UCSD Wins Series vs. Cal State Dominguez Hills

The Tritons won their fifth straight CCAA series, going 3-1 against Cal State Dominguez Hills in a home-and-home slate.

Game One, 3-1: Danny Susdorf and Spencer Frazier each had two hits and Ryan Goodbrand tossed six strong innings to guide UCSD to a win in the opener. The Tritons scored three runs in the second inning and limited the Toros to a single run in the fourth. Goodbrand gave up the one run on four hits en route to his seventh win of the season. He struck out three and walked none. Tony York earned his ninth save of the season, which ranks third on UCSD's single season list.

Game Two, 14-2: Susdorf led the charge in the second game, going 3-for-5 with a double and two triples while scoring a run and driving in three more. After falling behind 1-0 in the first inning, the Tritons tied it up in the fourth and slammed the door shut with 12 more runs over the next three innings. Also banging out three hits were Nick La Face and Garrett Tuck. Tuck, along with Scott Liske, each scored three runs. Sam Michaels was 2-for-4 with two runs and two RBI, while Frazier crossed the plate twice and drove in a pair. UCSD swiped nine bags in the game. Tuck accounted for three and Frazier and Liske each had two.

Game Three (0-1): UCSD out-hit CSUDH, 5-4, but the Toros pushed across a run in the first inning for the second straight game and made the lead stick. Justin Rahn had two of UCSD's five hits. Starter Trevor Scott was the hard luck loser, tossing 5.1 innings with just the one run on four hits. He struck out four and walked one. *(continued on next page)*

Game Four (15-6): A total of 19 hits, including a three-run home run by Liske, lifted UCSD to the win and gave the series to the Tritons. After falling behind 2-0 in the first inning, the Tritons struck for five runs in the bottom half to take the lead for good. They scored a single run in the second and at least two in each of the fourth, fifth and seventh innings. Both the 15 runs and the 19 hits were the second-most posted by UCSD this season. UCSD's two-three-four hitters in the lineup combined for 11 hits as Richard Seigel had three and Tuck and La Face each had four. The trio also accounted for seven runs with Seigel leading the way, crossing the plate four times. Liske also had a night, connecting for three hits while scoring a pair of runs and driving in four total. Six of the Tritons' hits went for extra bases. Liske doubled to go along with his long ball, while Tuck doubled twice and Brian Choi and Seigel each had a two-bagger. Richard Kilbury improved to 3-0 on the season as he won in a relief role. Both teams played less than stellar defense as UCSD committed four errors in the field and CSUDH was just behind with three. The Toros also racked up three passed balls and four wild pitches, while Triton hurlers hit three batters.

Poll Position

This week, the Tritons got back into the Collegiate Baseball poll for the first time since the preseason, coming in tied for 29th with three other teams. They stayed at No. 28 in the College Baseball Lineup poll and are receiving votes in the NCBWA poll for the second straight week. Tampa owns the top spot in three of four polls with St. Mary's in first in the NCBWA list.

The West is the Best

The Tritons continued climbing in the NCBWA West Region poll, moving from fourth to third this week. Cal Baptist retained the top spot, followed by Western Oregon, UCSD, Chico State, Cal Poly Pomona, Cal State San Bernardino, Dixie State, Cal State Stanislaus, Cal State Los Angeles and Hawaii Pacific.

Triple Threat

Danny Susdorf currently leads the nation with his seven triples and has tied UCSD's career record with 12 (Bob Natal, 1984-87). On the school's single season list, Susdorf's seven three-baggers rank third. In the stolen base department, his 21 swipes this year rank eighth for a single season and his 44 career steals are tied for sixth in program history (Bret Sandstrom, 1979-81).

New York

Relief pitcher Tony York (2-0) has come on strong this season, leading the team with an .038 ERA and nine saves over 24 innings. The league-leading nine saves rank third on UCSD's single season list and fourth in the school's career rankings. Nationally, York's save total ranks 12th. In 2011, York finished with a 4.91 ERA and a 2-0 record over a total of 18.1 innings.

Eric Newman was named the head coach of the UCSD baseball program on August 29, 2011, becoming the team's second leader since the school moved to NCAA Division II status for the 2001 season.

Newman had been the pitching coach at Nebraska since 2007 and served as the head coach at Dallas Baptist from 2004 until 2007. A San Diego Padres draft pick, Newman played eight seasons of professional baseball.

He took over the Triton program from Dan O'Brien, who resigned in June of 2011 to take the head position at NCAA Division I Santa Clara. O'Brien, the winningest coach in school history, amassed a record of 454-283-1 (.616) over 14 seasons in La Jolla.

In 2008, his first season as pitching coach at Nebraska, Newman wasted no time making an impact as his staff played a major role in getting the Huskers to the NCAA Regionals for the ninth time in 10 years. He took a contingent that had just 14 returning wins and guided the team to 41 wins and a No. 1 regional seed. For the season, NU was tops in the Big 12 in complete games (7) and ranked among the league leaders in saves (17, second), strikeouts (491, third) and ERA (4.18, third). The ERA ranked 23rd nationally, while the 491 strikeouts were the most at NU since 2005 and the staff's 8.46 strikeouts per game set a new school record.

The 2008 Huskers featured two-time All-American Johnny Dorn, as well as All-Big 12 selections Thad Weber and Dan Jennings. Five pitchers were selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, including Aaron Pribanic (third round, Seattle), Jennings (ninth, Florida), Dorn (15th, Florida), Weber (16th, Detroit) and Zach Herr (38th, San Diego).

In 2010 and 2011, Newman boasted top 15-ranked recruiting classes.

Prior to arriving in Lincoln, Newman spent five years (2002-07) at NCAA Division I independent Dallas Baptist. Named the program's head coach in 2004, Newman led the Patriots to a 95-72 (.569) record and guided the program through its transition to Division I.

During Newman's years at the helm, the Patriot program turned out a Collegiate Baseball First Team All-American in Drew Holder and 14 All-Independent Team picks. Newman had three players invited to Team USA trials and 15 of his players, including eight pitchers, were drafted or signed professional free agent contracts.

In 2005, the Patriots were top 15 in the country in batting average, runs scored, doubles and slugging percentage. In 2006, the team was top 10 nationally in runs, doubles, home runs and slugging.

Newman was named the 2006 Independent Coach of the Year.

From 2002-2004, Newman was the associate head coach and pitching coach at Dallas Baptist. During his tenure, he lowered the team ERA from 5.80 to 3.28. The 3.28 in 2004 would have ranked seventh nationally had DBU not been provisional Division I status at the time.

The Patriots won their second consecutive NCCAA national championship in 2004, a season that saw five pitchers finish with ERAs under 3.00. The duo of Lance Broadway and Jeff Gilmore each recorded 10 wins. Broadway, a finalist for the Dick Howser Trophy and Roger Clemens Award in 2005, was drafted by the Chicago White Sox in the first round and made it to the Major Leagues in 2007.

Dallas Baptist also won a NCCAA title in 2003.

Patriot pitchers tossed a perfect game and three no-hitters under Newman.

While at DBU, Newman was instrumental in fundraising, helping secure over \$600,000 to build a new clubhouse and renovate the indoor hitting facility in 2006. In 2005, Newman assisted in starting the Minuteman Booster/Alumni Club.

A fifth round draft pick of the San Diego Padres in 1994, Newman pitched professionally for eight seasons with four different organizations. Overall, he ended his career with a 44-44 record over 600+ innings. He averaged less than one hit per inning and nearly one strikeout per inning for his career. He saw action all the way up to the AAA level.

Newman played in the minors for the Padres (1994-98), the Chicago Cubs (1999-2000), the Arizona Diamondbacks (2001) and the Los Angeles Dodgers (2002). He was a player/coach for the Vero Beach Dodgers in the Florida State League.

As a collegiate student-athlete, Newman played two seasons at Fresno State before transferring to Texas Tech. In 1993, he won a Western Athletic Conference (WAC) championship with the Bulldogs. The next season, he was tabbed All-Southwest Conference as a member of the Texas Tech Red Raiders.

Newman earned a master's degree in higher education from Dallas Baptist in 2004. He did his undergraduate work at Texas Tech and received a bachelor's degree in family studies in 1997.

Edwin Mendoza is first in home runs (8), Ethan Chapman ranks third in triples (6), Paul Eshleman is third in home runs (6) and Curtis Cassise is fourth in walks (23). Pitcher Mike Mudron ranks first in opponent average (.200) and fewest hits allowed (29), second in fewest runs allowed (14) and ERA (1.69) and fourth in wins (5). Bryant Hollingsworth is third in fewest hits allowed (34) and fourth in fewest runs allowed (19) and Casey McCarthy is fourth in innings pitched (64.1)

Steal Wheels

UCSD leads the CCAA with its 83 stolen bases, a whopping 28 more than the second place team. Danny Susdorf is second in the league with 21 steals and Garrett Tuck, who stole a career-high three on Apr. 15 at CSUDH, is seventh with 11

swipes. The Tritons stole 68 bags in 2011 and 83 in 2010. The team record for steals is 101, set in 1985 and again in 1988.

Double Digits

With its 15-6 win over Dominguez Hills Monday night, UCSD has posted 10 or more runs 10 times this season. The Tritons have won all 10 of those games. They've hit double digits in six of their last 11 games.

More National Numbers

In the country, UCSD ranks 17th in walks allowed per nine innings, 23rd in triples, 24th in sac bunts and 26th in steals. Individually, Garrett Tuck is eighth in sacrifice flies and Ryan Goodbrand is 20th in pitching victories.

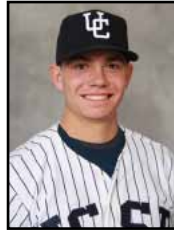
