TRITONS BEGIN SECOND HALF OF MPSF SEASON

UC San Diego (6-11, 3-9 MPSF) begins the second half of the 2013 Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) season with a pair of matches this weekend. The Tritons first make the day trip to Riverside to take on 12th-ranked league newcomer Cal Baptist at Van Dyne Gym on Friday, Mar. 1. They then return home to host No. 2 BYU inside RIMAC Arena on Saturday night, Mar. 2. First serve for both contests is set for 7 p.m. UCSD split this particular weekend during the first half of the season, outlasting CBU in five sets in La Jolla on Jan. 17 before losing 3-0 at BYU two nights later. Following this weekend, the Tritons embark on a season-long five-match road stretch that will lead them into a season-long five-match homestand to round out the regular season. That stand kicks off with No. 6 UCLA heading to La Jolla on Friday, Mar. 29.

MATCH COVERAGE

All UCSD home matches inside RIMAC Arena again this season feature a live online video stream as well as live stats, both free of charge. Fans can access live video and live stats from the Schedule/Results tab of the men's volleyball page at UCSDtritons.com. Friday night's match at Cal Baptist will have a live broadcast for a fee of \$2.95, and live stats for free.

UCSD ROLLS IN NON-CONFERENCE FINALE AT HIU

UCSD posted a 25-22, 25-20 and 25-23 victory at Hope International in Fullerton last Friday night, Feb. 22, in its final non-conference match of the 2013 season. The Tritons out-hit the Royals, .279-.160. Carl Eberts led all players with 15 kills. Sebastian Brady added nine kills with just one error on 16 swings for a .500 hitting percentage, while also getting his hands to three total blocks. Nick Iorfino had seven kills while senior Greg Smith came off the bench to hit .750 with six kills on eight attacks without a miscue. Smith also provided three block assists of his own. Mike Brunsting contributed 28 assists, eight digs, two kills, two blocks and a match- and season-high three service aces. All three aces came during a stretch of seven consecutive points to give UCSD a commanding 16-8 advantage in the opening frame, six of them coming with Brunsting at the service line. Chase Frishman had nine digs and was credited with the first kill of his college career. The result improved UCSD to a perfect 8-0 all-time against Hope International, the Tritons needing just three sets in seven of those match-ups.

TRITONS RECEIVING VOTES IN AVCA POLL

UCSD is among teams receiving votes outside of the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Division I-II Men's Coaches Top 15 Poll, released each Monday. The Tritons were last ranked on Jan. 28 at No. 13.

EBERTS APPROACHING EXCLUSIVE 1000-KILL CLUB

In his final season of college volleyball, senior outside hitter Carl Eberts needs 62 kills to become just the fifth player in program history to reach the 1,000-kill plateau. The product of Huntington Beach and Edison High School produced 89 kills as a redshirt freshman in 2010, before leading the squad in 2011 and 2012 with 326 and 335 kills, respectively. With 62 more kills, Eberts would join current members of the 1,000 Club and former teammates Jason Spangler (1,491; 2007-10) and Frank Fritsch (1,403; 2007-10), as well as Jim Waller (1,301; 2001-04) and former Triton women's volleyball head coach (2005-09) and current LMU women's coach Tom Black (1,268; 1993-96). Eberts once again paces the team through 17 matches this season with 188 kills (3.30/set). He ranks 14th in the conference.

VETERAN DUO MOVING UP ALL-TIME CHARTS

Carl Eberts and Chase Frishman are each moving up separate all-time lists in the UCSD men's volleyball record book. Eberts is currently ninth in kills with 938 (four away from Tyson Kerr in eighth). He is tied for seventh in digs (458), seventh in attacks (2,227) and also looking to enter the all-time list in the aces (50; four short) category. Frishman, meanwhile, is fifth with 577 digs, and is just 30 away from matching Chris Mortimer (2000-03) for second all-time in program history.

FRISHMAN REACHES DIGS MILESTONE

Senior libero Chase Frishman's first dig of the Jan. 25 meeting with Cal State Northridge marked career dig No. 500, making the Dana Point native just the sixth player in program history to reach that total. Frishman now has 577 for his career, having recently (Jan. 30 vs. Princeton) passed former teammate and star setter Phil Bannan for fifth-most all-time at UCSD.

SCOUTING CAL BAPTIST

Cal Baptist (6-9, 3-7 MPSF) enters Friday night's match as a loser of four straight, including two conference tilts already this week. The Lancers dropped a 3-1 home decision (21-25, 25-18, 25-21 and 25-21) to No. 4 Stanford on Monday night after winning the first set, and were beaten 3-2 at top-ranked UC Irvine on Wednesday night. Game scores in that one were 25-19, 25-19, 24-26, 16-25 and 15-11 as the Lancers rallied from a two-set deficit but fell in the end. All three of Cal Baptist's league wins this season, its first as a member of the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation, have come at home inside Van Dyne Gym. CBU holds a 16-7 advantage in the all-time series and is 10-1 against the Tritons in Riverside. UCSD has won two straight, however, including a five-set triumph in La Jolla in the first meeting this season between the teams on Jan. 17. Game scores in that back-and-forth affair were 19-25, 25-17, 17-25, 25-16 and 15-12. The Tritons' lone success in Riverside came on Mar. 9, 2005, by the score of 3-2. Wes Schneider is in his first season as the CBU head coach.

SCOUTING BYU

First-place BYU (11-3, 10-2 MPSF) last edged Stanford at home, 3-2, last Saturday night, Feb. 23, for its third victory in a row. The Cougars play at top-ranked defending national champion UC Irvine, a winner of 11 straight, on Friday night prior to traveling further south to RIMAC Arena on Saturday. True freshman outside hitter and Provo native Ben Patch is the reigning Sports Imports/AVCA National and MPSF Molten Player of the Week. Patch put down a career-high 26 kills (.465 hitting), just one kill shy of the 2013 MPSF season high, in the comeback triumph over Stanford. The Cougars hold a 33-0 all-time mastery of UCSD, and took a three-set decision (25-15, 25-19 and 25-23) in Provo, Utah, in this season's first meeting on Jan. 19. Chris McGown is in his second season as the head coach at his alma mater.

DOUBLE-DOUBLES

Mike Brunsting posted his second career double-double at No. 11 Pacific on Friday, Feb. 8, with match highs of 46 assists and 15 digs, the latter total also a career high for the junior setter. Cheyne Hayes had produced the season's first double-double by a Triton, against then-seventh-ranked Long Beach State on Jan. 5. Hayes had a team-high 18 kills to go along with a match-high 15 digs in the 3-2 loss to the 49ers in the third-place match of the UCSB Asics Invitational. Both totals were career highs. UCSD had two double-doubles during the 2012 season, by Carl Eberts (1/14 vs. NJIT: 15 kills and 11 digs) and Brunsting (1/14 vs. NJIT: 12 digs and 55 assists).

FIRST-EVER THREE-SET SWEEP OF USC

UCSD's 3-0 home defeat of then-eighth-ranked USC in its home opener on Jan. 10 marked the Tritons' first three-set sweep over the Trojans among seven wins all-time in 45 meetings. The result snapped a seven-match losing skid against USC.

LENNON SELECTED TO UCSB ASICS INVITATIONAL ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Junior outside hitter Vaun Lennon represented UCSD on the seven-player All-Tournament Team of the 2013 UC Santa Barbara Asics Invitational. He was the lone Triton to achieve double-digit kill totals in all three matches, with 13 in the come-from-behind win over Lewis, 12 against UCLA and 16 more in the third-place match versus Long Beach State. The Los Angeles native also produced seven digs in all three contests and was a UCSDtriton.com Athlete of the Week.

HEAD COACH KEVIN RING



The 2013 season is former Triton player Kevin Ring's eighth as head coach of the UCSD men's volleyball program.

Ring's 2012 squad finished with a 9-19 overall record and placed ninth in the ultra-competitive Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) with a 6-16 mark, narrowly missing a berth in the eight-team league tournament. UCSD recorded upsets over No. 3 UCLA, No. 9 Long Beach State, No. 11 Hawai'i, No. 12 UC Santa Barbara and No. 13 Cal State Northridge. The team strung together an unprecedented five-match win streak in league play, three of those victories on the road.

For the second straight year, the Tritons climbed to as high as No. 11 in the AVCA national poll.

Outside hitter Carl Eberts and libero Chase Frishman earned All-MPSF honorable mention. Outside hitter Vaun Lennon was tabbed the AVCA National Player of the Week in early April, becoming the second Triton to garner that distinction in the history of the program. Additionally, six players were named MPSF All-Academic in 2012.

UCSD finished with five MPSF wins in 2011, producing upsets at defending national champion and fourth-ranked Stanford, at No. 5 UCLA, at No. 7 UC Irvine, at No. 11 Pepperdine and at home against No. 11 Hawai'i. The sweep at Stanford marked not only the Tritons' first-ever triumph at Maples Pavilion, but also snapped the 18-match home win streak of the Cardinal.

On March 24, 2011, UCSD hosted third-ranked Ohio State and took a four-set victory over the Buckeyes, who went on to win the national championship.

Senior setter Phil Bannan was an All-MPSF Second Team selection after becoming UCSD's all-time leader in assists and service aces. Ring also graduated middle blocker Calvin Ross, who took over as the school's career leader in blocks. Four Tritons were named MPSF All-Academic in 2011.

In 2010, the Tritons were ranked in the top-15 nationally through the entire year and collected six conference wins for the campaign, including two each over UCLA and Pepperdine. Bannan picked up All-MPSF honorable mention for the second straight year.

Ring led the 2009 squad to its most successful in program history. The Tritons won a Division II-best 13 matches and nearly qualified for the MPSF Tournament, being eliminated during the final weekend of conference play. UCSD defeated several ranked teams, including a win over UCLA for the second consecutive season. The Tritons finished the year ranked No. 11 and Ring was named MPSF Coach of the Year.

While maintaining a high level of success on the court and in the classroom, Ring and his players have kept a clear focus on giving back to the community. For the past several years, the Tritons have held regular volleyball clinics with Big Brothers Big Sisters of San Diego County.

Before being elevated to the head-coaching position on June 15, 2005, Ring spent the previous nine years as an assistant for the UCSD men's squad. He served as the top assistant for Duncan McFarland in 1997 and 1998, for Jon Stevenson in 1999 and for Ron Larsen between 2000-05. Ring helped guide the Tritons to an NCAA Division III national championship in 2000.

In addition to his duties at UCSD, Ring was an adjunct faculty member in the Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry at the University of San Diego. He also served as an assistant coach for the Torero women's volleyball team in 2004-05.

Ring got his start at UCSD serving as the men's volleyball team manager from 1989-91 before playing on the team for three seasons.

Ring was the full-time team manager for the USA men's national team from 1991-93 and continued on as a technical advisor through 1996. He accompanied the national team to the 1992 Olympic Games in Barcelona and the 1996 Games in Atlanta. The 1992 squad left Spain with a bronze medal.

Ring earned two degrees from UCSD, graduating with a bachelor's degree in biochemistry in 1996, followed by a master's degree in chemistry in 1998. A native of Oregon, he played prep volleyball at Sheldon High School in Eugene.

BEST-EVER FOURTH-PLACE ASICS FINISH

UCSD made its first championship semifinal appearance at the UC Santa Barbara Asics Invitational on Friday, Jan. 4, after rallying to take down No. 5 Lewis in five sets earlier that day. With back-to-back 3-2 losses to UCLA and Long Beach State, the Tritons finished a best-ever fourth at the tourney. UCSD went an identical 1-2 but placed seventh in both 2010 and 2011.

EBERTS AND FRISHMAN BACK FOR ONE FINAL CAMPAIGN

The Tritons return their senior tandem of Carl Eberts and Chase Frishman in 2013 for one final season of their stellar college careers. The duo each earned All-Mountain Pacific Sports Federation honorable mention a year ago. Frishman recently garnered preseason All-America honorable mention from Off the Block. Eberts is a fifth-year senior out of Huntington Beach who red-shirted as a true freshman in 2009. Frishman, a native of Dana Point, is in his fourth year in the program. The only other senior on head coach Kevin Ring's 2013 roster is third-year Triton Greg Smith, a middle blocker out of Fullerton.

UCSD CAPTAINS

Team tri-captains for the 2013 season were designated as senior Carl Eberts and juniors Sebastian Brady and Vaun Lennon. Eberts is now a three-time captain in his fifth season in the program. He was co-captains with Brady in 2012. Lennon is in his first year as a Triton captain.

A PROUD TRADITION OF ACADEMIC AND ATHLETIC EXCELLENCE

UCSD had six players earn Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) All-Academic honors a season ago, with all six Tritons returning for the current 2013 campaign. Those players are seniors Carl Eberts and Chase Frishman, juniors Sebastian Brady, Mike Brunsting and Vaun Lennon, and sophomore Cheyenne Hayes. UCSD was tied with Pacific and Stanford for the most MPSF All-Academic players for 2012. Eberts is now a three-time selection while Frishman has earned the award in two successive years.

IN THE MPSF

Through matches played Feb. 24, Chase Frishman is fourth in the MPSF in digs at 2.39 per set and Carl Eberts is 14th in kills (3.30/set). Garrett Dempsey (7.71/set) and Mike Brunsting (5.86/set) are 12th and 13th, respectively, in assists, with Fred Stahl 15th in blocks (1.00/set). UCSD is third in team digs (9.41/set), sixth in opponent hitting percentage (.271), eighth in assists (11.57/set) and ninth in kills (12.17/set). Last year, Carl Eberts ranked 14th in both kills (3.22/set) and points (3.77/set), while Frishman was third in digs (2.28/set). UCSD ranked sixth in digs (8.60/set).

IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

Through matches played Feb. 24, Chase Frishman ranks 13th nationally in NCAA Division I-II in digs per set (2.39), Carl Eberts is 26th in kills per set (3.3), Fred Stahl is 26th in blocks per set (1.00) and Garrett Dempsey is 29th in assists per set (7.71). UCSD is 12th in digs per set (9.41), 16th in assists per set (11.57), 21st in kills per set (12.17), 22nd in hitting percentage (0.229) and 27th in blocks per set (2.05).
