 Triton seniors. Following a recognition ceremony ahead of kickoff, all 10 were featured in head coach Brian McManus' starting lineup, along with freshman Kelcie Brodsky in goal. That included Mary McWalters' first career start, and Ellie Nevarez's first appearance since Oct. 25, 2009.
