- Kansas is participating in its seventh Maui Jim Maui Invitational and has a combined record of 17-6 in the event. The Jayhawks are 3-0 mark in campus round games and a 14-6 record in Maui.
- KU will be playing in its third-straight Maui Invitational title game and its fourth overall when it meets Dayton Wednesday. KU has gone 2-1 in its previous three title game appearances.
- Kansas has won two Maui Invitationals in 1996 and 2015, its last appearance in the event. KU has also won five-straight Maui Invitational games and seven of its last eight battles at Lahaina Civic Center.
- · Kansas has won its last five in-season tournaments with the 2015 Maui Invitational included in the run. The streak started with the 2014 Orlando Classic, then the 2015 Maui Invitational, the 2016 CBE Classic, the 2017 HoopHall Miami Invitational and the 2018 NIT Season Tip Off.
- Kansas and Dayton are meeting for the third time in men's basketball with the series tied at 1-1.
- KU's first two opponents in Maui combined for 47 turnovers (Chaminade -27, BYU - 20), marking the second-most in a two-game span for Jayhawk opponents during the Bill Self Era.
- Kansas is 3-0 in Allen Fieldhouse this season and has a 24-game home court winning streak, which is third longest nationally behind Tennessee (30) and Gonzaga (27).
- KU is ranked No. 4 in the Nov. 25 Associated Press national poll. KU has been ranked in the top-five 340 times overall and 134 times in the Bill Self era.
- KU has been ranked in each of the last 204 AP polls dating back to 2008-09. The 204-consecutive weeks in the polls is the longest active streak in the nation. KU holds the same streak in the coaches' poll at 212.
- Kansas head coach Bill Self is 684-212 in his 27th season overall as a head coach. He is four games from being the 30th active coach in the NCAA to have coached in 900 games.

ABOUT KANSAS

No. 4/5 Kansas is coming off a 71-56 win against BYU in the semifinals of the 2019 Maui Jim Maui Invitational. The Jayhawks are 5-1 for the eighth straight season and 15th time in the 17 seasons under Bill Self

Sophomore guard Devon Dotson leads Kansas in scoring at the Maui Invitational at 16.0 and in overall games at 17.8 points per contest. Dotson is tied for the team lead with 26 assists, which includes nine in the Maui Invitational. Dotson, who is on most everyone's national player of the year watch list, is shooting 88.9 percent from the free throw line, averages 3.7 rebounds and has 10 steals.

Senior center Udoka Azubuike leads Kansas in rebounds with 8.3 per game after recording his second double-double of the season with 11 points and 10 rebounds against BYU (11/26). Azubuike is second on the team in scoring at 12.8 points per game and he leads the team with nine blocked shots. Azubuike also leads the team in field goal percentage at 79.5 percent, which includes 85.7 percent in the Maui Invitational, and in blocked shots with nine.

Following his 14 points versus BYU, sophomore guard Ochai Agbaji is next in scoring at 10.2 points per game. He is second on the team lead with 12 steals. Agbaji has made 10 3-point field goals and pulls down 3.5 rebounds per contest.

Senior guard Isaiah Moss is next in scoring at 9.8 points per game. He is averaging 9.0 points and has made four 3-pointers in the Maui Invitational with three steals.

Sophomore forward David McCormack has five starts this season and is averaging 13.0 points in the Maui Invitational, 9.2 ppg overall. McCormack had 16 points on 7-of-9 shooting against BYU (11/26) with five rebounds.

Junior guard Marcus Garrett is a starter who is tied with Dotson for the team lead in assists with 26. A defensive stopper, Garrett

leads the team with 13 steals and averages 8.7 points and 4.8 rebounds per game.

Other KU regulars include freshman guard/forward Tristan Enaruna (5.2 ppg, 3.0 rpg), junior forward Silvio De Sousa (4.3 ppg, 2.8 rpg) and freshman guard Christian Braun (3.3 ppg, four 3-pointers).

ABOUT DAYTON

Located in Dayton, Ohio, with an enrollment of 9,441, Dayton is one of 39 teams undefeated in 2019-20 with a 5-0 record. The Flyers are coached by Anthony Grant who is 39-29 in his third season at DU and 232-139 in his 12th season overall. Grant was an assistant coach on the USA U18 FIBA Championships gold medal team in which the head coach was Kansas' Bill Self.

Dayton defeated Georgia in the opening round of the Maui Invitational, 80-61, and Virginia Tech in the semifinals, 89-62. The Flyers average 87.6 points per game and have a plus-21.0 scoring margin. They have scored 80 or more points in all five games this season. Dayton hold a plus-5.4 rebound margin and averages 9.4 3-point field goals made per game and 25.8 3-point attempts. Dayton also averages 19.6 assists, 5.2 steals and 4.0 blocked shots per contest.

Redshirt sophomore forward Obi Toppin lead Dayton is scoring at 24.0 points per game and rebounding at 8.2 boards per contest. He has made eight 3-pointers. Redshirt junior guard Rodney Chatman is next in scoring at 12.2 points per game and he has made a team-high 12 3-pointers and seven steals. Chatman is second on the team with seven steals. Junior guard Jalen Crutcher is next in scoring at 11.8 points per game and he leads Dayton with 32 assists. Crutcher is second on the team with nine 3-pointers made per game. Senior transfer forward Ryan Mikesell is also scoring in double figures at 11.0 points per game and he pulls down 4.0 rebounds per contest. Senior guard Trey Landers (9.2 ppg, 4.4 ppg) rounds out the Dayton starters.

Other Dayton regulars include redshirt junior guard Ibi Watson (6.8 ppg, 2.6 rpg), reshirt sophomore guard Chase Johnson (3.8 ppg, 3.8 rpg), sophomore guard Dwayne Cohill (3.8 ppg) and redshirt junior guard Jhery Matos (2.6 ppg).

THE SERIES

The Kansas-Dayton series is tied at 1-1. Dayton won the first meeting, 61-48, in the 1968 NIT championship game in New York, N.Y., on March 23, 1968. Kansas won the second meeting, 60-43, in the second round of the NCAA Tournament in Minneapolis. KU's Cole Aldrich recorded the first official KU triple-double in the game with 13 points, 20 rebounds and 10 blocked shots. Unofficially, its was the fourth of KU's five triple-doubles in school history.

- Kansas is now 17-6 all-time in the Maui Jim Maui Invitational, including 14-6 in games at Lahaina Civic Center. KU won its fifth-straight win in the Maui Invitational.
- The win gave Kansas its third-straight Maui Invitational Championship game appearance.
- Kansas won its 13th-straight in-season tournament victory.
- Kansas took a slim 29-27 lead into the break marking the fifth time in its six outings this season that KU has led at the half. The Jayhawks are 5-0 in those contests with a 388-31 record in the Self era
- KU's 29 first-half points were the fewest by the Jayhawks in a half this season. The opening stanza point total also marked the fewest by Kansas in the Maui Invitational since KU tallied 26 in the first half against Vanderbilt on Nov. 25, 2015.
- The Jayhawks outscored BYU 42-18 in the paint, marking the fourth-straight game that Kansas has outscored its opponent by 20 or more points in the paint.
- Senior Udoka Azubuike had 11 points and 10 rebounds for the game. Azubuike tallied his second double-double of the season and his 10th of his career.
- After going 5-of-6 from the field, Azubuike has shot 84.4 percent from the field in his last four outings via a 27-of-32 clin
- Dotson finished with 13 points going 3-for-3 from the free throw line. Dotson is now 32-of-36 from the charity stripe this season.
- Dotson tied his career high with eight assists, a clip he's hit twice previously. The most recent came against West Virginia on Feb. 16, 2019.
- Sophomore David McCormack finished with 16 points, just two shy of his career high on a 7-for9 shooting performance.

KANSAS IN THE MAUI INVITATIONAL

Kansas has a combined 17-6 record in this Maui Jim Maui Invitational (counting home games that are part of the tournament). KU is 14-6 in games played at the Lahaina Civic Center in Maui, Hawaii.

In KU's 1988 NCAA National Championship season, the Jayhawks placed fourth in the event, going 1-2. Kansas won the 1996 Maui Invitational, defeating LSU, California and Virginia. Raef LaFrentz was named the MVP. In 2001, KU finished third in the event with a 2-1 record. Drew Gooden was a member of the all-tournament team and was the first Jayhawk on the Maui Invitational all-tourney list, which began in 2000.

KU has appeared in the invitational three times under Bill Self. In 2005, the Jayhawks placed seventh, losing to Arizona and Arkansas before defeating Chaminade.

In 2011, KU finished runner-up, defeating Georgetown and UCLA before falling to Duke in the title game. Jayhawk Thomas Robinson was named to the 2011 Maui All-Tournament Team. Later that season KU would advance to the Final Four, finishing runner-up.

In 2015, Kansas won the event with victories over Chaminade, UCLA and Vanderbilt. KU's Wayne Selden Jr. and Frank Mason III were named co-MVPs, and were joined on the all-tournament team by teammate and current staff member Perry Ellis.

LETS GET DEFENSIVE

The 2019-20 Jayhawks are building an early-season reputation of being a stout defensive team. KU opponents are shooting 38 percent from the field, with the Jayhawks keeping opposing 3-point shooters to a 28 percent clip from beyond the arc.

KU is also forcing its opponents into over 17 turnovers per game. This includes a combined 47 giveaways by the Jayhawks' first two opponents in the Maui Invitational. Chaminade's 27 and BYU's 20 turnovers marked the second-most by KU opponents in consecutive games during the Bill Self era and just the second time in the last 10 seasons the Jayhawks have forced 20 or more turnovers in back-to-back games.

Kansas has taken advantage of these opponent giveaways, posting 17 or more points off turnovers in five of its six outings this season.

KANSAS STREAKING AT HOME (AGAIN)

Going 17-0 at home in 2018-19, Kansas is once again building an impressive winning streak on its home court, something that has been a common occurrence in Lawrence over recent decades.

KU has won 24-straight home games, 23 of which have come at Allen Fieldhouse (the Dec. 8, 2018 win at Sprint Center considered a home game). The streak currently ranks as the third-longest active among NCAA DI schools. KU's last home loss came to Oklahoma State on Feb. 3, 2018. In 2018-19, the Jayhawks wrapped up their 20th undefeated season at Allen Fieldhouse and their first since 2015-16.

Since Bill Self took the reins in 2003-04, Kansas as posted seven unblemished records in a season on James Naismith Court. The Jayhawks have won more Big 12 regular-season titles (14) than have lost home games (13) in that span.

Kansas has now posted home-court winning streaks of 20 games or more 15 times, with 11 of those streaks coming at Allen Fieldhouse. The program record is 69-straight home wins from Feb. 7, 2007, to Jan. 22, 2011. That streak is a Big 12 record and the 11th-longest in NCAA DI history.

Junior college standout Tyon Grant-Foster (6-foot-7) will be a junior guard in 2020-21. He is currently ranked as the No. 2 junior college recruit in 2019-20. Grant-Foster is from Kansas City, Kan., and plays at Indian Hills (Iowa) Community College.

Guard Bryce Thompson (6-foot-5) will be a freshman in 2020-21 and ranks No. 19 by rivals.com and 247Sports Composite. Thompson was the Oklahoma Gatorade Player of the Year as a junior while playing at Booker T. Washington High School in Tulsa.

Center Gethro Muscadin (6-foot-10) will be a freshman next season and hails from Gonaivaes, Haiti. He is concluding his prep career at Aspire Academy in Louisville, Ky., and ranks as the 17th best center in this year's class.

Guard Latrell Jossell (5-foot-11) will be a freshman next season and is from Keller, Texas. He plays for Keller Central High School and plays on the AAU circuit for Marcus Smart's YCG36 team and has been teammates of KU freshman Jalen Wilson and Muscadin while on YCG36

BOUNCING BACK

Since Bill Self took the helm of the Jayhawks in 2003, Kansas has been stellar at bouncing back following a loss, and that trend continued on Nov. 8 with KU's win over UNCG. With the victory over the Spartans, which followed the Jayhawks' season-opening loss to Duke, Kansas is now 94-13 in games coming off a defeat since 2019, which is the best winning percentage in NCAA DI in that span.

Incredibly, KU has been even more efficient over the last six seasons, amassing a record of 43-5 after losses. This includes an 8-1 mark last season.

Kansas checked in at No. 4 in the latest Associated Press poll released Nov. 18. Kansas has been ranked in the AP polls for 203-consecutive weeks, which is the longest active streak in the nation.

For the seventh-consecutive season, Kansas men's basketball entered the preseason ranked fifth or higher as KU was No. 3 in the 2019-20 preseason Associated Press poll released Oct. 21.

Last season, Kansas entered the preseason ranked No. 1 nationally in the Associated Press poll for the third time in school history and ended at No. 17. The Jayhawks were ranked in the AP Top 10 for 12 weeks in 2018-19. In KU's 2018 Final Four run, the Jayhawks

KU started the 2010-11 season 18-0 and and posted a 35-3 overall record winning the Big 12 regular season (14-2) and conference tournament titles and advancing to the NCAA Tournament Elite Eight.

were preseason No. 4 by AP. Kansas was No. 3 in 2016-17, No. 4 in 2015-16 and No. 5 in 2014-15 and 2013-14. It is also the 10th time in the last 11 seasons that the Jayhawks have entered the season No. 7 or higher by the AP.

Under 17th-year and Hall of Fame head coach Bill Self, this is the 14th time that Kansas enters the season ranked seventh or higher in the Associated Press preseason poll and historically, the No. 3 ranking marks the 22nd time since the 1992-93 season that Kansas will enter the season seventh or higher.

KANSAS VS. TOP-25 TEAMS

Kansas went 8-4 against top-25 teams in 2018-19. Under Bill Self, KU is 98-50 against AP-ranked opponents. In his first 16 seasons, Self's Jayhawks have collected four wins or more over top-25 ranked foes in 13 of those seasons, which includes a 43-21 record from 2014-present.

KU's record against top-10 ranked opponents is even more impressive. KU is 18-6 against foes ranked inside the top-10 of the AP poll since 2013-14, including 2-1 in 2018-19 and 4-1 in 2017-18. Since Bill Self's first season, the Jayhawks are 13-3 against AP top-10 teams inside Allen Fieldhouse, which includes KU's current streak of nine-straight home victories against top-10 foes.

KANSAS NO. 5 IN USA TODAY COACHES' PRESS POLL

Kansas is No. 5 in the first *USA TODAY* Coaches' poll of the regular season, released on Nov. 18.

This is the sixth-straight year the Jayhawks have opened the season in the top-five and KU is ranked in the preseason for the 28th time in time in the 31-year history of the poll. With the preseason ranking,

Kansas has appeared in each of the last 210 coaches' polls, which is the longest active streak in coaches' poll history.

The No. 3 ranking marks the 10th time KU has been preseason No. 3 or higher in the coaches' poll. Additionally, it is the 14th time in the Bill Self era the Jayhawks have been preseason seventh or higher, including each of the last eight seasons. In 2018-19 Kansas opened the year No. 1 in the preseason coaches' poll and ended No. 16.

Kansas could potentially play eight games against teams ranked in the coaches' preseason poll this season. Those include: No. 1 Michigan State (potential in Maui Invitational), No. 4 Duke, No. 10 Villanova, No. 12 Texas Tech (twice), No. 18 Baylor (twice), and No. 25 Tennessee.

AZUBUIKE'S, DOTSON'S PRESEASON HONORS

Kansas senior Udoka Azubuike and sophomore Devon Dotson have received numerous preseason honors heading into the 2019-20 season. Both were named to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 and the Naismith Trophy and NABC Player of the Year watch lists. On Oct. 22, the Associated Press listed the KU duo as receiving votes when it announced its preseason All-America men's basketball team. A total of 21 players were recognized, voted on by a 65-member media panel. Kansas was the only school with two players listed.

Earlier in October, Azubuike was named the Preseason Big 12 Player of the Year and Preseason All-Big 12 by the conference coaches. He was also named one of 20 on the Kareen Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year watch list. Dotson joined Azubuike on the Preseason All-Big 12 team and was one of 20 on the Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year watch list.

Azubuike played in nine games in 2018-19 before an injury sidelined him for the season. The 7-foot-0, 270-pound center from Delta, Nigeria, averaged 13.4 points and 6.8 rebounds while shooting 70.5 percent from the field last season. As a sophomore in leading Kansas to the 2018 Final Four, Azubuike led the nation with a 77.0 field goal percentage, which ranks second-best for a season in NCAA history and set the KU and Big 12 single-season records. He averaged 13.0 points and 7.0 rebounds while being named an All-Big 12 Third Team selection. Azubuike is a two-time Academic All-Big 12 selection.

As a freshman, Dotson (6-foot-2, 185) started every game for Kansas in 2018-19 and ranked 12th in the Big 12 in scoring at 12.3 points per game. The Charlotte, N.C., guard was a member of the 2019 All-Big 12 Third Team and the league's all-freshman team. Dotson also ranked sixth in the conference in assists (3.5), 11th in field goal percentage (48.2), tied for ninth in steals (1.4) and ninth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.6). He averaged 15.7 points, 4.0 rebounds and 4.3 assists in leading KU to the Big 12 Tournament title game and was named to the event's all-tournament team.

- Kansas has been ranked in the Associated Press top-25 poll for 204-consecutive weeks. The next closest active streak is North Carolina at 107-straight weeks ranked. KU's current stretch began on Feb. 2, 2009.
- The Jayhawks have won 20 of their last 23 regular-season games against AP top-10 teams. Under Bill Self, KU is 40-21 against top-10 opponents, a figure that includes postseason play.
- KU has won at least 12 league games for 19-straight years, which is the longest active streak in the nation.
- Kansas won its 1,100th all-time conference game with a 72-67 win against Oklahoma State (3/2/19). The Jayhawks won their 300th Big 12 game vs. Oklahoma (2/19/18)
- Each KU senior class since 1986-87 has won at least 100 games.
- Kansas has won 25 or more games in each of its last 14 seasons, an NCAA DI record.
- Kansas is the only team in the Big 12 to have a .500 winning percentage or better series record against every conference foe.



PRESEASON BIG 12 POLL

For the ninth-straight season and 19th time in the 24-year history of the league, Kansas tops the men's basketball Big 12 Coaches Preseason Poll. The Jayhawks received eight of a possible nine first-place votes by the coaches in 2019-20 poll. The coaches were not allowed to vote for their own team.

KU has won 18 outright or shared Big 12 regular-season championships in the previous 23 years since the inception of the league in 1996-97. Included was an NCAA-record 14 consecutive from 2005-18. KU's 61 overall conference titles is also an NCAA record.

Historically, the other 18 times Kansas has been named the preseason favorite, the Jayhawks won the Big 12 regular-season on 15 occasions. This includes the first preseason poll in 1996-97 in which only a media poll was conducted.

Kansas has won 18 of the 23 Big 12 regular-season titles (includes ties), including an NCAA record 14 straight from 2005-18. Kansas' 61 conference titles are the most in NCAA Division I. Kentucky is second with 54 and Penn third at 37. KU's 14-straight league titles, all under head coach Bill Self, is the longest streak in NCAA Division I and in school history.

TOP-10 TRIUMPHS

The Jayhawks have been stellar when taking on a top-10 team in the regular-season during the Bill Self era. The Jayhawks have lost only three regular-season contests against top-10 teams in its last 23 tries. One of those losses came at then-No. 8 Kentucky last season, a game result which ended an astounding 13-game regular-season winning streak against top-10 foes.

Kansas is an incredible 20-3 in its last 23 regular-season contests against top-10 ranked squads. Since Bill Self took the reins of the Jayhawks in 2003, KU is 40-21 against top-10 teams, a number which includes postseason play.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR IN 2019-20

- Kansas has won 24-straight home games and is No. 3 on the active home court winning streak. Last year, KU went 17-0 at home, including 16-0 in Allen Fieldhouse. Tennessee is first at 30, with Gonzaga at 27 and Kansas at 24. Prairie View A&M is fourth at 16.
- The 2019-20 Jayhawks are looking to put the finishing touches on the winningest decade in program history. KU is 309-67 record during the 2010s. The .822 win percentage this decade trails only the run in the 1990's that saw the Jayhawks win 82.7 percent of its games at 286-60.
- Kansas has won five straight in-season tournaments after claiming the 2018 NIT Season Tip-Off last season in Brooklyn, N.Y. Included in the run was the 2015 Maui Jim Maui Invitational, an event KU will compete in Nov. 25-27, in Lahaina, Hawaii.
- Kansas ranks second all-time in wins with 2.279. The Jayhawks are 21 victories from No. 2,300.
- Kansas is 791-113 all-time in Allen Fieldhouse and is nine shy from win No. 800 in the historic venue.
- KU head coach Bill Self has a 478-107 record in his 17th season at Kansas. He is 22 wins shy of 500 while at KU.
- Overall, Self is 685-212 in his 27th season as a head coach, 15 shy of 700 all-time wins.
- Senior center Udoka Azubuike has a career field goal percentage of 74.9 with 431 attempts. The current KU career field goal percentage record, with a minimum 500
- attempts, is 62.0 percent by Mark Randall (1987, 89-91). The Big 12 career field goal percentage record is 63.7 by Ricardo Ratliffe of Missouri (2010-12). Senior transfer Isaiah Moss is 45 points from 1,000 for his
