Tritons Wrap Up Homestand, Head to BYU

UC San Diego (2-3, 1-1 MPSF) closes out a three-match Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) homestand this Thursday night, Jan. 17. The Tritons play host to 14th-ranked conference newcomer Cal Baptist (2-1, 0-0) in the teams' first-ever meeting as MPSF rivals. The Lancers will be coming off of their first-ever MPSF match the previous night on Wednesday, Jan. 16, at home against top-ranked defending national champion UC Irvine (7 p.m.). Following Thursday night's contest, UCSD will head out-of-state for the first and only time during this 2013 campaign, traveling to Provo, Utah, to take on the third-ranked BYU Cougars at Smith Fieldhouse on Saturday night, Jan. 19, beginning at 6 p.m. PT. BYU remains the only current MPSF member that the Tritons have never beaten.

All UCSD home matches inside RIMAC Arena again this season feature a live online video stream as well as live stats, both free of charge. Fans can access live video and live stats from the Schedule/Results tab of the men's volleyball page at UCSDtritons.com. A link is also available there for live stats for the road match at No. 3 BYU on Saturday night, Jan. 19.

Tritons Split Opening Weekend of Conference Play at Home

UCSD split a pair of 3-0 results to open both its home and conference slate for the 2013 season last week. The Tritons first overwhelmed then-eighth-ranked USC, the 2012 national runner-up, on Thursday night, Jan. 10. Set scores were 25-22, 25-22 and 25-20. Carl Eberts was the star, putting down a match-high 16 kills and committing just four errors over 29 swings for a .414 attack percentage. He added a match-high nine digs and five total blocks. Teammates Vaun Lennon and Cheyne Hayes provided nine kills apiece, while setter Garrett Dempsey had 29 assists and eight digs. Junior middle blocker Fred Stahl finished with three kills and a team-high six blocks. On Saturday afternoon, Jan. 12, UCSD was out-blocked as a team, 15-2, and fell to a dominant Pepperdine side ranked fourth, 25-13, 25-13 and 25-15. Hayes led all players with 11 kills while Mike Brunsting had 14 assists and eight digs off the bench.

Tritons Move Up Again in AVCA Poll

UCSD advanced in the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Division I-II Men's Coaches Top 15 Poll for the second week in a row, moving up from No. 14 to No. 13 in Monday's latest release. The Tritons were among five teams receiving votes just outside of the preseason edition of the rankings, and have since gone 2-3 in going up against No. 5 Lewis, No. 6 UCLA, No. 7 Long Beach State, No. 8 USC and No. 4 Pepperdine, in order.

Eberts Approaching Exclusive 1000-Kill Club

In his final season of college volleyball, senior outside hitter Carl Eberts needs 191 kills to become just the fifth player in program history to reach the 1,000-kill plateau. The product of Huntington Beach and Edison High School produced 89 kills as a redshirt freshman in 2010, before leading the squad in 2011 and 2012 with 326 and 335 kills, respectively. Matching either of those two campaigns would put Eberts firmly in UCSD's 1000-Kill Club, joining current members and former teammates Jason Spangler (1,491; 2007-10) and Frank Fritsch (1,403; 2007-10), as well as Jim Waller (1,301; 2001-04) and former Triton women's volleyball head coach (2005-09) and current LMU women's coach Tom Black (1,268; 1993-96).

Veteran Duo Moving Up All-Time Charts

Carl Eberts and Chase Frishman are each moving up separate all-time lists in the UCSD men's volleyball record book. Eberts has moved into the top-10 in kills, currently in ninth with 809. He is ninth in attacks (1,933) and also looking to enter the all-time lists in the aces (48; six short) and digs (396; 28 short) categories. Frishman, meanwhile, is sixth with 483 digs, and is 124 away from matching Chris Mortimer (2000-03) for second all-time in program history.

Cal Baptist Notes

The 14th-ranked Lancers open their first-ever MPSF campaign at home against top-ranked defending national champion UC Irvine this Wednesday prior to making the trip from Riverside to La Jolla the following night. Cal Baptist is coming off of a 2012 season in which it went 12-16 overall. The Lancers lead the MPSF in hitting (.373), assists (14.36/set), kills (15.73/set) and aces (1.82/set) in the early going, but are also last in opponent hitting percentage (.318) and blocks (1.45/set). Senior outside hitter Levi Cabral was named the season's first MPSF Molten Player of the Week on Jan. 7 following his performance at the UCSB Asics Invitational. He and fellow Brazilian Guilherme Koepp share the MPSF lead at 4.82 kills per set. Koepp is also first in aces (0.73/set) and points (5.82/set). Wes Schneider is in his first season in charge of the Lancers.

BYU Notes

BYU dropped one spot from No. 2 to No. 3 in the AVCA poll this week after a home split of its only two non-conference matches, against Lewis. The Tritons had rallied to upset the then-fifth-ranked Flyers, 3-2, in the season opener for both squads in Santa Barbara on Jan. 4. BYU took a two-set lead before Lewis staged a comeback of its own to take the first meeting between the sides on Friday, Jan. 11. The host Cougars posted a routine three-set victory the following night. Junior outside hitter Taylor Sander leads BYU at 3.87 kills per set. Senior Ryan Boyce (10.47 assists/set), like Sander a native of Huntington Beach, is the Cougar setter. Senior middle Russ Lavaja is getting his hands on a team-best 1.60 blocks per set. BYU hosts top-ranked defending national champion UC Irvine on Friday night, Jan. 18, (6 p.m. PT) prior to welcoming the Tritons to Smith Fieldhouse. Chris McGown is in his second season guiding his alma mater.

Best-Ever Fourth-Place Asics Finish

UCSD made its first championship semifinal appearance at the UC Santa Barbara Asics Invitational on Friday, Jan. 4, after rallying to take down No. 5 Lewis in five sets earlier that day. With back-to-back 3-2 losses to UCLA and Long Beach State, the Tritons finished a best-ever fourth at the tourney. UCSD went an identical 1-2 but placed seventh in both 2010 and 2011.

Lennon Selected to UCSB Asics Invitational All-Tournament Team

Junior outside hitter Vaun Lennon represented UCSD on the seven-player All-Tournament Team of the 2013 UC Santa Barbara Asics Invitational. He was the lone Triton to achieve double-digit kill totals in all three matches, with 13 in the come-from-behind win over Lewis, 12 against UCLA and 16 more in the third-place match versus Long Beach State. The Los Angeles native also produced seven digs in all three contests and was a UCSDtritons.com Athlete of the Week.

Double-Double for Hayes

Cheyne Hayes, a redshirt sophomore opposite, produced the season's first double-double by a Triton men's volleyball player against then-seventh-ranked Long Beach State on Jan. 5. Hayes produced a team-high 18 kills to go along with a match-high 15 digs in the 3-2 loss to the 49ers in the third-place match of the UC Santa Barbara Asics Invitational. Both totals were career highs for the Creston native. UCSD had two double-doubles during the whole of the 2012 season, by Carl Eberts (1/14 vs. NJIT: 15 kills and 11 digs) and Mike Brunsting (1/14 vs. NJIT: 12 digs and 55 assists).

HEAD COACH KEVIN RING



The 2013 season is former Triton player Kevin Ring's eighth as head coach of the UCSD men's volleyball program.

Ring's 2012 squad finished with a 9-19 overall record and placed ninth in the ultra-competitive Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) with a 6-16 mark, narrowly missing a berth in the eight-team league tournament. UCSD recorded upsets over No. 3 UCLA, No. 9 Long Beach State, No. 11 Hawai'i, No. 12 UC

Santa Barbara and No. 13 Cal State Northridge. The team strung together an unprecedented five-match win streak in league play, three of those victories on the road.

For the second straight year, the Tritons climbed to as high as No. 11 in the AVCA national poll.

Outside hitter Carl Eberts and libero Chase Frishman earned All-MPSF honorable mention. Outside hitter Vaun Lennon was tabbed the AVCA National Player of the Week in early April, becoming the second Triton to garner that distinction in the history of the program. Additionally, six players were named MPSF All-Academic in 2012.

UCSD finished with five MPSF wins in 2011, producding upsets at defending national champion and fourth-ranked Stanford, at No. 5 UCLA, at No. 7 UC Irvine, at No. 11 Pepperdine and at home against No. 11 Hawai'i. The sweep at Stanford marked not only the Tritons' first-ever triumph at Maples Pavilion, but also snapped the 18-match home win streak of the Cardinal.

On March 24, 2011, UCSD hosted third-ranked Ohio State and took a four-set victory over the Buckeyes, who went on to win the national championship.

Senior setter Phil Bannan was an All-MPSF Second Team selection after becoming UCSD's all-time leader in assists and service aces. Ring also graduated middle blocker Calvin Ross, who took over as the school's career leader in blocks. Four Tritons were named MPSF All-Academic in 2011.

In 2010, the Tritons were ranked in the top-15 nationally through the entire year and collected six conference wins for the campaign, including two each over UCLA and Pepperdine. Bannan picked up All-MPSF honorable mention for the second straight year.

Ring led the 2009 squad to its most successful in program history. The Tritons won a Division II-best 13 matches and nearly qualified for the MPSF Tournament, being eliminated during the final weekend of conference play. UCSD defeated several ranked teams, including a win over UCLA for the second consecutive season. The Tritons finished the year ranked No. 11 and Ring was named MPSF Coach of the Year.

While maintaining a high level of success on the court and in the classroom, Ring and his players have kept a clear focus on giving back to the community. For the past several years, the Tritons have held regular volleyball clinics with Big Brothers Big Sisters of San Diego County.

Before being elevated to the head-coaching position on June 15, 2005, Ring spent the previous nine years as an assistant for the UCSD men's squad. He served as the top assistant for Duncan McFarland in 1997 and 1998, for Jon Stevenson in 1999 and for Ron Larsen between 2000-05. Ring helped guide the Tritons to an NCAA Division III national championship in 2000.

In addition to his duties at UCSD, Ring was an adjunct faculty member in the Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry at the University of San Diego. He also served as an assistant coach for the Torero women's volleyball team in 2004-05.

Ring got his start at UCSD serving as the men's volleyball team manager from 1989-91 before playing on the team for three seasons.

Ring was the full-time team manager for the USA men's national team from 1991-93 and continued on as a technical advisor through 1996. He accompanied the national team to the 1992 Olympic Games in Barcelona and the 1996 Games in Atlanta. The 1992 squad left Spain with a bronze medal.

Ring earned two degrees from UCSD, graduating with a bachelor's degree in biochemistry in 1996, followed by a master's degree in chemistry in 1998. A native of Oregon, he played prep volleyball at Sheldon High School in Eugene.

Eberts and Frishman Back for One Final College Campaign

The Tritons return their senior tandem of Carl Eberts and Chase Frishman in 2013 for one final season of their stellar college careers. The duo each earned All-Mountain Pacific Sports Federation honorable mention a year ago. Frishman recently garnered preseason All-America honorable mention from Off the Block. Eberts is a fifth-year senior out of Huntington Beach who redshirted as a true freshman in 2009. Frishman, a native of Dana Point, is in his fourth year in the program. The only other senior on head coach Kevin Ring's 2013 roster is third-year Triton Greg Smith, a middle blocker out of Fullerton.

UCSD Captains

Team tri-captains for the 2013 season were designated as senior Carl Eberts and juniors Sebastian Brady and Vaun Lennon. Eberts is now a three-time captain in his fifth season in the program. He was co-captains with Brady in 2012. Lennon is in his first year as a Triton captain.

A Proud Tradition of Academic and Athletic Excellence

Head coach Kevin Ring's UCSD squad had six players earn Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) All-Academic honors a season ago, with all six Tritons returning for the current 2013 campaign. Those players are seniors Carl Eberts and Chase Frishman, juniors Sebastian Brady, Mike Brunsting and Vaun Lennon, and sophomore Cheyne Hayes. UCSD was tied with Pacific and Stanford for the most MPSF All-Academic players for 2012. Eberts is now a three-time selection while Frishman has earned the award in two successive years.

Poll Position

UCSD was ranked No. 13 in the final American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) national poll of the 2012 season, and that is where the Tritons currently sit. Their highest AVCA ranking a year ago was No. 11. National champion UC Irvine was No. 1 in the final poll, and is No. 1 again now.

Other Poll News

UCSD is one of four teams receiving votes in this season's second installment of the Volleyball Magazine Men's Division I-II Top 10 Poll, released on Jan. 15. In a third rating, by Off the Block, the Tritons are one of four teams listed as on the bubble outside of the top 10.

In the MPSF

In the conference's first statistical report of the new season, Chase Frishman ranks seventh in the MPSF in digs at 2.33 per set. He was third at the end of 2012 (2.28/set). UCSD is fourth in team digs (9.10/set). Last year, Carl Eberts ranked 14th in both kills (3.22/set) and points (3.77/set). Garrett Dempsey and Mike Brunsting were 12th (7.97/set) and 13th (6.39/set), respectively, in assists. UCSD ranked sixth in digs (8.60/set), eighth in aces (0.87/set), and ninth in kills (12.20/set) and assists (11.44/set).

In the National Rankings

The NCAA has not yet produced its first statistical rankings for 2013. In 2012, Chase Frishman was 13th nationally in digs (2.28/set).
