2012 All-CCAA Baseball Team Announced *Cal State L.A.'s Daniel Duran Voted Most Valuable Player*

WALNUT CREEK — Regular-season baseball co-champions Chico State and UC San Diego dominated the 2012 All-California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) team that was announced on Wednesday. The Wildcats led all teams with nine selections, while the Tritons had eight players honored.

Cal State L.A. senior third baseman Daniel Duran was named Most Valuable Player while Cal Poly Pomona senior right-hander Geoff Broussard was a unanimous pick as Pitcher of the Year. San Francisco State catcher Mark Lindsay was tabbed Freshman of the Year, Cal State Stanislaus senior outfielder Eli Davis was voted Newcomer of the Year and UC San Diego first-year head coach Marc Newman was named Coach of the Year

Sonoma State and UC San Diego each had a conference-high four first-team selections. Seawolves named to the first team included first baseman Garrett Gooselaw, second baseman Jackson Stogner, designated hitter Devon Zenn and right-hander Thomas Lee. Tritons voted to the first team included shortstop Garrett Tuck, outfielder Danny Susdorf, starting pitcher Ryan Goodbrand and relief pitcher Tony York.

Duran, who becomes the third Cal State L.A. player and first since 1998 to earn Player of the Year honors, enjoyed a productive season at the plate as he led the conference in overall batting (.451), slugging percentage (.737), on-base percentage (.533), runs scored (47) and doubles (23). During CCAA play, Duran posted conference-highs in batting average (.468), slugging percentage (.773), on-base percentage (.541) and doubles (19).

Broussard, who is the fourth Cal Poly Pomona hurler to garner Pitcher of the Year accolades, made 13 appearances, including 12 starts, and registered an 11-1 record, 1.58 ERA and seven complete games. In 97.0 innings, he allowed 70 hits, 17 earned runs, walked 10 and struck out 82. The Broncos right-hander led the CCAA in ERA, innings pitched, strikeouts and wins. During CCAA play, Broussard posted a 9-1 mark, 1.63 ERA and seven complete games. In 83.0 innings, he surrendered 62 hits, 15 earned runs, walked nine and struck out 70.

Lindsay earned Freshman of the Year honors after batting a team-high .352 with 18 runs scored and 20 RBI. Davis, a senior transfer from Sacramento, Calif., was near the top of the CCAA in virtually every offensive category after leading Cal State Stanislaus in average (.399), slugging percentage (.657), on-base percentage (.457), runs scored (46), hits (79), RBI (49), triples (6), home runs (8) and total bases (130).

Newman, in his first season piloting the Tritons, was named Coach of the Year after leading UC San Diego to a share of the CCAA regular-season title.
