Head Coach Grant Teaff: "This was a big win. Anytime you can come to the Astrodome and beat the team that played in the Cotton Bowl last year you have to be happy, no matter how you do it. We did have a lot of problems, but I thought we showed a lot of character being able to hand on. Our defense started out playing just super and we got enough points to go ahead, then Landry got hot and the receivers came up with some great catches. When it came down to the final moments, our defense did what it had to do. Our offense had two good drives that didn't get any points but did at least eat up some of the clock. This is a great win for this team. We just weren't supposed to be in the thick of things like this. I have got to say I think Houston will go a long way. They will beat some people and be in the thick of the conference race. Landry is the prototype Houston quarterback. He puts so much pressure on you. I think he will take them a long way."

HOUSTON QUOTES:

Head Coach Bill Yeoman: "We made too many mental mistakes. A hold here, a clipping there and we are not a good enough team to make those kind of mistakes and win. You certainly can't make them against a good football team."

On Harper's injury: "I don't know how bad his leg is, but he may be out 2 to 3 weeks. I don't know how many injuries we have, but we do have a bunch of bruises, but that is going to happen when ever you bump heads."

On second half passing: "They had seven guys hitting the line of scrimmage and we were playing catch-up. Gerald did a real good job throwing the ball. He did come up with a pull in the first half. We will just have to wait and see how bad it is."

On defense: "We didn't do a good job of picking up their third man coming out of the backfield."

Randy Thornton: "It's just one of those things. We lost mentally, they didn't beat us we beat ourselves. (on last pass break-up) I wish I could of caught that ball, I don't know if I made the right or wrong decision. I was positive we would come back, they can't say it was an easy game to win."

Gerald Landry: "If we had more time I think we could of come back and won the game. We always get ourselves in trouble by making mistakes. (on his injury) I felt better the second half, but the thigh was still immobile and I couldn't run good."

Everett Brown: "(on official's non-interference call) If I didn't trip, hopefully I would of caught it and it would have been a first down. It was a good throw by Gerald. (on team) It is not going to get any easier. We all know that we have to work 100% up to our last game."

Todd Schoppe: "We just messed-up, that's all I can say. We just have to pick our heads-up and get us a win next week. I expected them to be good, but I expected us to get the ball moving. We started making our move too late. It is the same old thing, mental mistakes here and there."

Gary McGuire: We were ready to play. We had chances to turn it around and cash in on us holding Baylor, but just couldn't do it. For a while, I think, we played a great defensive game. Baylor isn't as good as everyone says."
