#### KANSAS' WIN...

- Gave Kansas its 30th-straight conference opening win, a streak which started in 1991-92
- Was Kansas' 10th-straight Big 12 road win.
- Made Kansas 7-1 for the second-straight season and 7-1 or better for the seventh-consecutive season beginning in 2014-15.
- Gave Kansas its third-straight win against Texas Tech, making the series 38-6 in favor of KU.
- Improved Bill Self to 508-110 while at Kansas, 715-215 all-time and 25-8 against Texas Tech, 24-5 while at Kansas.
- Made Kansas 2,309-863 all-time.

#### **TEAM NOTES**

- Thursday's contest as the earliest conference game for Kansas since December 13, 1986 against Colorado in the Big Eight era.
- In the middle of the first half Kansas went on a 6-0 run in 3:42, ended by a layup by Mac McClung.
- Towards the end of the first half, Kansas did not make a field goal for 3:56, shooting 1-7, and ended with a layup by Tyon Grant-Foster.
- Kansas tied their season low for first half points, scoring 29 points (29 v Kentucky 12-1-20).
- Two 3-pointers also tie a low for a half done three other times this season.
- In the beginning of the second half, Kansas went on a 5:55 scoring drought, shooting 0-7 partnered with 4 turnovers, ended by a made 3-pointer by Ochai Agbaji.
- Following Ochai Agbaji's 3-pointer, Kansas did not score a field goal for 3:52, ended by another made 3-pointer by Ochai Agbaji, making the Kansas run 7-0 the past 1:07, ended by a free throw by Terrance Shannon Jr.
- Kansas scored a season low 58 points in the game.

- Kansas attempted a season low 47 field goals.
- Kansas attempted a season low 15 free throws.

- Shortly after the run, Kansas went on a 2:07 scoring drought, ended by a made free throw by Bryce Thompson.
- Following this layup by Mac McClung, Texas Tech did not make a field goal for 5:50, going on a 2:59 scoring drought. Both ended by a made jumper by Nimari Burnett.
- Mac McClung scored a season high 21 points.
- Terrance Shannon scored a season high 20 points.
- In the beginning of the second half, Texas Tech went on a 12-0 run in 5:44, ended by a made 3-pointer by Ochai Agbaji.
- Texas Tech took 5 charges.
- Mac McClung and Terrance Shannon attempted 16 field goals, which is the highest for Kansas opponent's this season.
