MEDICAL WAIVER

CAMP DIRECTOR JAYSON KING

Head Coach
University of Dayton Baseball



- King has returned to be the head coach at Dayton after spending one season as an assistant coach at Vanderbilt, helping the Commodores earn the No. 1 seed in the NCAA postseason. The 2026 season will be his eighth season with the Flyboys. King's 165 wins at Dayton make him the second winningest baseball coach for Dayton.

- Four Flyers have been drafted under King's tutelage, with UD's highest draft pick in program history coming in 2024 when Nick Wissman was taken in the eighth round by the San Diego Padres. Riley Tirota (Toronto) and Mariano Ricciardi (Oakland) were taken in the 2021 draft. Mark Manfredi was drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in 2023.

- King led Franklin Pierce to 10 NE-10 Conference Championships, seven NCAA Northeast Regional appearances, and seven trips to the NCAA DII College World Series. Twenty-five of his student-athletes were drafted Baseball First-Year Player Draft in his time at Franklin Pierce.

ASSISTANT CAMP DIRECTOR PETE SASS

- Sass joined the University of Dayton baseball staff as a volunteer assistant in January of 2022 and was promoted to full-time assistant prior to the 2023 season.

- He served as the primary recruiter for the 2023 and 2024 classes, both nationally ranked by Perfect Game.

- Sass was also the first base coach, playing a hand in the FlyBoys' 118 steals in 2024, the third-best stolen base performance in a single-season.



PROSPECT CAMP

This camp will allow you to experience “What it takes” to play college baseball at all levels (NCAA I, II, III, NAIA and NJCAA). This is an intense camp unlike any other and is designed for athletes who desire intensive and in-depth instruction.

The Prospect Camp will break down the defensive skills of all positions, the mechanics of the swing, and gives student-athletes the opportunity to showcase their skills.

We expect sessions to be full. We will take 100 participants on a first-come, first-serve basis until the session is filled.

TRACKMAN REPORTS

TrackMan is what the FlyBoys use to measure hitting and pitching analytics. You can purchase either pitcher, hitter, or both.

ABOUT THE CAMP

FACILITIES

The session will be conducted at Woerner Field at AES Ohio Stadium, home of the Dayton Flyers. An itinerary will be sent out a few days prior to the event with locations, directions, and parking instructions.

WHAT TO BRING/WEAR

Practice clothes, helmet, baseball glove, baseball bat (optional), sneakers, and a water bottle. It is recommended for catchers to bring a full set of catcher's gear. *No metal cleats will be allowed.*

INDIVIDUALIZED ATTENTION

The Prospect Camp allows for hands-on experience with direct feedback from the coaching staff. Players will learn and develop their abilities with individualized attention allowing for greater player development.

TRACKMAN ANALYTICS

Beginning in Fall 2019, Dayton Baseball added the opportunity for campers to receive additional analytical insights to their game. TrackMan is what the FlyBoys use to measure hitting and pitching analytics. You can purchase either pitcher, hitter, or both.

CAMP FEES INCLUDE

T-shirt, instructions, mental skills development, and individual evaluation.

MEDICAL CARE

An experienced athletic trainer will be present during each session. Medical waiver forms must be completed prior to registration.

ADDITIONAL INFO / CANCELLATION POLICY

Payment for camp is non-refundable. If you cannot attend for any reason you can allocate payments towards future camps. Documented health issues that preclude attendance will be the only refundable circumstance.

CAMPUS TOUR
