#### **#FLYBOYS TRAVEL TO NO. 9 LOUISVILLE FOR WEEKEND SET**

After opening the 2023 season at Woerner Field at AES Ohio Stadium over the weekend, the FlyBoys return to the road to take on No. 9 Louisville at Jim Patterson Stadium.

Dayton and Louisville have played one another 12 times in program history, dating back to their first meeting in 1953. The last time the Flyers and Cardinals played was in 1999, with Louisville taking the best-of-three series, two games to one.

#### **EVERYDAY EDDIE - A-10 ROOKIE OF THE WEEK**

Freshman Eddie Yamin IV earned the first Atlantic 10 weekly award for the #FlyBoys this week, being named the A-10's Rookie of the Week Wednesday, March 8.

Yamin was a menace to Eastern Illinois pitching during the #FlyBoys home-opening series, slugging three extra-base hits including his first

During Dayton's second game against the Panthers, Yamin left the vard as part of back-to-back-to-back homers in the third inning, and then picked the perfect time to launch his second of the season four innings later. With the Flyers trailing 6-5 and a man on first, Yamin deposited his second homer of the game beyond the left field fence to put UD back on top 7-6. Dayton held on to that lead for the second win of the season.

Yamin kept things rolling against Miami Wednesday, knocking an eighth-inning, two-run double to left-center field to put the FlyBoys ahead for their third victory in their last five games

#### **POWER HOUR**

After picking up their first win of the 2023 campaign in Game One of a doubleheader against Eastern Illinois Saturday, March 4, the FlyBoys came out swinging in game two, slugging five home runs, including backto-back-to-back jacks in the third inning.

Senior Marcos Pujols launched his second homer of the season to start the outburst in the third. It was the 29th of his career and officially entered him into Dayton's Top 5 all-time. Freshman Eddie Yamin IV then hammered his first collegiate home run, and junior Michael Adair followed with his first home run as a Flyer.

An inning later, sophomore catcher **Matt Maloney** left the yard for his first collegiate homer to tie Dayton with EIU at 4-4.

After the Panthers got a go-ahead home run in the top of the seventh inning. Yamin stepped to the plate and deposited his second long ball of the day beyond the left field wall to give Dayton its final lead of 7-6.

#### **MANFREDI MAGIC**

The FlyBoys' received one of their best start of the season by a member of the rotation Saturday in Game Two against Eastern Illinois, as senior **Mark Manfredi** pitched into the sixth and allowed just two earned runs while striking out nine. Manfredi leads the pitching staff with 16 strikeouts on the campaign.

The senior's final line against EIU was 5.1 IP, 6 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 9 K.

#### **WELCOME BACK KEAGAN!**

Senior **Keagan Calero** made his first career start in the outfield during Dayton's game against Miami Wednesday, March 8, and the return of his bat was welcome to the FlyBoys lineup.

Calero reached base four times in the contest with two walks and two hits, including his first triple of the season.

#### **SCOUTING THE CARDINALS**

Louisville has started the season with a bang, winning 11-of-12 in the early going. The lone blemish came in week two to Bowling Green.

The Cardinals are hitting a robust .336 as a team this season with 17 home runs and an on-base percentage of .431. Jack Payton and Eddie King Jr. both turn in averages of .400 or better, with Payton hitting an incredible .467 and King turning in a .400 average.

On the mound, the Louisville starting rotation is one of the tops in the country, led by Ryan Hawks and his 0.46 ERA. Greg Farone and Carson Liggett round out the rotation and turn in 1.46 and 1.53 ERAs, respectively.

The Cardinals were picked at the top of the Atlantic Coast Conference Preseason Poll.

#### LAST TIME OUT

Dayton got back to its winning ways with a mid-week victory over Miami (Ohio) on Wednesday by a 7-5 final.

After the RedHawks battled back to knot the score at 5-5, Freshman Eddie Yamin IV smashed a two-out, two-run double to put the Flyers ahead 7-5 in the bottom of the eighth inning.

Reliever **Parker Bard** bridged the gap from the starter to the back end of the bullpen with five strong innings of work. The junior tossed five frames of one-hit ball, striking out eight and only walking one.

Junior **Nick Wissman** picked up the win while **Matthew Johnson** registered his first save.

#### **PRESEASON POLL**

Dayton was picked fifth in the 2023 Atlantic 10 Preseason Poll, picking up one first place vote and 92 total votes.

Davidson finished with the most points (130) and VCU the second-most (125), while both garnered five first place votes.

Richmond and Saint Louis each tallied 103 points, with the Spiders earning a first place vote.

In 2019, the Flyers went 32-26-1 and advanced all the way to the championship game in the Atlantic 10  $\,$ Tournament. The team's 32 wins were also the program's most since the 2011 season. Dayton also set the program record with 491 strikeouts by Dayton pitchers.

Prior to UD, King was most recently the Associate Head Coach and Recruiting Coordinator at Army West Point after spending the previous 18 seasons as head coach at NCAA Division II Franklin Pierce. In his first season in Division I, King produced the No. 33 overall recruiting class as ranked by Perfect Game, with 24 high school commitments from 14 states.

A 1993 graduate of Framingham State College, King received a bachelor's degree in sociology while playing four seasons for the Rams. He went on to earn his master's degree in physical education in 1996 from Springfield College. King and his wife, Missy, have one daughter, Katie, and one son, Justin.

# RYAN STEINHAUER LHP | Senior | 6-3 | 195 lbs. Saline, Mich. //Lansing C.C.

Steinhauer has solidified himself as part of Dayton's weekend rotation after making 11 starts for the FlyBoys in the 2022 campaign. The left-hander led the Flyers and ranked 11th in the Atlantic 10 with 63 strikeouts across 53.1 innings of work. Steinhauer ranked second in the Atlantic 10 with a .208 batting average against and allowed the fewest hits in the conference among qualified pitchers. In his first

season with the FlyBoys, Steinhauer finished 3-4 with a 4.39 ERA.
