UIC's LeKesha Williams and Jaysie Chambers (11 rebounds) each scored 16 points.

Last Time Out

Eastern Illinois shot 58% (11-for-19) from the field and 71.4% (5-for-7) from three-point range in the second half as the Panthers held on for the 78-72 non-conference victory over the Flames on Thursday night. UIC junior point guard Chrissy Dizon posted a season-high 24 points, followed by 17 points and four treys from guard Krystal Hugelier.

Scouting Mississippi:

Mississippi shot a blistering 63.1% (41-for-65) from the field as the Rebels thrashed New Orleans, 100-50, on Wednesday afternoon. Ole Miss forward Arminie Price led four Lady Rebel players in double-figures with 15 points.

Triple Threat:

The trio of **Chrissy Dizon (Chicago, Ill./Latin)**, **LaShonda Grant (Chicago, Ill./Marshall)** and **Krystal Hugelier (Elmhurst, Ill./York)** combined for 116 of UIC's 160 three-pointers last season, which accounted for 72.5 percent of the Flames' treys. Those 160 three-pointers were a school-record, breaking the previous mark of 157 set by the 1999-2000 squad.

Fresh Faces:

UIC Head Coach **Lisa Ryckbosch** has inked five players during the early signing period to suit up for the Flames next season. Joining the team will be center **Nikki Grobbecker (Stratford, Ont./St. Michael's)**, forward **Ashley Hluska (Lansing, Ill./Marian Catholic)**, forward **Jill Hushka (Orland Park, Ill./Sandburg)**, guards **Meghan Hutchens (Riverside, Ill./Riverside-Brookfield)** and **Jackie Parker (St. Louis, Mo./John A. Logan CC)**.

IronWoman:

Senior **Chastity Quinn (Farmington Heights, Mich./West Bloomfield)** has not missed a game during her career at UIC, appearing in 92 consecutive contests, including 28 starts.

Walk-On:

Junior point guard **Chrissy Dizon** originally joined the team as a walk-on.

300 Club:

Sophomore guard **Krystal Hugelier** posted 17 points, including a team-season best, four three-pointers, against Eastern Illinois on Thursday night, pushing the Elmhurst, Ill., native over the 300-point mark for her career. Hugelier now has 309 points during her two years at UIC.

Preseason Pick:

UIC was picked to finish sixth overall in the Horizon League in a pre-season poll of coaches, media and sports information directors.

Hello Again:

Senior forward **Amber Washington (Columbia, S.C./Pensacola JC)** and Ole Miss junior guard **LaTanya Jones** were teammates at Pensacola Junior College.

Defensive Stoppers:

UIC held Arkansas-Little Rock to 41 points on Nov. 26th, marking the fewest points scored against the Flames since Nov. 24, 2000, when UIC held South Alabama to 31 points.

All-Tournament Team:

Sophomore guard **Krystal Hugelier** and junior point guard **Chrissy Dizon** were both named to the SEMO Thanksgiving Classic All-Tournament Team. Hugelier averaged 20.5 points and 8.5 rebounds per game, while Dizon chipped in 7.5 points and four assists per contest.

Trey Chic:

UIC has connected for at least one three-pointer in the last 28 games. The last time the Flames were held without a trey was against DePaul on Dec. 12, 2003.

Road Tested:

UIC will be tested early and often in the opening stages of the 2004-05 season, as the Flames will be on the road for eight of their first nine contests. Their current seven-game road stand is their longest such swing since the 1980-81 campaign when the Flames spent their first eight games of the season away from home.

It's an Honor:

After a breakout sophomore campaign, averaging a team-best 14.3 points per game, junior point guard **Chrissy Dizon** has been named to the 2004-05 Preseason All-Horizon League First Team. Dizon has not disappointed, as she is third in the Horizon League, averaging 15.8 ppg.

Double Time:

Sophomore guard **Krystal Hugelier** picked up her first career, double-double against Arkansas-Little Rock with a team-high 16 points and 10 rebounds in a 55-41 victory over the Trojans on Nov. 26th.

Are You Experienced?:

UIC is one of two teams in the Horizon League, including UW-Green Bay, that returns all five starters to the court for the 2004-05 campaign.

First Impressions:

Sophomore guards **LaShonda Grant** and **Krystal Hugelier** quickly made their presence felt during their rookie campaigns as both were named to the 2004 Horizon League All-Newcomer Team. Hugelier was third on the squad in scoring with 9.1 points per game, while Grant followed with 7.1 points per contest.

Block Party:

Senior forward **Amber Washington** tied a career-high with three blocked shots against Eastern Illinois on Thursday night, helping the Flames tie a season-best mark of seven swats on the evening. UIC is currently third in the Horizon League, averaging 4.2 blocks per game.

Taking Care of the Ball:

Thursday's contest against Eastern Illinois marked the first time this season that UIC did not have more turnovers than assists, as the Flames dished out 14 helpers, while turning the ball over 14 times.

Basketball coaches are rarely afforded the opportunity to spend their entire career in one city.

University of Illinois at Chicago Head Women's Basketball Coach Lisa Ryckbosch not only has spent her entire collegiate coaching career in the Windy City, but she was born and raised in Chicago's McKinley Park neighborhood.

With her roots deeply entrenched and typifying the Chicago blue-collar work ethic, Ryckbosch has her squad, which consists of nine players from the Chicagoland area, poised to make a run at the 2005 Horizon League Championship.

Since her hiring on April 25, 2002, Ryckbosch and her staff have laid the groundwork to build a solid program not only on the local scene, but on the national scene.

Her sophomore campaign provided the foundation for the future as the Horizon League issued postseason honors to three Flames' student-athletes – all underclassmen, the most in the conference.

All told, Ryckbosch has led the Flames to 29 victories over her first two seasons, which is more than anyone in school history.

Ryckbosch, however, wants more.

Now in her third year, Ryckbosch is looking for a payoff on her investment, as UIC returns an experienced lineup with eight players who averaged at least 14 minutes per game last season.

Leading the way for the Flames is the three-guard lineup of junior Chrissy Dizon along with sophomores LaShonda Grant and Krystal Hugelier.

Dizon led the team and was fourth in the Horizon League in scoring, averaging 14.3 points per game, en route to All-Horizon League Second Team honors. Hugelier and Grant each turned in impressive freshman campaigns, chipping in 9.1 and 7.1 points respectively, on their way to Horizon League All-Newcomer Team nominations.

That trio combined for 116 three pointers, which accounted for 72.5% of the Flames' treys during the 2003-04 campaign. UIC finished with 160 three-pointers, breaking the school-record of 157 set by the 1999-2000 squad.

During Ryckbosch's rookie campaign, the Flames used a stingy defense and combined it with a swift offense translating into an overall record of 17-11 and a second-place finish in the Horizon League with a mark of 11-5.

The 11 wins in Horizon League action, tied for the most in school history, while the second-place mark was the Flames first ever.

UIC's 17 wins were the second-most in school history and the most since the 1995-96 campaign, when the Flames finished 17-14. UIC also received its first-ever vote in the Associated Press Top 25 poll.

UIC set a school-record with 344 steals on the campaign and finished with the second-most points (1,949) and second-highest scoring average (69.6) in school history.

Ryckbosch also had the luxury of having a pair of 1,000-point scorers on her squad in Jaysie Chambers and LeKesha Williams.

Chambers averaged a double-double of 14.7 points and 10.8 rebounds per game, on her way to First Team All-Horizon League honors and All-Horizon League Defensive team accolades.

Williams broke out in her senior year, as the Oklahoma City, Okla., native led UIC and was second in the Horizon League with 19.3 points per contest. Following the season, she was also named to the All-Horizon League First Team and the All-Horizon League Defensive team.

Ryckbosch came to UIC after spending 11 seasons on the coaching staff at DePaul University, where she served most recently as associate head coach under Doug Bruno. She had been instrumental in bringing top Chicagoland and national talent to the Blue Demons' successful women's basketball program, including five players that competed in the WNBA.

While at DePaul, Ryckbosch helped guide the Blue Demons to five NCAA Tournament appearances and three WNIT berths. DePaul owned a record of 186-140 during her tenure, while winning a pair of Great Midwest Conference titles (1989; 1991) and the first-ever Conference USA regular-season championship in 1996.

Prior to her stint with the Blue Demons, Ryckbosch, ironically, got her collegiate coaching start as a member of the UIC staff in 1990-91, serving under then-head coach Eileen McMahan.

Ryckbosch began her coaching career at Hillcrest High School in Country Club Hills, Ill., where she served as the Head Girls' Varsity Basketball Coach and Math teacher for three years.

Ryckbosch, who played three seasons of professional basketball in Belgium with DBC Aalst, enjoyed a standout collegiate career at Loyola (Ill.). She was a four-year starter and two-time team captain for the Ramblers from 1980-84 and still ranks fourth on the school's all-time scoring (1,296) and rebounding (765) charts. She played an instrumental role in leading Loyola to a school-record 23 wins and the inaugural North Star Championship in 1984.
