## TRITON UPDATES

### FIRST THINGS FIRST

After a pair of tough losses to Chico State and Cal State Stanislaus last week, the UC San Diego men's basketball team will play four straight road games to close out the season. The Tritons will travel to Seaside to take on Cal State Monterey Bay on Friday night, before squaring off with Cal State East Bay on Saturday evening in Hayward. Both games will tip-off at 7:30 p.m. or immediately following the women's contests.

### ON THE RECORD

UCSD enters Friday's clash with Cal State Monterey Bay with an overall record of 9-14 and a 5-13 mark in California Collegiate Athletic Association play after falling to Chico State and Cal State Stanislaus at home last week. The Tritons let a 10-point second half lead slip away in a 71-64 defeat to the league-leading Wildcats on Friday and then suffered a 55-42 setback to the Warriors on Saturday after an ugly performance from the offense. UCSD, which currently sits in 10th place in the CCAA standings, had won four of its previous seven to stay in the hunt for a CCAA Tournament berth, but saw its postseason hopes dashed with the two losses last week. Seven of the eight tournament qualifiers have been determined and eighth place Cal State Stanislaus needs just two wins in its last four games to lock up the final spot.

### PLAYING FOR PRIDE

Now that they have been officially eliminated from postseason contention, the Tritons will look to put together a strong finish in their final four road games. UCSD has struggled on the road this season, going 1-7 so far, but the Tritons will have a decent shot at picking up a couple of wins this week. Cal State Monterey Bay is just 2-9 at The Kelp Bed in 2011-12 (and 2-20 overall), while Cal State East Bay is just one game over .500 on its home floor with a record of 6-5. The Tritons defeated the Otters, 71-67, earlier this season and dropped an 80-79 decision to the Pioneers in overtime the following night.

### OFFENSE STALLS VS. STANISLAUS

UCSD will be looking to bounce back this week after a forgettable offensive performance against Cal State Stanislaus on Saturday. The Tritons never found their rhythm against the Warriors, shooting a season-low 24% from the field. UCSD converted just 14 field goals in the game, finishing with 20 points in the first half and 22 in the second. Despite the offensive struggles, the Tritons still had a shot to win, pulling to within five on a three-pointer by James McCann with six minutes to play. Unfortunately, the Warriors answered with a 9-1 run over the next three and a half minutes and pulled away from there. UCSD was much sharper offensively against Chico State on Friday, shooting 50% (23-46) from the floor and 45% (4-9) from downtown.

### DEFENSE DOING ITS PART

While UCSD's offense had its troubles against Cal State Stanislaus, the defense played much better, holding the Warriors to just 37% (19-51) shooting for the game. The Tritons have been getting the job done on the defensive end over the last several weeks, holding three of their last five opponents to 37% shooting or less. UCSD currently ranks seventh in the CCAA in field goal percentage defense, holding the opposition to 42% for the season.

## NEWS AND NOTES

### LEADING MAN

Senior center Christian Hatch is in the midst of another outstanding season for the Tritons, averaging team-highs of 12.5 points and 7.2 rebounds in 20 games. The Henderson, Nev. native is shooting just under 50% from the field and has scored in double figures a total of 11 times this season. He has tallied three double-doubles on the year, including an impressive 16-point, 14-rebound performance against Cal State East Bay last month. After a dealing with a wrist injury for the last several weeks, Hatch looked like himself again against Chico State, finishing with a game-high 22 points on 9-of-13 shooting, while also hauling down six boards in 33 minutes. He finished with just five points on 1-of-4 shooting against Cal State Stanislaus, but still made an impact, grabbing 11 rebounds.

### ON POINT

Sophomore point guard James McCann has been playing his best basketball over the last month, averaging a team-high 15.3 points, 2.5 rebounds and 4.4 assists in UCSD's last 10 games. He shooting 46% (44-95) from the field over that span, including 44% (18-41) from the three-point line. The Carlsbad native had another big game against Chico State on Friday, finishing with 17 points, three rebounds and two assists in game-high 37 minutes. He was 4-of-8 from the floor, sank both of his attempts from behind the arc and hit seven of his nine free throws to finish in double figures for the 11th time this season. On the year, McCann is averaging 11.3 points, 2.0 rebounds and 4.0 assists per game. He's shooting 40% from the field and 36% from downtown.

### SCOUTING THE OTTERS

Cal State Monterey Bay has an overall record of 2-20 and a 1-17 mark in the CCAA after losing a 97-61 decision to Cal State East Bay in Seaside on Tuesday night... The Otters have lost 17 straight since defeating Sonoma State the opening weekend of conference play... Junior guard Brandon Ward is averaging a team-high 15.5 points, while junior forward Derrick Anderson is putting up 11.3 points and grabbing 5.0 boards... CSUMB ranks ninth in the league in scoring offense, averaging 64.9 points per game, while the defense is allowing 75.6 on the other end, a figure that ranks 11th... UCSD trails the all-time series with Cal State Monterey Bay 9-7 after claiming the first meeting of the year by a final score of 71-67 on Jan. 14 at RIMAC... James McCann and Justin Brue scored 19 points apiece to lead the way for the Tritons.

### SCOUTING THE PIONEERS

Cal State East Bay heads into the weekend at 8-14 overall and 6-12 in conference play after knocking off Cal State Monterey Bay on the road on Tuesday... The Pioneers had lost nine straight before routing the Otters... CSUMB is currently ninth in the league standings and still alive for a CCAA Tournament berth... Junior guard Mark Samuels is the player to watch for CSUEB, averaging 16.2 points on 50% shooting... He is also hauling down 4.9 rebounds and dishing out a team-high 3.1 assists... The Pioneers have the league's second-ranked offense, averaging 74.3 points per game, while the defense ranks dead last, allowing 77.1... The Tritons have won five out of eight previous matchups with Cal State East Bay... The Pioneers stole an 80-79 OT victory in the first meeting of the year on Jan. 13 in La Jolla.

### QUICK HITS

UCSD has struggled in the rebounding department lately, losing the battle on the glass in six of its last seven games... The Tritons were outrebounded 36-29 against Chico State on Friday and 47-37 on Saturday against Cal State Stanislaus... UCSD currently ranks 11th in the CCAA in scoring offense at 63.7 points per game and 12th in field goal percentage at 41.8%... Defensively, the Tritons rank fifth in the league, allowing 64.5 points per night... After taking on Cal State Monterey Bay and Cal State East Bay this week, UCSD will travel to Humboldt State and Sonoma State Feb. 22 and 24 to concluded the season.

## HEAD COACH CHRIS CARLSON



**C**hris Carlson embarks on his fifth season as the head coach at UC San Diego in 2011-12. The 11th coach in program history, he enters the year with an overall record of 54-57 (.486) in four seasons at the helm.

Carlson made an immediate impact upon arriving at UCSD, leading the Tritons to an overall record of 18-12 in his first season, the program's best mark since the 1998-99 campaign. After finishing sixth in the ultra-competitive California Collegiate Athletic Association standings at 11-9, Carlson's Tritons caught fire in March, defeating Cal State San Bernardino, San Francisco State and Cal Poly Pomona on the way to UCSD's first CCAA Tournament title. UCSD earned a No. 8 seed in its first NCAA Tournament appearance at the Division II level, falling to the University of Alaska-Anchorage 80-60 in the opening round of the West Regional.

The Tritons were one of the top teams in the CCAA again in 2008-09, recording an overall record of 17-11 and a 13-7 mark in league play. After earning a No. 4 seed in the CCAA Tournament, UCSD defeated No. 5 Humboldt State 79-67 in the first round before falling 76-72 to host Cal State San Bernardino in the semifinals.

UCSD finished with an overall record of 8-17 in 2009-10, missing the postseason for the first time since 2007. The Tritons went 4-2 during a six-game stretch in February to stay in contention for a conference tournament berth, but a pair of losses to Sonoma State and Humboldt State the final week of the regular season dashed the Tritons' postseason hopes.

Under Carlson's guidance, senior guard Jordan Lawley became the first Triton to win the CCAA scoring title since UCSD joined the conference in 2000-01 during the 2009-10 campaign. Lawley was named to the All-CCAA First Team and went on to earn All-West Region accolades after averaging career-highs of 20.2 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.4 assists in his final season as a Triton.

UCSD won five of its first six games to kick off the 2010-11 campaign, marking the program's best start in 10 seasons at the D-II level. The Tritons claimed the 2010 Disney West Coast Tipoff Classic title after defeating Lewis and Dixie State to open the season and also posted early season victories over Notre Dame de Namur and Simon Fraser. Despite the torrid start, UCSD would ultimately finish with an 11-7 record and miss the postseason for the second consecutive season.

Carlson joined the Triton family after spending four seasons as the Director of Basketball Operations at UCLA under head coach Ben Howland. As the DOB, he was responsible for the day-to-day operations of the program and served as a liaison to the athletic administration and other school officials. Carlson also assisted in scheduling and recruiting and helped guide the Bruin program to back-to-back NCAA Final Four appearances in 2005-06 and 2006-07.

Before assuming his duties at UCLA, Carlson served in the same capacity for two years at the University of Pittsburgh, joining the Panther staff in the summer of 2001. Prior to that, he was a member of Howland's staff at Northern Arizona in 1998-99, where he coached a Lumberjack squad that led the country in both field goal percentage and three-point percentage for the first time in NCAA history. He remained on at NAU for two years after Howland's departure (1999-2001), where he worked with NAU's post players and oversaw recruiting and scheduling.

Prior to his stint at Northern Arizona, Carlson served as an assistant coach at his alma mater, UC Santa Barbara, from 1994-98, where he oversaw development of the team's perimeter players. He also served as an assistant coach at nearby Dos Pueblos High School in Goleta from 1991-93.

Carlson worked as a game management assistant at the National Association of Basketball Coaches All-Star game for 12 straight years from 1993-2004 and has worked four NCAA Tournament West Regionals. In addition, he was an intern in the Los Angeles/St. Louis Rams media relations department, a sports information assistant at UCSB in 1993-94 and a member of the 1994 FIFA World Cup media relations staff.

A San Diego native, Carlson is a 1993 graduate from UC Santa Barbara, where he received his bachelors degree in History. Prior to his days as a Gaucho, Carlson attended Helix High School in La Mesa, where he earned All-League honors in basketball. He and his wife Karen have two sons, Nicklas and Charlie.

### UCSD PICKED TO FINISH 10TH IN CCAA STANDINGS

UC San Diego was selected to finish 10th in the California Collegiate Athletic Association regular season standings, according to the league's annual preseason coaches poll that was released in October. UCSD, which finished 11th in the conference with a 6-16 record last season, received 32 points in the poll. Defending regular season champion Humboldt State was picked to win the 2011-12 CCAA title, receiving nine first place votes and a total of 119 points. Cal State San Bernardino collected 106 points and two first place votes to finish second, while Cal State Dominguez Hills was third after garnering 90 points and the remaining first place vote.

### UCSD GAMES TO AIR ON ESPN 1700 IN 2011-12

The UC San Diego Athletics Department in November announced a partnership with ESPN Radio 1700 that will carry 16 Triton men's basketball games live locally during the 2011-12 season. ESPN 1700 will broadcast a total of 12 home games and four road contests this season, marking the first time UCSD basketball will air on terrestrial radio. Craig Elsten, who is in his third season as the voice of Triton basketball during UCSD's online broadcasts, will serve as play-by-play announcer, while Jack Cronin, Executive Producer at XX Sports 1090 and ESPN 1700, will handle the color commentary duties.
