- » The first game between Rice and Houston was in 1948.
- » Todd Whitting is 18-22 against Rice while at the helm of the Cougars.
- » Houston is 6-4 over the last 10 meetings.

NEWS AND NOTES

- » Second baseman Harold Coll set a career-best with five RBI on Saturday against BYU, driving in two on a home run and then a three-RBI double in the eighth inning.
- » Houston's 5,547 fans over the three-game series against Baylor was the seventh-largest three-game series crowd in program history.
- » Right-handed pitcher Duncan Howard has not allowed a walk in four starts this season. He is the only pitcher in Division I that has not allowed a walk this season.
- » The Cougars' conference opening sweep of Baylor was just the fourth conference opening series sweep by a Todd Whitting team (2024, 2018, 2013, 2011)
- » Houston was perfect in extra-inning games in 2023 (6-0) and is 1-1 so far this year after playing two extra-inning games at the Astros Foundation College Classic.
- » Murray's three-double performance against Louisiana was the first three-double game by a Cougar since Lael Lockhart Jr. at Memphis on 4/13/17.
- » Second baseman Harold Coll broke the Astros Foundation College Classic record for stolen bases in a game when he swiped a career-high three bags against Louisiana.
- » Right-handed pitcher Jaxon Jelkin was named to the Astros Foundation College Classic All-Tournament team after striking out eight hitters in 5.1 innings.
- » Houston's 27 runs against Prairie View were the most since 1993 when the Cougars scored 27 against Illinois State.
- » The Cougars' 27 runs against Prairie View are tied for the second-most runs scored in a game in program history.
- » First baseman Justin Murray had his 22-game hitting streak snapped against UTSA. It matched Brett Cooley's 22-game hit streak back in 2002.
- » Murray and shortstop Jake Rainess were named NCBWA Preseason All-Americans. Murray was named Second Team Utility while Rainess was tabbed Third Team Shortstop.
- » The Cougars have won 1,997 games in program history.

ALL-JUSTIN MURRAY

- » Senior Justin Murray played just about everywhere but catcher in 2023. The senior played in 57 of the team's 59 games and appeared 25 times out of the bullpen, mostly after playing a corner infield position or designated hitter.
- » Murray led the team in average (.379) and slugging (.598) and finished second on the team in home runs (11). On the mound, Murray paced the team with 10 saves, good for 25th nationally, and posted 49 strikeouts over 41.0 innings.
- » The Dartmouth transfer earned All-America honors and All-Region honors after being named American Athletic Conference Newcomer Position Player of the Year and an All-Conference First-Team selection.

STELLAR DEFENSE

» For the second-straight year, the Cougars boasted one of the best defenses in the country — posting the seventh-best fielding percentage in the country (.982) while turning the fifth-most double plays nationally (56).

ELEVATED RESULTS, ELEVATED TITLE

- » After a strong offensive season by the Cougars assistant coach Ross Kivett was promoted to associate head coach for 2024 by head coach Todd Whitting.
- » The move comes after Houston ranked 39th nationally in hits and the Cougars won every conference series for the first time in school history.

ROSTER MAKEUP

- » Houston's roster features 22 newcomers including 14 transfers and 8 freshmen.
- » UH has no shortage of innings pitched on its staff with six pitchers tossing at least 70.0 innings at the Division I level.

MLB DRAFT FACTORY

- » Houston's **45** draft picks under head coach Todd Whitting continues to be a recruiting staple.
- » 11 Cougars have made their MLB debuts after playing for the head coach in Houston with three former Cougars making their Big League debuts in 2023.

NEW COACHES KENNY & REIDA

- » With 27 years of coaching experience, Kenny brings a wealth of knowledge to the Houston Baseball program. Kenny has spent the last 14 seasons with Power 5 programs and tutored 45 pitchers selected in the MLB Draft. A former New York Mets draft pick, Kenny spent the previous seven seasons as the pitching coach at the University of Georgia.
- » A native of Ann Arbor, Mich., Kenny followed head coach Erik Bakich to the University of Michigan after three seasons at the University of Maryland. With the Wolverines, Kenny tutored 10 pitchers selected in the MLB Draft while his staff consistently ranked at the top of the Big Ten Conference in multiple categories, helping the program to two NCAA postseason appearances.

D1BASEBALL PREVIEWS THE COUGARS

» Strengths

One thing I love about this Houston club is the fact it has a ton of experience. That's important in college baseball. The Cougars have six seniors in their everyday lineup, and that includes veterans at important positions like catcher with Anthony Tulimero, along with second baseman Harold Coll, and of course, fifth-year player Jake Rainess, a talented transfer from Maine. There's also experience on the mound, where Antoine Jean and Jaxon Jelkin lead the charge. There's no reason why this Houston team shouldn't be able to build off last year's 36-win campaign.

» Question Marks

Houston had some turnover during the offseason as pitching coach Kyle Bunn left the program. The Cougars then hired former Georgia pitching coach Sean Kenny, who has a strong reputation in the industry. The biggest key for the Cougars this spring is to stay healthy on the mound. That didn't happen last season, and UH still managed to win 36 games. UH has a veteran in the weekend rotation in Antoine Jean, and German product righthanded pitcher Paul Schmitz has big-time potential. But the bell cow of this group is junior college transfer righthander Jaxon Jelkin. He will need to have a strong season for the Cougars to reach the NCAA tournament.

» Star Power

Remember the name Jaxon Jelkin this spring. Jelkin will either start on Friday or Saturday for the Cougars, and he's a 6-foot-5, 190-pounder, with major upside. Jelkiin was terrific in the fall, getting up to 94-95 mph with his fastball, along with high-quality secondary stuff. He pounded the zone and had a hard-nosed approach. Jelkin is a rising prospect, and the slider will play up this spring. Look for him to be one of the premier starters in the Big 12.

» Glue Guv

The Cougars have one of the nation's premier two-way players in Justin Murray. Murray is coming off a strong offensive season at first base, where he hit .379 with 11 doubles, 11 homers and 58 RBIs, while on the mound, he serves as UH's closer. Last season, he appeared in 25 games and had a 3.07 ERA in 41 innings of work. He also limited teams to a .253 batting average. Outside of Murray, Tulimero is an incredibly important player for Todd Whitting's club.

» Picks to Click

Alex Lopez. When I saw the Cougars against Texas A&M during fall workouts, Lopez was a hitting machine. In fact, Whitting said he had a terrific fall from an offensive standpoint. That's interesting considering that he finished last season with a .270 average, six homers and 34 RBIs. Lopez is ripe to take a huge step forward in the consistency department this spring.

» Top Newcomer

I'll give you two names here — freshman Ace Reese and Maine transfer Jake Rainess. Reese stands out from a physical standpoint and is coming off a solid fall at the plate, while Rainess arrivés in Houston with quite a track record. He was a hitting machine with the Black Bears, batting .316 with 14 doubles, LIVING IN THE STRIKE ZONE 16 homers and 47 RBIs last season. Both players are expected to make a massive impact this season.

» 2024 Outlook

The Cougars are embarking on a new era in the Big 12 Conference, and they're hoping to make the NCAA tournament in year one. UH has a solid offensive lineup and a ton of experience from an offensive standpoint, while the pitching staff is loaded with big-time potential when you consider Murray, Schmitz, Jean and Jelkin, among others. Navigating a rugged Big 12 won't be easy, but the Coogs most certainly have the tools to compete.

PAIR TABBED PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA

Justin Murray and Jake Rainess, were named National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Preseason All-Americans on February 6.

Murray, a utility player who began his career at Dartmouth, was named to the Second Team as a utility player after he racked up a team-high 10 saves out of the bullpen in 2023 for the Cougars while leading the American Athletic Conference in average (.379) and hitting posting double digit home run (11) and double (11) numbers. Murray's 5-0 record out of the bullpen led the team in winning percentage on his way to a 3.07 ERA and All-America Third Team honors a year ago. The right-hander was named a Top 50 first baseman by D1Baseball on Jan. 31 as the 22nd ranked first baseman.

Rainess, a senior transfer from Maine, was named to the Third Team as a shortstop after he helped lean the Black Bears to the NCAA Tournament in 2023 while hitting 321 with 16 home runs, 14 doubles and 38 stolen bases. The shortstop's 38 stolen bases in 2023 lead all NCWBA Preseason All-Americans. Rainess was named the 13th best shortstop in the country by D1Baseball on Monday and the fourth best in the Big 12 Conference.

In total, there were 45 different schools and 16 DI conferences represented on the 2024 DI All-America teams, which also have individuals honored from 22 teams ranked in various preseason polls. Houston is one of 19 schools to have at least two athletes on the All-America list and one of four Big 12 schools with multiple honorees.
