The No. 3-seeded University of Dayton women's soccer team looks to keep its postseason journey going Wednesday night as the Flyers travel to Philadelphia to take on No. 2-seed La Salle at 7 p.m. at McCarthy Stadium.

### WILSON WINS IT

• Senior Madison Wilson came up clutch for the Flyers in their Atlantic 10 Tournament opener against Saint Joseph's, scoring the game-winning goal in the 87th minute for her third game-winner of the season.

• Junior Noel Blain started the scoring play with a beautiful feed to senior Natalie Hegg, who then sent a pass back post for Wilson. The London, Ontario native drove home the goal with a header, giving UD a 1-0 advantage and eventual win.

• It was the sixth goal of the season for Wilson, who came into the campaign with just three total goals in her career. She is now the team leader in points with 16.

### CONTINUING THE CLIMB

• The Flyers moved up to No. 24 in the latest College Soccer News Top 30 this week, inching ahead one spot from last week's No. 25 ranking.

### STIFLING DEFENSE

• Dayton has had 11 total shutouts this season, finishing Atlantic 10 play with eight clean sheets and allowing just two goals.

• Leading the way for the defensive effort has been sophomore Batoul Reda, who has been nothing short of the best keeper in the Atlantic 10 this season. The Dearborn, Mich. native leads the A-10 in shutouts (10), goals against average (.500), save percentage (.900) and shutouts per game (.556).

• The combination of the backline defenders (Alicia Donley, Mackenzie Lutz, Ella Raimondi and Kyra Karfonta), as well as the defensive midfielders (Marlee Taylor and Yaiza Navarro Leon) have held opponents to a league-leading 0.526 goals per game.

### UNDEFEATED OCTOBER

• Dayton comes into Wednesday evening's game riding a six-match winning streak that started Oct. 1 at George Washington.

• Overall UD is on a 12-match unbeaten streak (8-0-4).

### STREAKING!

• Dayton's current six-match winning streak matches the longest in UD women's soccer history, matching the mark set by the 2013 team.

• The Flyers' last six-match streak came against Central Michigan, Toledo, Richmond, George Mason, Massachusetts and Rhode Island. UD would go on to fall in the A-10 Championship to La Salle in penalty kicks.

• UD has had five total instances of five or more consecutive wins, winning five in a row in 2001, 2004, and 2009 in addition to the aforementioned six-match streaks.

### SERIES HISTORY VS. LA SALLE

• Dayton and La Salle have played 31 times in program history, dating back to 1992, with the Flyers holding the all-time edge at 19-10-2.

• UD and La Salle have played three times in the Atlantic 10 Tournament, with the record split at 1-1-1. The Explorers advanced on penalty kicks in the one draw.

• Dayton is 8-8 all-time against La Salle when playing in McCarthy Stadium, including seven consecutive losses to the Explorers in Philadelphia.

• The Flyers last played at La Salle in the 2019 season when they played there twice. Once, a 3-2 loss in the regular season on Oct. 27, then again the following week as part of the A-10 Tournament, losing 1-0.

### SCOUTING THE FLYERS

• Madison Wilson leads the offense with a team-best 16 points (6 goals, 4 assists), while Laney Huber has the team's lead in goals (7).

• Keeper Batoul Reda leads the Atlantic 10 in save percentage, goals per game and shutouts.

### SCOUTING THE EXPLORERS

• La Salle comes into Wednesday's semifinal with an overall record of 11-5-3. The Explorers earned the No. 2 seed thanks to an 8-1-1 record in Atlantic 10 play.

• Haley Gschrey leads the team in points (16) thanks in large part to a team-best seven goals. Justyce Hollenbach, Emily Banashefski, Elizabeth Estrada and Ricshya Walker all finished the season with 10+ points.

• Michela Aaguadro has played 17 games in goal this season, boasting a 1.05 goals-against average with a .776 save percentage.

**TAYLOR'S BIG WEEK**

• Fifth-year Marlee Taylor had a big week for the Flyers Oct. 12-15, scoring a goal and registering an assist in both wins in her role as a box-to-box midfielder.

• The Plymouth, Mich. native earned a spot on both the Top Drawer Soccer Team of the Week and the College Soccer News Team of the Week thanks to her performance.

• In addition, Taylor was named No. 99 on the Top Drawer Soccer Midseason National Top 100 (Oct. 13).

**CLIMBING THE RANKS**

• Fifth-year senior Mackenzie Lutz is climbing the Flyers' all-time leaderboard for minutes played by a field player, now sitting in second in program history.

• The Sylvania, Ohio native has logged 7,715 minutes in her career, becoming just the sixth Flyer field player to surpass the 7,000 minute mark. She passed Kathleen Beljan (7,535) Emily Kenyon (7,556) in the final game of the regular season at Rhode Island.

• Kelsey Miller (2008-11) holds the program record for minutes played by a field player at 8,159.

**PLAYER OF THE WEEK WINNERS**

*Reda Earns Another Defensive POW*

• Batoul Reda was named Atlantic 10 Defensive Player of the Week Monday, Oct. 16.

• The sophomore led the Flyers to a 3-0 win over George Mason and a 2-0 victory over Loyola Chicago, helping lower UD's goals allowed average to an Atlantic 10-leading 0.59.

• Reda faced only four shots in Dayton's shutout of George Mason to start the week, stopping both that were on-goal. The keeper turned around to face 14 total shots against Loyola Chicago on Sunday, making saves on all seven that were on-goal.

*Bowman Named A-10 Rookie of the Week*

• Freshman Maddie Bowman scored the first goal of her collegiate career to give Dayton a 1-0 road win at VCU on Sunday to pave the way to earning Atlantic 10 Co-Rookie of the Week.

• The Saint Louis native lofted the game-winner over the keeper to the upper 90 in the 71st minute, giving the Flyers a crucial three road points with three matches to play.

*Benigno Named Offensive POW*

• Senior midfielder Diana Benigno was named Atlantic 10 Co-Offensive Player of the Week Monday, Sept. 25, after playing a key role in Dayton's 1-0-1 week.

• The Beavercreek, Ohio native picked up an assist in the Flyers 3-0 victory over Davidson and scored the Flyers' game-tying goal in the 1-1 draw at Saint Louis.

*Blain Earns Offensive POW*

• Junior Noel Blain Dayton gave Dayton its third Atlantic 10 Player of the Week honoree of the season, earning the league's Offensive Player of the Week award Sept. 5.

• Blain led Dayton's high-scoring offense with seven points on the week, scoring a pair of goals and adding an assist in UD's 5-2 win over Akron, and coming back to score another goal in a 3-0 victory over Wright State on Sunday. In total, Blain registered 14 shots and nine on goal for the week.

*Reda Named Defensive POW*

• Sophomore forward Batoul Reda was named Atlantic 10 Defensive Player of the Week Aug. 28.

• Reda had a fantastic week in net for the Flyers. In their win over the Cardinals, Reda set a new career-high with nine saves while facing 17 total shots. In the Flyers' first shutout of the season, the Dearborn, Mich. native stopped six Illini shots and registered her first clean sheet of the 2023 campaign and seventh of her career.

*Wessner Wins A-10 offensive pow*

• Sophomore forward Mairin Wessner was rewarded by the Atlantic 10 for her strong start to the 2023 campaign, garnering the league's first Offensive Player of the Week award.

• Wessner led the Flyers' high-scoring offense with three total goals and an assist for seven points in Dayton's opening week of action. After scoring her first goal of the season in UD's 4-1 win over Loyola Maryland, she came back to score two goals and tally an assist against in-state foe Cincinnati in another 4-1 Flyer victory.

## HEAD COACH ERIC GOLZ

Eric Golz was named head coach of the Dayton women's soccer program by Vice President/Director of Athletics Neil Sullivan on Dec. 20, 2016. Golz became the fourth coach in the history of the program, taking over for Mike Tucker, who retired after leading the Flyers for 22 seasons.

2022 marked a continued rise for the Flyers under Golz in his sixth season at the helm, winning 16 games on the season, UD's most in over a decade. The Flyers once again played for the Atlantic 10 Championship, marking the 25th consecutive year Dayton has earned an A-10 Tournament berth. UD continued its trend of team contributions, as 11 different student-athletes tallied goals on the season, while five individuals were honored by the Atlantic 10. Itala Gimelli and Mackenzie Lutz earned All-Atlantic 10 First Team honors and Alicia Donley was named All-Atlantic 10 Second Team. Freshmen Ella Raimondi and Batoul Reda were both tabbed to the Atlantic 10 All-Rookie team. Gemelli (First Team), Donley (Third Team) and Lutz (Third Team) were each honored by the United Soccer Coaches Association as All-Region honorees. The Flyers also earned United Soccer Coaches Team Academic Award for the 14th consecutive season.

The Flyers rode the momentum of a strong spring campaign to a 12-6-2 finish in the fall of 2021. The season included a five-match win streak and gave Golz his first season in Dayton with double-digit wins. Sophomore Itala Gimelli was named the Atlantic 10 Offensive Player of the Year, as well as All-Atlantic 10 First Team. She was joined in postseason honors by All-Atlantic 10 Second Team honorees Laney Huber and Marlee Taylor, and Academic All-Conference member Jessica Sheldon. Huber was named to the Atlantic 10 All-Championship team.

Golz came to the Flyers after two seasons as head coach at Illinois State University. In 2016, Illinois State (14-6-3) went on the longest unbeaten streak in program and Missouri Valley Conference history, going 15 matches without a loss. The Redbirds closed out the 2016 campaign with a 3-1 loss at Duke in the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The Redbirds finished as the MVC Regular Season Champions and MVC Tournament Champions and Golz and his staff were named the 2016 MVC Coaching Staff of the Year.
