TRITONS WELCOME WARRIORS TO OPEN LEAGUE SLATE

The 21st-ranked UCSD baseball team begins its defense this weekend of four consecutive California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) regular-season championships. The Tritons welcome in the Warriors of Cal State Stanislaus for a four-game series beginning Friday night, Feb. 15, under the lights at Triton Ballpark. UCSD is 5-2 coming off of a second straight three-game non-conference series victory and an extra-inning win at home over Point Loma Nazarene on Tuesday night. Stanislaus is 3-4.

WEEKEND MATCH-UPS

The series opener with Cal State Stanislaus this Friday, Feb. 15, will begin at 6 p.m. A doubleheader will follow at 12 p.m. on Saturday, with the second game a shortened seven-inning affair. Sunday's finale is set for an 11 a.m. first pitch. Friday's game will see Triton staff ace Ryan Goodbrand, the reigning NCBWA West Region Pitcher of the Week, take his unblemished record up against fellow senior right-hander Byron Lemon. Dan Kolodin kicks off Saturday's twin bill against another sophomore right-hander in Dustin Baisdon, while junior left-hander Justin Rahn should draw his first collegiate pitching start in the nightcap against senior right-hander Rafael Vasquez. Sophomore left-hander Trevor Scott faces junior right-hander Michael York on Sunday.

LIVE COVERAGE

All UCSD home games at Triton Ballpark this season again feature a live online video stream and live stats, both free of charge. Weekday games during the conference season will also have audio commentary, with former Triton pitcher Tim Strombel (2007-08) calling the action. Friday's conference opener against Cal State Stanislaus will mark Strombel's season debut. Fans can access live video and live stats from the Schedule/Results tab of the baseball page at UCSDtritons.com. Most road games will also at minimum have live stats available, with links active at that same location on the baseball team's Schedule/Results page. SCOUTING CAL STATE STANISLAUS

Cal State Stanislaus is off to a 3-4 start to the 2013 season. The Warriors, who finished 27-23 overall a year ago and an even 20-20 for seventh place in the 11-team CCAA, have lost four games out of the gate despite posting a miniscule 2.18 ERA. Conversely, Stanislaus is hitting just .223 as a team thus far. Clint Brill (.444), Skippy Ferreria (.333) and Andrew Graves (.333) have seen the most success at the plate. Justin Charles has driven in five runs. Friday starter Byron Lemon is 1-0 with a 1.23 ERA over his two starts, with a team-best 11 strikeouts against a single walk in 14.2 innings of work. Last time out, Cal State Stanislaus dropped both ends of a home doubleheader to Fresno Pacific on Saturday, Feb. 9 (1-3, 0-3), after having swept a twin bill at Fresno Pacific just one day prior (7-4, 3-2). Kenny Leonasio is in his 11th season as the Cal State Stanislaus head coach.

SERIES HISTORY

UCSD leads the all-time series between these teams, 32-22. The Tritons won the 2012 series in Turlock, three games to one, with the Warriors narrowly salvaging the seven-inning finale, 7-6, after UCSD had clinched the set by final scores of 3-2, 11-4 and 12-8. The lone loss snapped a 15-game win streak for the Tritons against Stanislaus going back to May 9, 2008. The last meeting in La Jolla took place in 2011, with the Tritons earning the sweep, 4-2, 2-1, 2-1 and 18-1. UCSD has won 11 straight over the Warriors in La Jolla since a 7-1 defeat on April 27, 2007.

TRITONS IN THE NATIONAL POLLS

UCSD moved up one spot for the second straight week, from No. 22 to No. 21, in the latest installment of the Collegiate Baseball Newspaper Division II poll, released each Monday. The Tritons dropped from No. 17 to No. 22 in the second in-season edition of the D2 Baseball News listing. College Baseball Lineup has the Tritons still at No. 20, where they had them rated in the preseason. The fourth and final national poll for the NCAA Division II, conducted by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA), has stuck with its preseason ranking thus far, with UCSD beginning the new year at No. 19.

UCSD TAKES EXTRA-INNING THRILLER OVER CITY RIVALS

UCSD is coming off of a come-from-behind, 6-5 victory over crosstown foe Point Loma Nazarene in 11 innings on Tuesday night at Triton Ballpark. The Tritons scored twice in the ninth and nabbed the decider in the 11th as Danny Susdorf walked to lead off, moved to second when Dillon Moyer was plunked, and sprinted home on a Justin Rahn sacrifice when the Sea Lion pitcher threw the ball away. Earlier in the game, it was vintage Susdorf as the senior leadoff man singled to right on a 1-2 pitch to open the home seventh, stole second and third, and scored on a wild pitch to give UCSD a 3-2 edge.

GOODBRAND NAMED NCBWA WEST REGION PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Ryan Goodbrand was named on Tuesday, Feb. 12, as the 2013 season's first National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) West Region Pitcher of the Week. The initial award encompassed the first two weekends of the season, from Feb. 1-10. During that span, Goodbrand threw 11.0 scoreless innings over two starts, both wins, allowing five hits and two walks with 11 strikeouts. It was the second weekly West Region honor of his career after Feb. 28, 2012.

THREE TRITONS ON TINO MARTINEZ AWARD WATCH LIST

Ryan Goodbrand, Danny Susdorf and Garrett Tuck were named on Monday, Feb. 11, to the 150-player watch list for the 2013 Tino Martinez Award. Given annually to the top Division II player in the nation, the honor is named after the former University of Tampa Spartan, United States Olympian, first-round draft pick and Major League Baseball All-Star, Tino Martinez. Susdorf was a semifinalist a year ago. After being narrowed down to semifinalists (May 6) and finalists (May 20), the 2013 winner will be announced on June 3, two days after the NCAA Division II championship game. Bryan Fogle of Erskine (2010), Chase Larsson of Cameron (2011) and Nathan Minnich of Shepherd (2012) were the previous recipients.

BACK-TO-BACK SERIES WINS OVER TOUGH OPPOSITION

UCSD posted a second straight three-game non-conference series victory against a well-regarded foe last weekend, traveling by bus to Phoenix, Ariz., to take a pair from former conference rival Grand Canyon, who was receiving votes in a national poll going in. The Tritons held off late 'Lopes rallies to win each of the first two games, themselves rallying in the middle affair to turn a 4-2 deficit into an 8-4 lead through a six-run eighth. On the season's opening weekend, UCSD nabbed the rubber game from then-No. 20 Colorado Mesa, 8-4, at Triton Ballpark on Sunday, Feb. 3, to win that series.

TRITONS RATED SECOND IN WEST

UCSD was ranked second in the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) preseason West Region top-10 poll. UCSD earned one of six first-place votes and 55 total points to rank just behind defending West Region champion Chico State, which garnered the remaining five first-place nods and totalled 58 points. The NCBWA's next listing will be released on Feb. 18. D2 Baseball News has UCSD rated third in the West behind Chico State and Cal Poly Pomona.

GOODBRAND, SUSDORF AND TUCK EARN REGIONAL PRESEASON RECOGNITION

Ryan Goodbrand, Danny Susdorf and Garrett Tuck were each named to the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) Preseason All-West Region First Team. Susdorf had also earned the distinction prior to the 2012 season.

GOODBRAND PICKS UP SEASON'S FIRST CCAA PITCHER OF THE WEEK NOD

Ryan Goodbrand was named on Monday, Feb. 4, as the 2013 season's first Rawlings/California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Pitcher of the Week. He tossed five scoreless, three-hit innings with six strikeouts in UCSD's 6-2 win over then-No. 20 Colorado Mesa on Opening Night on Friday, Feb. 1. It was the second weekly CCAA honor of his career.

Senior All-American centerfielder Danny Susdorf has extended his career-best hitting streak to 24 games over the first two weeks of the 2013 season. He had concluded his junior year on a 17-game run in 2012 (Apr. 19-May 19). This is the second hit streak of his career of double-digit games, following a 10-gamer late in 2011 (Apr. 30-May 14). With a team-leading six doubles already this year, Susdorf has moved into the program's top-10 list in the category, now up to No. 9, with 47 career two-baggers.

SUSDORF STREAKING ON DEFENSE, TOO

Danny Susdorf also has a lengthy defensive streak intact, having now handled 181 defensive chances in a row without an error, spanning 74 games dating back to his last charged error on April 29, 2011, at Chico State. He put away all 125 chances without a miscue in 2012 and 21 thus far to begin the 2013 season, including an outfield assist at Grand Canyon.

GOOD START, GOODY START

Ryan Goodbrand has picked up right where he left off in 2012. The right-handed staff ace has tossed 11.0 innings of shutout baseball through his first two starts, both wins. Over a workmanlike five frames against then-No. 20 Colorado Mesa at home on Feb. 1, he allowed just three hits and no walks, retiring six Mavericks on strikes and four more on ground balls of the 15 outs he recorded before exiting after 76 throws on a 75-pitch limit for his initial 2013 outing. At Grand Canyon on Feb. 8, Goodbrand's no-hit bid was broken up on an infield single with one out in the sixth. He left after that inning with just two hits and two walks against him, and five more strikeouts. Goodbrand is now an undefeated 13-0 in his 17 career starts in a Triton uniform, with winning decisions in six straight appearances. He has gone a minimum of 5.0 frames in all 17 stints on the mound, with a pair of nine-inning complete games a year ago. UCSD is 15-2 when Goodbrand starts.

IRONMAN TUCK

Junior infielder Garrett Tuck has made 79 straight starts and appeared in 86 consecutive games since late in the 2011 campaign. He and fourth-year junior teammate Nick La Face were the only two Tritons to have both played in and started all 57 contests a year ago. Tuck, second on the team in 2012 behind Danny Susdorf (84) with 77 hits, matched his single-game career high with a four-hit effort in the rubber-game victory over Colorado Mesa on Feb. 3. La Face, incidentally, has drawn 64 starts in a row.

SINGLE SHORT OF CYCLE FOR SEIGEL

Senior first baseman Richard Seigel powered up in lifting UCSD to an 8-4 victory in the all-important rubber game of its opening series with then-No. 20-Colorado Mesa on Feb. 3. Seigel fell a single short of hitting for the cycle in smacking a double to lead off the home second, a leadoff home run in the fifth and a one-out triple in the eighth. All three hits were pulled to the gap in right center, as Seigel wound up 3-for-5 with two runs scored and one run driven in on the afternoon. He then added a triple and a home run at Grand Canyon and is currently slugging .792.

RAHN AIMING FOR NEW BOARD

Justin Rahn led the Triton offense during the opening weekend, as the junior hit a team-best .571 (8-for-14) with four RBI. In the middle game against Colorado Mesa on Feb. 2, he launched his first collegiate home run, a solo shot to open the bottom of the sixth and temporarily give UCSD a 2-1 edge. The home run was officially the first one hit off of the new scoreboard in right field. Ironically, Rahn had done the same thing in UCSD's exhibition opener with Concordia back on Jan. 21.

TWO-WAY TRITONS

Justin Rahn made his collegiate pitching debut in the middle game against Colorado Mesa (2/2), tossing two shutout innings with just one walk and a strikeout. Though he threw throughout the fall and saw 6.2 innings of work over two exhibition appearances late last month, Rahn had not pitched in an official game since he was at Cupertino's Monta Vista High School. He is expected to join the four-person starting rotation when conference play begins this week, with his bat remaining in the lineup. With true freshman Troy Cruz, a local product out of Bonita Vista High School, the two should see significant action as two-way performers.

OPENING SUCCESS

With a 6-2 victory at home over then-No. 20 Colorado Mesa on Opening Night on Friday, Feb. 1, UCSD improved to 10-3 in season openers since the program moved up from the NCAA Division III to Division II for the 2001 campaign.

UCSD LOADED FOR 2013 RUN

UCSD began the 2013 season as the four-time defending CCAA regular-season and tournament champion. Eric Newman, the 2012 CCAA Coach of the Year in his first year in charge, welcomed back nine of his top 10 hitters from a year ago, as well as valuable arms like Ryan Goodbrand, Trevor Scott and bullpen veteran Richard Kilbury. Tops among those returning bats is All-American centerfielder Danny Susdorf, who was third in the league with his team-best .393 batting average. Goodbrand, who went a perfect 11-0, again takes the ball from Newman in series openers in 2013 after moving into that role on March 2, 2012, in Hayward. The Tritons were 13-2 in his 15 starts in 2012, and Goodbrand earned the winning decision in his last four appearances. UCSD does, however, still need to replace 31 of 57 starts and 257 innings out of the 483 thrown a year ago, or 53 percent.

TRIPLE THREAT

Danny Susdorf finished his junior campaign with nine triples, giving him 14 for his career heading into his final collegiate season. He owns UCSD's career record for three-baggers and his nine from 2012 tied him for the program's single-season mark. That total was tied for the lead among all players in the NCAA Division II. Susdorf was sixth in triples per game (0.17).

STEAL WHEELS

UCSD led the CCAA and ranked 27th nationally in the NCAA Division II with its 103 stolen bases in 2012, setting a new single-season program record. The previous mark of 101 had been set in 1985 and matched in 1988.

AROUND THE NATION

Nationally in 2012, UCSD ranked 15th in triples (18) and walks allowed per nine innings (2.78), 17th in sacrifice bunts (57), 21st in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.23), 27th in stolen bases (103), 28th in doubles (106), 29th in fielding percentage (0.966), 33rd in hit-by-pitches (70). Individually, Danny Susdorf was tied for first in triples (9), sixth in triples per game (0.17), ninth in hits (84), 36th in steals (26) and 50th in batting average (.393). Garrett Tuck was 11th in sacrifice flies (7) and 46th in hits (77). Scott Liske was 33rd in hit-by-pitches (16). On the mound, Ryan Goodbrand ranked eighth in wins (11), 11th in starts (15) and 36th in walks allowed per nine innings (1.45). Trevor Scott was 48th in hits allowed per nine innings (6.82).

NEW ADDITION TO TRITON BALLPARK

Fans visiting Triton Ballpark during the 2013 season will notice a new addition in right field. The UCSD baseball program has a new scoreboard. The board was generously donated by the University of San Diego, which brought in a new one of its own for its brand-new Fowler Park facility. It was refurbished and repainted in UCSD colors and installed ahead of the exhibition opener on Jan. 21.

Eric Newman was named the head coach of the UCSD baseball program on August 29, 2011, becoming the team's second leader since the school moved to NCAA Division II status for the 2001 season.

In 2012, his first campaign with the Tritons, Newman was named the California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Coach of the Year after guiding the team to its fourth straight league regular season and tournament championships. The Tritons qualified for their sixth consecutive NCAA West Regional appearance as well.

UCSD won a slew of individual awards, led by starting pitcher Ryan Goodbrand and outfielder Danny Susdorf, who each garnered All-America honors. Six Tritons picked up all-region accolades and eight were named to All-CCAA teams. Reliever Elias Tuma showed his strength away from the diamond as well by being named a CoSIDA Academic All-American.

Prior to coming to La Jolla, Newman had been the pitching coach at Nebraska and served as the head coach at Dallas Baptist. A San Diego Padres draft pick, he played eight seasons of professional baseball.

In 2008, his first season as pitching coach at Nebraska, Newman wasted no time making an impact as his staff played a major role in getting the Huskers to the NCAA Regionals for the ninth time in 10 years. He took a contingent that had just 14 returning wins and guided the team to 41 wins and a No. 1 regional seed. For the season, NU was tops in the Big 12 in complete games (7) and ranked among the league leaders in saves (17, second), strikeouts (491, third) and ERA (4.18, third). The ERA ranked 23rd nationally, while the 491 strikeouts were the most at NU since 2005 and the staff's 8.46 strikeouts per game set a new school record.

The 2008 Huskers featured two-time All-American Johnny Dorn, as well as All-Big 12 selections Thad Weber and Dan Jennings. Five pitchers were selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, including Aaron Pribanic (third round, Seattle), Jennings (ninth, Florida), Dorn (15th, Florida), Weber (16th, Detroit) and Zach Herr (38th, San Diego).

In 2010 and 2011, Newman boasted top 15-ranked recruiting classes.

Prior to arriving in Lincoln, Newman spent five years (2002-07) at NCAA Division I independent Dallas Baptist. Named the program's head coach in 2004, Newman led the Patriots to a 95-72 (.569) record and guided the program through its transition to Division I.

During Newman's years at the helm, the Patriot program turned out a Collegiate Baseball First Team All-American in Drew Holder and 14 All-Independent Team picks. Newman had three players invited to Team USA trials and 15 of his players, including eight pitchers, were drafted or signed professional free agent contracts.

In 2005, the Patriots were top 15 in the country in batting average, runs scored, doubles and slugging percentage. In 2006, the team was top 10 nationally in runs, doubles, home runs and slugging.

Newman was named the 2006 Independent Coach of the Year.

From 2002-2004, Newman was the associate head coach and pitching coach at Dallas Baptist. During his tenure, he lowered the team ERA from 5.80 to 3.28. The 3.28 in 2004 would have ranked seventh nationally had DBU not been provisional Division I status at the time.

The Patriots won their second consecutive NCCAA national championship in 2004, a season that saw five pitchers finish with ERAs under 3.00. The duo of Lance Broadway and Jeff Gilmore each recorded 10 wins. Broadway, a finalist for the Dick Howser Trophy and Roger Clemens Award in 2005, was drafted by the Chicago White Sox in the first round and made it to Major League Baseball in 2007.

Dallas Baptist also won a NCCAA title in 2003.

Patriot pitchers tossed a perfect game and three no-hitters under Newman.

While at DBU, Newman was instrumental in fundraising, helping secure over \$600,000 to build a new clubhouse and renovate the indoor hitting facility in 2006. In 2005, Newman assisted in starting the Minuteman Booster/Alumni Club.

A fifth round draft pick of the San Diego Padres in 1994, Newman pitched professionally for eight seasons with four different organizations. Overall, he ended his career with a 44-44 record over 600+ innings. He averaged less than one hit per inning and nearly one strikeout per inning for his career. He saw action all the way up to the AAA level.

Newman played in the minors for the Padres (1994-98), the Chicago Cubs (1999-2000), the Arizona Diamondbacks (2001) and the Los Angeles Dodgers (2002). He was a player/coach for the Vero Beach Dodgers in the Florida State League.

As a collegiate student-athlete, Newman played two seasons at Fresno State before transferring to Texas Tech. In 1993, he won a Western Athletic Conference (WAC) championship with the Bulldogs. The next season, he was tabbed All-Southwest Conference as a member of the Texas Tech Red Raiders.

Newman earned a master's degree in higher education from Dallas Baptist in 2004. He did his undergraduate work at Texas Tech and received a bachelor's degree in family studies in 1997.

Newman, 40, resides in La Jolla with his wife, Melissa, and sons EJ (5) and Jack (10 months).
