UCSD Splits Series vs. Cal State San Bernardino

The Tritons won the two home games and lost both road contests.

Game One, 2-3: A two out, bases loaded single in the bottom of the ninth inning lifted CSUSB to the opening game win at Fiscalini Field. Danny Susdorf went 3-for-4, scoring a run and stealing a base. Reliever Tony York suffered the first loss of his career. Starting pitcher Ryan Goodbrand, who entered the day with a 7-0 record, got a no decision as he went 5.2 innings, giving up two runs on seven hits while striking out two and walking three. UCSD tied the game up at 2-2 with a two out, unearned run in the top of the ninth.

Game Two, 4-14: CSUSB plated four runs in the third inning and tacked on five more in the fourth. UCSD scored single runs in the fifth and seventh innings and a pair in the top of the ninth. Jeff Rauh suffered the loss as he lasted 3.1 innings, giving up nine runs and nine hits while striking out three and walking four. Susdorf again led UCSD at the plate, going 3-for-3 with a run scored and a RBI. He doubled and stole a base. Nick La Face was 2-for-3 with a RBI, two walks and a pair of stolen bases. Paul Eshleman went 4-for-5 with six RBI, cracking a grand slam home run in the fourth inning for the Coyotes. It was the first time since Mar. 3 that the Tritons had lost two consecutive games.

Game Three (8-4): UCSD posted three runs in the first inning and held on to the lead the rest of the way. Five players had multiple hits for the Tritons, including La Face, who was 2-for-4 with a home run, two runs scored and three RBI. Scott Liske went 3-for-5 with two RBI while Justin Rahn, Richard Seigel and Garrett Tuck all had two hits apiece. *(continued on next page)*

Tuck scored a career-high four runs and Rahn doubled and drove in a pair of runs. Starter Greg Selarz earned the win, allowing four runs and nine hits over 5.2 innings. Richard Kilbury and Elias Tuma held the Coyotes scoreless over the final 3.1 frames with Tuma recording his first save of the season.

Game Four (5-2): Starting pitcher Trevor Scott limited the Coyotes to a single run and two hits as UCSD once again never trailed. He had a no-hitter going through five innings before Eric Dow smacked a solo home run off of him to lead off the sixth. The freshman struck out four and walked two over his 5.2 innings of work. Susdorf doubled, tripled and crossed the plate twice and Tuck had another two hits. York picked up his 10th save of the season.

Tuck Honored by NCBWA and CCAA

Garrett Tuck was named the NCBWA West Region Player of the Week as well as the CCAA Player of the Week after leading the Tritons in batting average (.611), runs (7), hits (11), doubles (3), total bases (14), slugging percentage (.778) and on-base percentage (.667) over five games last week. He had a hit in every game with multiple hits in four of five. In game four vs. CSUDH, he went 4-for-5 with two runs, an RBI and two doubles. He scored a career-high four runs in game three against CSUSB. Tuck has reached base safely in his last 21 plate appearances. He won the CCAA award in mid-March as well.

Triple Threat

Danny Susdorf led off the first inning of game four vs. Cal State San Bernardino by tripling to deep center field. It gave him 13 for his career, breaking UCSD's record for career triples. On the school's single season list, Susdorf's eight three-baggers rank second behind Matt Lawson, who totaled nine in 2005. Nationally, Susdorf is in a four-way tie for first place in total triples and ranks third in triples per game.

Poll Position

This week, the Tritons fell out of the Collegiate Baseball national poll, but are receiving votes. They dropped from 28 to 30 in the College Baseball Lineup poll and are receiving votes in the NCBWA listing for the third straight week. Mount Olive, St. Mary's and Tampa are the top-three in the Collegiate Baseball poll.

On the Western Front

The first NCAA regional rankings were released this week and UCSD is second in the West behind Western Oregon. Cal State San Bernardino is third, followed by Chico State, Dixie State, Cal State L.A., Cal Poly Pomona and Cal State Stanislaus. In this week's NCBWA West Region poll, UCSD is tied for third with Chico State. Cal Baptist and Western Oregon are tied for No. 1. Cal State San Bernardino is fifth, followed by Dixie State, Cal State Stanislaus, Cal Poly Pomona, Cal State L.A., Hawaii Pacific (tied for 10th) and Cal State Monterey Bay (tied for 10th).

New York

Relief pitcher Tony York has come on strong this season. He's 2-1 with a 1.04 ERA and a league-leading 10 saves over 26 innings. The 10 saves rank second on UCSD's single season list behind Keith Noe, who totaled 14 in 2008. He's tied for third on the school's career saves list. Nationally, York is currently 10th in total saves. In 2011, York finished with a 2-0 record, a 4.91 ERA and no saves over a total of 18.1 innings.

HEAD COACH ERIC NEWMAN



Eric Newman was named the head coach of the UCSD baseball program on August 29, 2011, becoming the team's second leader since the school moved to NCAA Division II status for the 2001 season.

Newman had been the pitching coach at Nebraska since 2007 and served as the head coach at Dallas Baptist from 2004 until 2007. A San Diego Padres draft pick, Newman played eight seasons of professional baseball.

He took over the Triton program from Dan O'Brien, who resigned in June of 2011 to take the head position at NCAA Division I Santa Clara. O'Brien, the winningest coach in school history, amassed a record of 454-283-1 (.616) over 14 seasons in La Jolla.

In 2008, his first season as pitching coach at Nebraska, Newman wasted no time making an impact as his staff played a major role in getting the Huskers to the NCAA Regionals for the ninth time in 10 years. He took a contingent that had just 14 returning wins and guided the team to 41 wins and a No. 1 regional seed. For the season, NU was tops in the Big 12 in complete games (7) and ranked among the league leaders in saves (17, second), strikeouts (491, third) and ERA (4.18, third). The ERA ranked 23rd nationally, while the 491 strikeouts were the most at NU since 2005 and the staff's 8.46 strikeouts per game set a new school record.

The 2008 Huskers featured two-time All-American Johnny Dorn, as well as All-Big 12 selections Thad Weber and Dan Jennings. Five pitchers were selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, including Aaron Pribanic (third round, Seattle), Jennings (ninth, Florida), Dorn (15th, Florida), Weber (16th, Detroit) and Zach Herr (38th, San Diego).

In 2010 and 2011, Newman boasted top 15-ranked recruiting classes.

Prior to arriving in Lincoln, Newman spent five years (2002-07) at NCAA Division I independent Dallas Baptist. Named the program's head coach in 2004, Newman led the Patriots to a 95-72 (.569) record and guided the program through its transition to Division I.

During Newman's years at the helm, the Patriot program turned out a Collegiate Baseball First Team All-American in Drew Holder and 14 All-Independent Team picks. Newman had three players invited to Team USA trials and 15 of his players, including eight pitchers, were drafted or signed professional free agent contracts.

In 2005, the Patriots were top 15 in the country in batting average, runs scored, doubles and slugging percentage. In 2006, the team was top 10 nationally in runs, doubles, home runs and slugging.

Newman was named the 2006 Independent Coach of the Year.

From 2002-2004, Newman was the associate head coach and pitching coach at Dallas Baptist. During his tenure, he lowered the team ERA from 5.80 to 3.28. The 3.28 in 2004 would have ranked seventh nationally had DBU not been provisional Division I status at the time.

The Patriots won their second consecutive NCCAA national championship in 2004, a season that saw five pitchers finish with ERAs under 3.00. The duo of Lance Broadway and Jeff Gilmore each recorded 10 wins. Broadway, a finalist for the Dick Howser Trophy and Roger Clemens Award in 2005, was drafted by the Chicago White Sox in the first round and made it to the Major Leagues in 2007.

Dallas Baptist also won a NCCAA title in 2003.

Patriot pitchers tossed a perfect game and three no-hitters under Newman.

While at DBU, Newman was instrumental in fundraising, helping secure over \$600,000 to build a new clubhouse and renovate the indoor hitting facility in 2006. In 2005, Newman assisted in starting the Minuteman Booster/Alumni Club.

A fifth round draft pick of the San Diego Padres in 1994, Newman pitched professionally for eight seasons with four different organizations. Overall, he ended his career with a 44-44 record over 600+ innings. He averaged less than one hit per inning and nearly one strikeout per inning for his career. He saw action all the way up to the AAA level.

Newman played in the minors for the Padres (1994-98), the Chicago Cubs (1999-2000), the Arizona Diamondbacks (2001) and the Los Angeles Dodgers (2002). He was a player/coach for the Vero Beach Dodgers in the Florida State League.

As a collegiate student-athlete, Newman played two seasons at Fresno State before transferring to Texas Tech. In 1993, he won a Western Athletic Conference (WAC) championship with the Bulldogs. The next season, he was tabbed All-Southwest Conference as a member of the Texas Tech Red Raiders.

Newman earned a master's degree in higher education from Dallas Baptist in 2004. He did his undergraduate work at Texas Tech and received a bachelor's degree in family studies in 1997.

Cal State L.A. Notes

The Golden Eagles enter the series at 22-16 overall and are in a tie for fourth place in the CCAA at 18-14. They have won nine of their last 11 games, including a 3-2 victory over Cal Poly Pomona in 11 innings this past Sunday. CSULA is 15-4 at Reeder Field, but just 7-12 on the road. Daniel Duran has been a force, leading the league in average (.444), slugging (.688) and on-base percentage (.512). He leads the team with 34 RBI, 17 doubles and six home runs. On the mound, Ryan Santhon is 3-0 with a 3.08 ERA over 61.1 innings. Gabriel Asakura is 5-3 with a 3.40 in 55.2 innings and Cedar Morgan and Jacob Valenzuela each have three saves.

Steal Wheels

UCSD leads the CCAA and ranks 21st in the nation with its 91 stolen bases. It is 33rd in steals per game (2.07). Danny Susdorf has 24 of those steals, the 35th-highest total in the country. In 2011, the Tritons stole 68 bases. The team's single season record is 101, set in 1985 and again in 1988.

More National Rankings

UCSD ranks 20th in walks allowed per nine innings (2.9), 27th in triples (14) and sacrifice bunts (41), 32nd in fielding percentage (.966), 38th in sacrifice flies (21) and 40th in triples per game (.32). Individually, Danny Susdorf ranks first in triples (8), third in triples per game (.20) and 42nd in toughest to strike out (16.3). Garrett Tuck is 14th in sacrifice flies (6) and 44th in hits (64). Pitching-wise, Tony York is 10th in saves (10) and Ryan Goodbrand is 34th in wins (7).
