TEAM NOTES

- Kansas has played at least 11 different players in every game this season.
- Leading at halftime, 45-35, the Jayhawks have led at half in all five games this season.
- Kansas had three players score in double-figures, including Ochai Agbaji (21 points) Remy Martin (17 points) and Christian Braun (17 points), the fifth time this season the Jayhawks had three or more players in double-figures scoring.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior Ochai Agbaji scored a team high 21 points on 8-of-16 (50 percent) from the field and 2-of-6 (33.3 percent) from beyond the arc, connecting on multiple threes in each game this season.
- Agbaji's 21 points marks his fourth 20-point game of the season and 11th of his career. Friday marked Agbaji's 82nd consecutive start and 86th start of his career.
- Senior Remy Martin surpassed the 1,800 point mark on Friday, scoring 17 points on 7-of-11 (63.6 percent) from the field. Martin's 17 points were the most by him in a Kansas uniform.
- Christaun Braun scored 17 points on Friday, scoring in double-figures in each of the five games this season. Braun shot 8-of-12 (66.7%) from the field. Braun also added 8 rebounds, tying a season-high. He has had five or more rebounds in all five games so far this season.
- Freshman Zach Clemence scored 3 points on 1-of-1 (100 percent) from beyond the arc. Clemence has now made at least one three-pointer in four of five games this season.
