### Tritons Take Second Straight Series

A week after going 3-1 at Cal State Monterey Bay to win its first series of the season, UCSD repeated at San Francisco State and set a team record in the process. The Tritons won games one, two and four by scores of 4-3, 20-2 and 4-0 with the Gators taking game three, 5-2.

The highlight of the weekend came in the second game as UCSD booked a total of 26 hits, the most in a single game since the program moved to Division II status for the 2001 season. The 20 runs were the most plated by the Tritons since putting up 21 at Cal State Dominguez Hills on Apr. 24, 2010. UCSD scored at least one run in all nine innings. Six Tritons had multiple hits, including five for Sam Michaels, four each for Danny Susdorf and Garrett Tuck and three apiece for Brett Levy, Scott Liske and Gregg Ringold. Susdorf and Tuck each drove in four runs while Michaels scored four times and knocked in three more. Seven doubles were registered by UCSD, two each for Liske and Susdorf. Starting pitcher Jeff Rauh gave up just one run over five innings for his first win of the season.

Down 3-1 after three innings of play in the series opener, UCSD plated two runs in the sixth to tie it up. An RBI single in the eighth by Ringold that scored Spencer Frazier was the difference. Ryan Goodbrand went seven innings to improve to 4-0 with the victory.

The fourth and final game of the series was the first shutout for the Tritons this season. Trevor Scott went five innings for the win and Elias Tuma and Tony York each tossed a scoreless inning to preserve the shutout.

### Cal State Stanislaus

The Warriors enter the series with a 15-11 overall record and are tied for third place in the league with UC San Diego with a 12-8 tally. CSUS has won its last four games, all against Cal State Monterey Bay in a home-and-home series last weekend. Outfielder Eli Davis is the reigning CCAA Player of the Week after going 10-for-16 (.625) with five runs scored, a double, two home runs and 10 RBI while posting a .684 on-base percentage and 1.062 slugging percentage over the CSUMB series. He leads the Warriors with his .418 average, 22 runs, 41 hits, four home runs, 23 RBI, .673 slugging percentage and .473 on-base percentage. On the mound, starters Byron Lemon and Rafael Vasquez each have three wins, as does reliever Anthony Gotelli. Vasquez has a team-best 33 strikeouts, while Shay Maltese is just behind with 30. As a team, CSUS holds a 3.68 ERA compared to its opponents' 4.93.

### Tuck Named CCAA Player of the Week

Shortstop Garrett Tuck was named the CCAA Player of the Week on Mar. 19. Over the four-game series at San Francisco State, he went 9-for-15 (.600) at the plate with three runs scored and five RBI. He walked twice and stole three bases. Tuck now leads the Tritons in average (.350), at-bats (100), hits (35), sac flies (5) and sac bunts (3).

### Steal Wheels

With 49 stolen bases, UCSD is leading the CCAA. As a team, the Tritons have been successful in 49 of 66 attempts while opponents have stolen just 27 bags in 31 attempts. UCSD has stolen at least one base in 22 of 28 games played and has totaled multiple steals 14 times. Individually, Danny Susdorf ranks second in the league with 14 swipes and Gregg Ringold is third with 11.

### No Baloney Tony

Relief pitcher Tony York (2-0) continues to baffle opponents. He's given up zero runs over 16.2 innings in 12 appearances and leads the Tritons with four saves and a .151 opponent batting average. The senior right-hander has scattered just eight hits and walked only three while striking out 11 this season. York has given up just one extra-base hit, a double against Western Oregon in his first game of the year.

### Susdorf, La Face and Tuma Earn NCBWA Preseason Recognition

Danny Susdorf was named to the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) Preseason All-America Second Team and the NCBWA Preseason All-West Region First Team. Nick La Face and Elias Tuma were also selected to the all-region second team. In addition, Susdorf was also named to the initial watch list for the 2012 Tino Martinez Award for the most outstanding player in DII college baseball. The annual honor is named after the former University of Tampa Spartan, Olympian and MLB All-Star, Tino Martinez. The finalists will be named on May 21st with the winner announced after the conclusion of the NCAA DII Baseball Championships.

Eric Newman was named the head coach of the UCSD baseball program on August 29, 2011, becoming the team's second leader since the school moved to NCAA Division II status for the 2001 season.

Newman had been the pitching coach at Nebraska since 2007 and served as the head coach at Dallas Baptist from 2004 until 2007. A San Diego Padres draft pick, Newman played eight seasons of professional baseball.

He took over the Triton program from Dan O'Brien, who resigned in June of 2011 to take the head position at NCAA Division I Santa Clara. O'Brien, the winningest coach in school history, amassed a record of 454-283-1 (.616) over 14 seasons in La Jolla.

In 2008, his first season as pitching coach at Nebraska, Newman wasted no time making an impact as his staff played a major role in getting the Huskers to the NCAA Regionals for the ninth time in 10 years. He took a contingent that had just 14 returning wins and guided the team to 41 wins and a No. 1 regional seed. For the season, NU was tops in the Big 12 in complete games (7) and ranked among the league leaders in saves (17, second), strikeouts (491, third) and ERA (4.18, third). The ERA ranked 23rd nationally, while the 491 strikeouts were the most at NU since 2005 and the staff's 8.46 strikeouts per game set a new school record.

The 2008 Huskers featured two-time All-American Johnny Dorn, as well as All-Big 12 selections Thad Weber and Dan Jennings. Five pitchers were selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, including Aaron Pribanic (third round, Seattle), Jennings (ninth, Florida), Dorn (15th, Florida), Weber (16th, Detroit) and Zach Herr (38th, San Diego).

In 2010 and 2011, Newman boasted top 15-ranked recruiting classes.

Prior to arriving in Lincoln, Newman spent five years (2002-07) at NCAA Division I independent Dallas Baptist. Named the program's head coach in 2004, Newman led the Patriots to a 95-72 (.569) record and guided the program through its transition to Division I.

During Newman's years at the helm, the Patriot program turned out a Collegiate Baseball First Team All-American in Drew Holder and 14 All-Independent Team picks. Newman had three players invited to Team USA trials and 15 of his players, including eight pitchers, were drafted or signed professional free agent contracts.

In 2005, the Patriots were top 15 in the country in batting average, runs scored, doubles and slugging percentage. In 2006, the team was top 10 nationally in runs, doubles, home runs and slugging.

Newman was named the 2006 Independent Coach of the Year.

From 2002-2004, Newman was the associate head coach and pitching coach at Dallas Baptist. During his tenure, he lowered the team ERA from 5.80 to 3.28. The 3.28 in 2004 would have ranked seventh nationally had DBU not been provisional Division I status at the time.

The Patriots won their second consecutive NCCAA national championship in 2004, a season that saw five pitchers finish with ERAs under 3.00. The duo of Lance Broadway and Jeff Gilmore each recorded 10 wins. Broadway, a finalist for the Dick Howser Trophy and Roger Clemens Award in 2005, was drafted by the Chicago White Sox in the first round and made it to the Major Leagues in 2007.

Dallas Baptist also won a NCCAA title in 2003.

Patriot pitchers tossed a perfect game and three no-hitters under Newman.

While at DBU, Newman was instrumental in fundraising, helping secure over \$600,000 to build a new clubhouse and renovate the indoor hitting facility in 2006. In 2005, Newman assisted in starting the Minuteman Booster/Alumni Club.

A fifth round draft pick of the San Diego Padres in 1994, Newman pitched professionally for eight seasons with four different organizations. Overall, he ended his career with a 44-44 record over 600+ innings. He averaged less than one hit per inning and nearly one strikeout per inning for his career. He saw action all the way up to the AAA level.

Newman played in the minors for the Padres (1994-98), the Chicago Cubs (1999-2000), the Arizona Diamondbacks (2001) and the Los Angeles Dodgers (2002). He was a player/coach for the Vero Beach Dodgers in the Florida State League.

As a collegiate student-athlete, Newman played two seasons at Fresno State before transferring to Texas Tech. In 1993, he won a Western Athletic Conference (WAC) championship with the Bulldogs. The next season, he was tabbed All-Southwest Conference as a member of the Texas Tech Red Raiders.

Newman earned a master's degree in higher education from Dallas Baptist in 2004. He did his undergraduate work at Texas Tech and received a bachelor's degree in family studies in 1997.

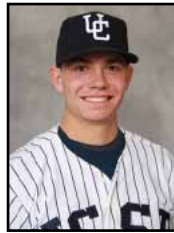
