HOUSTON NOTES

WIN COLUMN: Houston picked up its first victory on Tuesday, defeating McNeese, 3-2, in Lake Charles, Louisiana.

- » The Cougars made the most of their two hits and scored the winning run in the sixth on an RBI-fielder's choice from shortstop **Ian McMillan**.
- » Cougar pitching struck out 16 McNeese batters with a career-high seven coming in relief from **Ben Sears**.

GETTING DEFENSIVE: Through four games, Houston ranks 13th nationally in fielding percentage (.992). The Cougars' lone error in 133 chances came on Opening Day against Cal.

INJURY BUG: Houston had three student-athletes exit due to injury on Opening Weekend.

- » In the second inning Friday, starting right fielder **Nick DeNicola** laced a single into center before getting a spike caught heading to second. He exited with an Achilles injury and is expected to miss significant time.
- » In the eighth inning Saturday, reliever **Jackson Dannelley** retired his lone batter before departing.
- » In the third inning Sunday, reliever **José Torrealba** was drilled in the left thigh with a line drive and exited. He returned Tuesday in a relief appearance at McNeese.

HI, I'M _____: Houston returns 14 lettermen and welcomes 24 newcomers to its 2022 ballclub.

- » Houston is eyeing a return to dominance in 2022. Between 2014-18, the Cougars won five American Athletic Conference titles and advanced to four NCAA Tournaments. Since then, they have gone 57-70.
- » Houston was picked to finish seventh in The American after finishing in seventh a season ago.

FRESH FACES: Houston welcomed three new coaches to the staff this offseason including pitching coach **Kyle Bunn**, hitting coach **Ross Kivett** and volunteer assistant **Tyler Bielamowicz**.

- » Bunn brings 17 years of coaching experience. His 2021 Middle Tennessee staff led the nation in fewest walks per nine innings (2.42) and were 10th in WHIP (1.22).
- » Kivett was a volunteer assistant for four seasons at Tennessee including the 2021 College World Series run.
- » Bielamowicz was a five-year letterwinner at Houston and second-team all-AAC honoree in 2021.

SERIES HISTORY: Houston is 32-0 all-time against Texas Southern while head coach **Todd Whitting** is 10-0. The Cougars are 26-22-1 all-time against UTRGV.

- » The Cougars swept Texas Southern on Opening Weekend a season ago. Houston batted .354 highlighted by 10 doubles, five home runs and 60 total bases.
- » UTRGV outlasted Houston, 6-5, in its last visit to Schroeder Park (Feb. 25, 2020). Houston and UTRGV first met during the 1948 season.

HOME SWEET HOME: Houston opens a seven-game homestand with its Friday matchup against Texas Southern.

- » The Cougars are coming off a four-game, two-state road trip. It marked the first time since 2004 Houston had opened a season with four straight away from home.

2022 SCHEDULE: The Cougars ...

- » Host 32 games at Schroeder Park.
- » Play 37 games inside the state of Texas.
- » Play games against 12 different conferences, twice as many as a season ago (six).
- » Play games in seven different states.

TODD'S 12TH: The 2022 season is the 12th for **Todd Whitting** as head coach of his alma mater (Houston '95).

- » During his career, Whitting has been part of programs that have won 21 conference titles and competed in 17 NCAA Regionals, six NCAA Super Regionals and one College World Series (2010 - TCU).
- » Whitting has tutored 90-plus student-athletes selected in the MLB Draft including 24 Major Leaguers.

FEBRUARY FORTUNE: Houston is 61-30 in 91 February contests under head coach **Todd Whitting** (2011-present).

- » The Cougars have posted a winning record in February during nine of the last 11 seasons.
- » Houston went 6-1 in February a season ago, batting .324 including 8.8 runs and 2.85 home runs per game.

WICKED HITTAH: Houston senior, and Boston native, **Ryan Hernandez** has been recognized as a preseason all-conference honoree by Perfect Game at designated hitter.

- » Hernandez led Houston in hits (52), RBIs (37), home runs (11) and total bases (90) a season ago.
- » In 15 games during 2020, Hernandez led the Cougars with a .300 average, 18 hits and 13 runs.

PACE SETTER: Houston has been a force since joining the American Athletic Conference (2014-present). Here's a closer look where the Cougars ranked entering the 2022 season.

THOR'S HAMMER: Houston's home run tradition, Thor's hammer was introduced by former standout first baseman **Joe Davis** around the start of conference play in 2017. Made by his brother, John, a sheet-metal worker using scrap parts at work, the hammer is exchanged between the players, residing with team's most recent home run hitter.

AT THE HELM: Head Coach **Todd Whitting** is in his 12th season at the helm of his alma mater. Whitting ranks third in program history for victories.

NEW HOME: The Cougars moved into the Houston Baseball Player Development Center on Jan. 5, 2020.

- » The facility, located down the left field line, features 20,000 square-feet with state-of-the-art amenities, including locker room, player lounge, training room, hydrotherapy room, weight room, a pitching lab and a golf simulator.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN: Houston introduced "boat crew captains" to the program in the fall, as eight players were elected by their teammates in an effort to create a player-led team.

- » Captains include: **Zach Arnold, Derrick Cherry, Ryan Hernandez, Ian McMillan, Rey Mendoza, Maddux Miller and Ben Sears.**

REMEMBERING THE ALTABELLI FAMILY: For a third consecutive season, the Cougars pay tribute to the Altobelli family by wearing a decal "JKA ALTO" with each of their initials on their batting helmets throughout 2021.

- » **John Altobelli** was a former letterwinner and assistant coach who perished along with his wife, Keri and daughter Alyssa, in a helicopter accident that claimed nine lives including NBA legend Kobe Bryant and his daughter, Gianna, on Jan. 26, 2020.

ROSTER MANAGEMENT: A closer look at how Houston's 2022 roster shakes out (full breakdown on pages 22-23):

- » 13 different states represented
- » 23 players from Texas
- » 17 players with JUCO experience
- » 12 players with additional Division I experience

2021 REVIEW: Houston (19-34, 7-21 AAC) struggled during the 2021 season, finishing seventh in The American.

- » The Cougars hit .239 as a team (262nd nationally) and recorded a 5.34 ERA (151st nationally).
- » The season also looked vastly different, featuring four-game conference series with no midweek matchups once American Athletic Conference play began.

BIG 12 BOUND: On Sept. 9, 2021, the University of Houston accepted an invitation to join the Big 12 Conference.

- » Houston will begin Big 12 competition as soon as the fall of 2023. This will be the seventh conference in which Houston Athletics competes during its history.

75-YEAR CELEBRATION: The University of Houston is celebrating "75 years of Houston Athletics" with festivities and tributes planned throughout the 2021-22 sports calendar as the department pays homage to its rich history and tradition by spotlighting its greatest student-athletes and coaches.

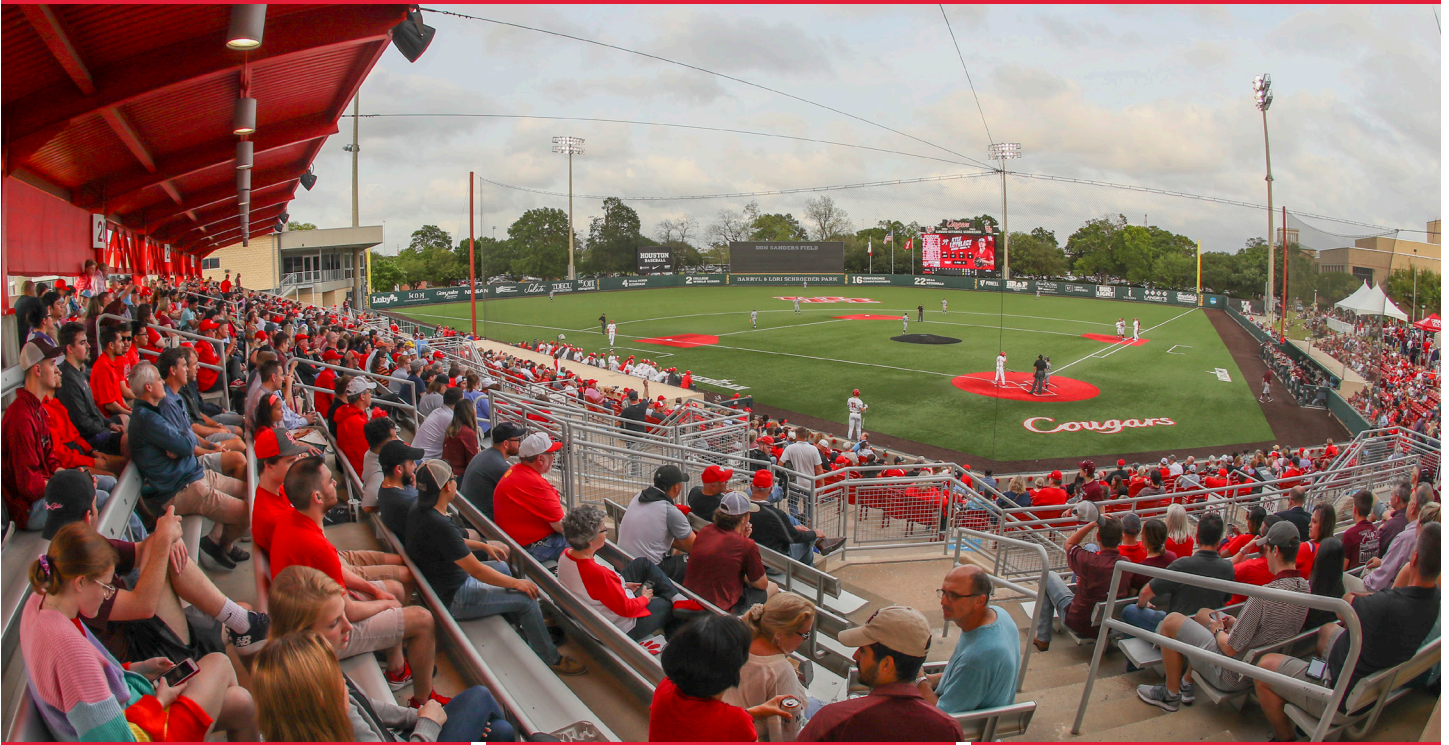
