UCSD Earns First Series Sweep of Season

The Tritons not only earned their first series sweep of the year with four wins against Sonoma State last week, they also overtook the Seawolves for first place in the CCAA.

Game One, 11-6: Every Triton in the starting lineup scored at least one run. UCSD led 5-3 after four and a half innings and plated five runs in the bottom half of the fourth to put the game out of reach. The Tritons out-hit the Seawolves 13-9 as four players had multiple hits. Scott Liske was 3-for-4 with a triple and an RBI and also scored two runs. Nick La Face doubled, tripled, scored a run, drove in a pair of runs and stole a base. Ryan Goodbrand improved to 6-0 as he struck out a career-high eight batters in 5.2 innings of work. He allowed all six runs on nine hits.

Game Two, 10-8: UCSD came back from a 6-2 deficit. Danny Susdorf scored four times and joined Richard Seigel and Garrett Tuck with two RBI each. Susdorf led off the game with his fifth triple of the season, Seigel smashed his fourth home run and Tuck was 3-for-3 at the plate. Liske doubled twice and scored a pair of runs. Reliever Richard Kilbury picked up the win as he gave up no runs and no hits over the seventh and eighth innings. Tony York finished the game to earn his seventh save.

Game Three (4-1): Trevor Scott struck out a career-high 10 batters and gave up just two hits in five scoreless innings of work. Susdorf again had two hits while Seigel and Brett Levy both doubled. Spencer Frazier and Sam Michaels each had an RBI. After three and a half scoreless innings, the Tritons broke it open with four runs in the bottom of the fourth.

Game Four (6-4): James Mossholder's RBI single sparked a three-run eighth inning to lead UCSD to the sweep. Eight of nine players in the starting lineup had at least one hit or one run scored. Six different Tritons crossed the plate and nine different players accounted for the team's nine hits. Frazier, La Face, Liske, Mossholder and Susdorf each had an RBI. Kilbury earned his second win in as many days, throwing a scoreless eighth inning, and York picked up his eighth save of the season.

Poll Position

This week, the Tritons are receiving votes in Collegiate Baseball Newspaper's top-30 national poll for the first time since February. UCSD was ranked 30th in CBN's preseason poll before dropping to receiving votes status in the Feb. 6 and Feb. 13 polls. Also this week, the Tritons made their debut in the College Baseball Lineup top-30 poll, coming in at 28.

The West is the Best

The Tritons moved from seventh up to fourth in this week's NCBWA West Region poll. Cal Baptist took over the top spot, while Western Oregon is second and Chico State, which was first last week, is third. Following UCSD is Dixie State, Cal Poly Pomona (tied for sixth), Cal State San Bernardino (tied for sixth), Sonoma State, Cal State Stanislaus and Hawaii Pacific. The Tritons took the fourth place spot from Sonoma State.

Liske on Fire

In the sweep of Sonoma State, right fielder Scott Liske led the Tritons in batting average (.500), hits (7), on-base percentage (.533) and doubles (3). He tied for the team lead in runs (6) while slugging .857 and adding three RBI and a triple. Liske had at least a hit and a run in all games and multiple hits and multiple runs in two games. He scored the game-winning run in game two and had the game-winning RBI in game four. His outfield assist, along with second baseman Spencer Frazier, nailed a runner at the plate to prevent the Seawolves from taking lead in the sixth inning of game two.

Win-Win Situation

Left-handed reliever Richard Kilbury won in back-to-back appearances vs. Sonoma State for the first time in his career. He gave up zero runs and one hit over 4.1 innings. The lone hit was a single and he picked that runner off first base. In the sixth inning of game one, Kilbury came on with two outs and runners on first and third to retire the first batter he faced, ending the inning. In game two, the junior retired the side in order in the seventh and eighth innings.

HEAD COACH ERIC NEWMAN



Eric Newman was named the head coach of the UCSD baseball program on August 29, 2011, becoming the team's second leader since the school moved to NCAA Division II status for the 2001 season.

Newman had been the pitching coach at Nebraska since 2007 and served as the head coach at Dallas Baptist from 2004 until 2007. A San Diego Padres draft pick, Newman played eight seasons of professional baseball.

He took over the Triton program from Dan O'Brien, who resigned in June of 2011 to take the head position at NCAA Division I Santa Clara. O'Brien, the winningest coach in school history, amassed a record of 454-283-1 (.616) over 14 seasons in La Jolla.

In 2008, his first season as pitching coach at Nebraska, Newman wasted no time making an impact as his staff played a major role in getting the Huskers to the NCAA Regionals for the ninth time in 10 years. He took a contingent that had just 14 returning wins and guided the team to 41 wins and a No. 1 regional seed. For the season, NU was tops in the Big 12 in complete games (7) and ranked among the league leaders in saves (17, second), strikeouts (491, third) and ERA (4.18, third). The ERA ranked 23rd nationally, while the 491 strikeouts were the most at NU since 2005 and the staff's 8.46 strikeouts per game set a new school record.

The 2008 Huskers featured two-time All-American Johnny Dorn, as well as All-Big 12 selections Thad Weber and Dan Jennings. Five pitchers were selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, including Aaron Pribanic (third round, Seattle), Jennings (ninth, Florida), Dorn (15th, Florida), Weber (16th, Detroit) and Zach Herr (38th, San Diego).

In 2010 and 2011, Newman boasted top 15-ranked recruiting classes.

Prior to arriving in Lincoln, Newman spent five years (2002-07) at NCAA Division I independent Dallas Baptist. Named the program's head coach in 2004, Newman led the Patriots to a 95-72 (.569) record and guided the program through its transition to Division I.

During Newman's years at the helm, the Patriot program turned out a Collegiate Baseball First Team All-American in Drew Holder and 14 All-Independent Team picks. Newman had three players invited to Team USA trials and 15 of his players, including eight pitchers, were drafted or signed professional free agent contracts.

In 2005, the Patriots were top 15 in the country in batting average, runs scored, doubles and slugging percentage. In 2006, the team was top 10 nationally in runs, doubles, home runs and slugging.

Newman was named the 2006 Independent Coach of the Year.

From 2002-2004, Newman was the associate head coach and pitching coach at Dallas Baptist. During his tenure, he lowered the team ERA from 5.80 to 3.28. The 3.28 in 2004 would have ranked seventh nationally had DBU not been provisional Division I status at the time.

The Patriots won their second consecutive NCCAA national championship in 2004, a season that saw five pitchers finish with ERAs under 3.00. The duo of Lance Broadway and Jeff Gilmore each recorded 10 wins. Broadway, a finalist for the Dick Howser Trophy and Roger Clemens Award in 2005, was drafted by the Chicago White Sox in the first round and made it to the Major Leagues in 2007.

Dallas Baptist also won a NCCAA title in 2003.

Patriot pitchers tossed a perfect game and three no-hitters under Newman.

While at DBU, Newman was instrumental in fundraising, helping secure over \$600,000 to build a new clubhouse and renovate the indoor hitting facility in 2006. In 2005, Newman assisted in starting the Minuteman Booster/Alumni Club.

A fifth round draft pick of the San Diego Padres in 1994, Newman pitched professionally for eight seasons with four different organizations. Overall, he ended his career with a 44-44 record over 600+ innings. He averaged less than one hit per inning and nearly one strikeout per inning for his career. He saw action all the way up to the AAA level.

Newman played in the minors for the Padres (1994-98), the Chicago Cubs (1999-2000), the Arizona Diamondbacks (2001) and the Los Angeles Dodgers (2002). He was a player/coach for the Vero Beach Dodgers in the Florida State League.

As a collegiate student-athlete, Newman played two seasons at Fresno State before transferring to Texas Tech. In 1993, he won a Western Athletic Conference (WAC) championship with the Bulldogs. The next season, he was tabbed All-Southwest Conference as a member of the Texas Tech Red Raiders.

Newman earned a master's degree in higher education from Dallas Baptist in 2004. He did his undergraduate work at Texas Tech and received a bachelor's degree in family studies in 1997.

Toro Notes

CSUDH enters the series at 10-22 overall and is in last place in the CCAA at 6-18. The Toros have lost three straight, going 1-3 against Cal State East Bay in their latest series. In the league, they have wins over San Francisco State, Cal State L.A., Cal Poly Pomona, Cal State Stanislaus (2) and Cal State East Bay. CSUDH leads the CCAA in doubles (79), is second in strikeouts (239), fourth in stolen bases (39) and fifth in batting average (.291). Matthew Young is tied with UCSD's Danny Susdorf for the league lead in steals (20), while Carlos Avila ranks third in batting average (.384) and slugging (.593). Drew Rodela is third in doubles (14) and Sako Chapjian ranks fifth in runs (30).

Steal Wheels

UCSD leads the CCAA with 72 stolen bases, 18 more than the second place team. Danny Susdorf is tied for first with 20 steals and Gregg Ringold is fourth with 12. UCSD has stolen at least one base in 29 of 36 games and multiple bases 20 times, including 11 of its last 13 games. Three times the Tritons have stolen a season-high five bags. In comparison, the team stole a total of 68 bags over 57 games in 2011.

In the Record Books

In UCSD's single season record book, Danny Susdorf's five triples are tied for third while his 20 steals rank eighth. Tony York's eight saves are tied for the third-most in a single season. Career-wise, Susdorf has 10 three-baggers, which ties him for fourth all-time. His 43 stolen bases put him in seventh. York's eight saves are tied for eighth on the school's career list.

A Tale of Two Teams

After starting the season 7-12, UCSD has gone 14-3 in its last 17 games. Comparing some numbers between the two spans, the Tritons raised their batting average from .247 to .330, scored 116 runs to 85, upped their slugging from .339 to .414 and elevated their on-base percentage from .324 to .397. On the mound, UCSD has lowered its ERA to 3.39 from 4.53.

In the Nation

Nationally, Garrett Tuck ranks seventh in sacrifice flies (6), Danny Susdorf ranks ninth in triples (5) and 36th in stolen bases (20), Tony York is 11th in saves (8) and Ryan Goodbrand is 23rd in pitching wins (6). As a team, the Tritons are 19th in walks per nine innings (2.88), 24th in steals (72), 28th in sacrifice bunts (33), 34th in hit by pitches (48) and 35th in sacrifice flies (18).

From Stockton to La Jolla

UCSD's Triton Ballpark will host to the 2012 CCAA Baseball Tournament May 10-12, marking the first time since 2008 that the tourney has been held on a campus site. The league's top four squads will compete for the tourney title and an automatic berth in the NCAA Division II Tournament. In 2009, the CCAA tourney was held in Palm Springs, while the 2010 and 2011 tournaments were contested at Klein Family Field in Stockton. The Tritons have won the past three CCAA regular season and tournament crowns.

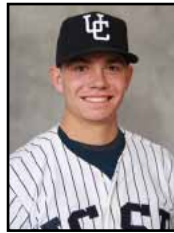
