Senior Infielder Garrett Tuck

On the offense coming around as the game progressed:

"The biggest thing we did was we just stuck to the plan we've had all year. We weren't getting runs in the beginning (of the game). We weren't doing what we wanted to do. We were hitting balls hard, but things weren't going our way. We stayed with it, and finally some balls dropped and we got some runs."

On how he has felt at the plate of late and his ninth-inning at-bat:

"I feel fine. I tried to not make it that big of a moment (in the ninth). We were tied, and I knew if I got out, nothing terribly bad was going to happen. We were just going to keep playing, so I just took it as another at-bat, and it went my way."
