NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS HISTORY

In 1956 the University of Houston began a dynasty that is unparalleled in all of college sports. Beginning that season, Houston dominated the college golf world, winning 12 of the next 15 NCAA golf championships. The Cougars have won 16 titles, and incredibly, finished second four times and third four other times. A Cougar has won the individual championship eight times, which only trails Yale (13). The following is a year-by-year look at the NCAA Championships since 1952.

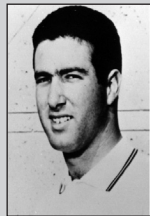

on PROFESSIONAL TOURS

Houston golfers have earned a combined \$147,327,841 on professional tours during their careers.

The University of Houston has carried a tradition forged on the collegiate level and continuing to the professional ranks. From Dave Marr and John Mahaffey in the 1960s and 70s to Fred Couples, Steve Elkington and Bruce Lietzke in the 90s, former UH players have continued to make indelible marks on the landscape of the PGA Tour in the 21st century.

Houston Alumni have won at least one championship at all four major tournaments on the PGA Tour and have claimed a combined total of 22 first or second-place finishes in The Masters, the Open Championship, the U.S. Open and the PGA Championship. Over the years, decades of success as a collegiate golf program has propelled many

University of Houston golfers on to success in the professional ranks on the PGA, European, Nationwide, Korn Ferry and Champions Tours.

A few of those players have become household names. 1992 Masters champion Fred Couples is one of the most successful golfers of all time and ranks among the PGA Top 75 on the all-time career earnings list.

Two-time All-American Steve Elkington led Houston to its most recent national championship in 1985 but has made his mark on the PGA Tour more recently than that, winning the 1995 PGA Championship and the 1997 Tour Player's Championship to move into an elite group. Elkington missed defending his PGA Championship by only one stroke in 1996.

Bill Rogers was a regular on the PGA Tour in the late 70s and early 80s, highlighted by his victory at the 1981 Open Championship.

Other Cougars have been fixtures on the PGA Tour for years, quietly successful and occasionally more famous. They are familiar names like Billy Ray Brown, Keith Fergus, Bruce Lietzke, John Mahaffey and Blaine McCallister. All enjoyed tremendous success at Houston before moving on to the professional ranks.

Some of the most famous names on Tour are those you may not even recognize as Cougars. Fuzzy Zoeller, winner of the 1984 U.S. Open and 1979 Masters, and Nick Faldo, who owns six major championships, both played at Houston, if rather briefly, before taking their games to the next level.

With a golf history that goes back to the first national championship in 1956, it makes sense that Houston exes populate the PGA Champions Tour too. Homero Blancas was an All-American in 1961 and 1962 and had his top year as a pro in 1994. Kermit Zarley, Rocky Thompson and Rex Baxter are other famous Cougs from the past who earned a living in the professional ranks.
