- Kansas continues its five-game homestand when it hosts North Dakota State, Saturday, Dec. 5, at 3 p.m. (Central). The contest will air on Big 12 NOW on ESPN+ with Dave Armstrong and Chris Piper calling the action.
- Through four games, Kansas has had four different players lead the team in scoring and steals.
- Kansas has been ranked in each of the last 222 Associated Press polls dating back to 2008-09. The 222-consecutive weeks in the AP poll is an all-time record, surpassing UCLA's 221 from 1966-80. KU holds the same streak in the coaches' poll at 229.
- This season, Kansas men's basketball will be wearing a patch that reads "UNITED WE STAND" signifying its stance on the recent social injustice in the United States. The patch has gold lettering with the black background being in the shape of the state of Kansas.
- With its win against Saint Joseph's (11/27), Kansas improved to 97-13 following a loss in the Bill Self era, which started in 2003-04, including 3-0 last season in 2019-20. Incredibly, KU has been even more efficient over the last six-plus seasons, amassing a record of 46-5 after losses.
- Kansas' last six losses have been to ranked foes, with three of those in the top five.
- Senior Marcus Garrett was named to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 on Dec. 1. Garrett has been named to every national player of the year watch list for 2020-21.
- Redshirt-senior Mitch Lightfoot posted three blocked shots against Washburn (12/3) and became the 21st player in KU history to record 100 career blocks, currently at 102.
- With its 89-54 win against Washburn in Allen Fieldhouse on Dec. 3, the Jayhawks have won a mind-boggling 48-straight home openers beginning in 1973-74 under head coach Ted Owens.

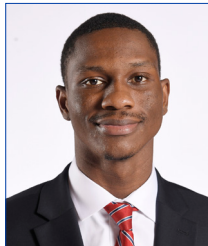

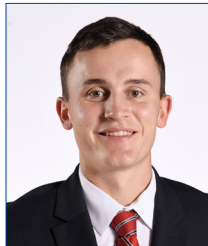

ABOUT KANSAS

No. 7/5 Kansas is 3-1 on the season after its 89-54 win against Washburn in the home opener for the Jayhawks on Dec. 3. Kansas averages 84.5 points per game and has a +12.0 scoring margin. KU pulls down 42.0 rebounds per contest and holds a +8.5 rebound margin through four games. Kansas has shot over 50% from the field in three of four games and is shooting 46.1% for the season. KU is also solid behind the arc making 8.8 3-pointers per outing with a 41.2 3-point field goal percentage.

Junior guard Ochai Agbaji leads Kansas in scoring at 17.0 points per game and has scored 16 or more points in all four contests. Agbaji leads the team with 11 3-point field goals made and he has nine assists and five steals. Redshirt-freshman forward Jalen Wilson posted his first career double-double with career highs in points (23) and rebounds (10) against Kentucky (12/1). Wilson is second on the team in points (15.3) and tied for the team lead in rebounds with a 7.3 average. Sophomore guard Christian Braun is the other Jayhawk with a 7.3 rebound average. He averages 13.8 points per game and is tied for the team lead with seven steals. Braun has also made 10 3-pointers. Junior forward David McCormack is coming off a season-high 17 points against Washburn (12/3) and averages 10.0 ppg and 5.0 rpg per game. Senior Marcus Garrett is an All-American candidate who averages 10.0 points, 4.5 rebounds and 2.8 assists after his five dimes against Washburn.

Others who have played significant minutes through four games include freshman guard Bryce Thompson (one start, 7.5 ppg), sophomore guard/forward Tristan Enaruna (3.5 ppg), junior guard Tyon Grant-Foster (2.8 ppg), freshman guard Dajuan Harris Jr. (1.8 ppg) and redshirt-senior forward Mitch Lightfoot (1.7 ppg). Harris is 14th nationally with a 7.00 assist-to-turnover ratio as he has 14 dimes and two turnovers in four contests.

Kansas returns three starters and nine letterwinners from last season's 28-3 team which ended the 2019-20 season ranked No. 1 in both the Associated Press and *USA TODAY* Coaches' polls. The Jayhawks won their 19th Big 12 and 62nd overall conference regular-season title by winning a conference-most 17 victories, going 17-1 in league play. KU also won the 2019 Maui Invitational.

ABOUT NORTH DAKOTA STATE

Located in Fargo, N.D., with an enrollment of 12,864, North Dakota State is 0-3 on the season and its KU contest will be its fourth game away from home in 2020-21. The Bison are coached by David Richman who is 121-78 in his seventh season at NDSU. North Dakota State averages 54.3 points per game and gives up 70.0. The Bison pull down 44.0 rebounds and have a +8.3 rebound margin. NDSU also averages 9.0 assists, 3.3 steals and 2.7 blocked shots per game.

Junior guard/forward Tyree Eady leads North Dakota State in scoring at 10.0 points per game. He is tied for the team lead with four 3-pointers made and is second on the team with an 8.0 rebound average. Senior forward Rocky Kreuser is next in scoring with a 9.7 points per game average and he pulls down 6.0 rebounds per outing with five assists. Junior guard Jaxon Knotek is a non-starter who next in scoring at 8.5 points per game. He pulls down 4.5 rebounds. Sophomore guard Maleeck Harden-Hayes (8.0 ppg, 5.0 rpg) has started both games he has played this season. Rounding out the NDSU starters are junior guard/forward Sam Griesel (7.3 ppg, a team-leading 8.7 rpg), and sophomore guard Jarius Cook (6.7 ppg). Other Bison regulars include freshman guard Boden Skunberg (3.0 ppg, 3.3 rpg), freshman forward Grant Nelson (2.7 ppg), senior forward Tyler Witz (2.0 ppg, 4.0 rpg) and freshman guard Dezmond McKinney (2.0 ppg).

THE SERIES

Kansas won the only meeting in its series with North Dakota State with an 84-74 victory on March 20, 2009, in the opening round of the 2009 NCAA Tournament in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Kansas All-American Sherron Collins erupted for a career-high 32 points in the win at the Hubert Humphrey Metrodome. Cole Aldrich added 23 points and 13 rebounds for KU.

Make Kansas 2,306-863 all-time.

Make Kansas 3-2 for the first time since a 3-2 start in the 2011-12 Final Four season ... Tie the two-game KU-NDSU series at 1-1 ... End a KU nine-game home court winning streak ... Make KU 803-115 all-time in Allen Fieldhouse, including 265-15 under Bill Self ... Make Bill Self 504-111 while at Kansas, 711-216 all-time and 1-1 against North Dakota State ... Make Kansas 2,305-864 all-time.

KANSAS-WASHBURN LEFTOVERS

- Kansas improved to 3-1 for the second-straight season and is 3-1 or better for the 15th-consecutive season dating back to 2006-07.
- KU won its 48th-straight home-opening win, beginning in 1973-74 under head coach Ted Owens.
- KU extended its winning streak in Allen Fieldhouse to nine games.
- Kansas had its highest run, going 14-0 in the second half, while holding the Ichabods to a scoring drought for six minutes.
- Kansas had its largest lead of the season at 35 points with 17 seconds remaining in the second half after a 3-point jumper from freshman Latrell Jossell.
- Kansas was led by four players (Jalen Wilson, David McCormack, Ochai Agbaji and Bryce Thompson) in double-figures scoring, marking the third time this season the Jayhawks had three or more players in double-digits. The Jayhawks had four players in double-figures against Gonzaga on Nov. 26 and three players in double-figures against Saint Joseph's on Nov. 27.
- The Jayhawks posted their season high with a 50% shooting from behind the 3-point arc, making 13 of their 26 attempts for the game.
- Redshirt-freshman Jalen Wilson scored in double-figures for the fourth time this season, scoring 13 points on 4-of-6 shooting. Wilson's 13 points come after scoring a career-high 23 points against Kentucky (12/1).
- Junior David McCormack recorded his 14th-career game in double-figures, scoring 17 points on 7-of-8 from the field. McCormack's 17 points are a new season high for the junior forward.
- With 16 points on 5-of-9 scoring, junior Ochai Agbaji extended his double-figures scoring streak to four games this season and for the 26th time in his career. Agbaji scored a season-high 18 points against Saint Joseph's on Nov. 27.
- In just his fourth-career game as a Jayhawk, junior Tyon Grant-Foster set a career high in scoring, recording six points on 3-of-7 shooting from the field.

KANSAS SETS AP POLL RECORD

Kansas men's basketball set the NCAA all-time record for 222-consecutive weeks ranked in the Associated Press (AP) poll on Nov. 30, being ranked No. 7 and surpassing the 221-straight weeks set by UCLA from 1966-80. Kansas' current streak started Feb. 2, 2009. The AP poll began during the 1948-49 season.

Kansas also holds the all-time consecutive ranked streak in the *USA TODAY* Coaches' poll, currently at 229. The coaches' poll began in the 1989-90 and KU has been ranked in every poll since the final eight polls of the 2008-09 season.

The final AP poll of the season is done just prior to the NCAA Tournament, while the coaches' poll has a final ranking following the NCAA tourney.

KU NO. 5 IN THE PRESEASON COACHES' POLL

Kansas' men's basketball team is ranked No. 5 in the preseason *USA TODAY* Coaches' Poll released Nov. 12.

This is the seventh-straight year the Jayhawks have opened the season in the top-five and KU is ranked in the preseason for the 29th time in time in the 32-year history of the poll. With the preseason ranking, Kansas has appeared in each of the last 229 coaches' polls, which is the longest active streak in coaches' poll history.

The No. 5 ranking marks the 15th time in the Bill Self era that the Jayhawks have been preseason seventh or higher, including each of the last nine seasons.

Kansas is scheduled to play 12 games against teams ranked in the 2020-21 coaches' preseason poll this season. Those include: No. 1 Baylor (twice), No. 2 Gonzaga, No. 9 Kentucky, No. 11 Creighton, No. 13 Texas Tech (twice), No. 14 Tennessee, No. 15 West Virginia (twice) and No. 22 Texas (twice).

KANSAS IN THE AP PRESEASON POLL

For the eighth-consecutive year Kansas entered the 2020-21 season ranked seventh or higher as KU was No. 6 in the 2020-21 preseason Associated Press (AP) poll released Nov. 9.

Under 18th-year head coach Bill Self, this is the 15th time that KU enters the season ranked seventh or higher in the AP preseason poll. Historically, the No. 6 ranking marks the 23rd time since the 1992-93 season that Kansas will enter the season seventh or higher.

Kansas is scheduled to play 11 regular-season games against teams ranked in the preseason AP top 25, including three in the top five: No. 1 Gonzaga, No. 2 Baylor (twice), No. 10 Kentucky, No. 11 Creighton, No. 12 Tennessee, No. 14 Texas Tech (twice), No. 15 West Virginia (twice) and No. 19 Texas (twice).

GARRETT'S PRESEASON HONORS

Senior Marcus Garrett has received numerous preseason honors heading into 2020-21. On Dec. 1, he was named to the John R. Wooden Award Preseason Top 50. On Nov. 23, he was one of 20 listed on the NABC Division I Player of the Year Watch List. The Dallas guard is on the Naismith Player of the Year Trophy Watch List, The Athletic top 20 guards for 2020-21 and received votes when the Associated Press named its preseason All-America team. Additionally, Garrett is on the Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Award watch list and was a unanimous Preseason All-Big 12 selection.

Garrett was the 2020 Naismith Defensive Player of the Year. As a junior, he led the Big 12 in assists (4.6) and assist-to-turnover ratio (2.7) and also ranked among the league leaders in steals (fifth at 1.8). Garrett averaged 4.5 deflections per game, including 6.9 in his last nine outings in 2019-20. For the season, Garrett produced 9.2 points and 4.5 rebounds per game. He was the 2020 Big 12 Defensive Player of the Year, USBWA All-District VI, All-Big 12 Second Team and a unanimous Big 12 All-Defensive Team selection.

KANSAS VS. TOP-25 TEAMS

Kansas' last six losses have been to ranked foes. Last year, KU went 4-3 against top-25 teams in 2019-20. With its win against No. 20 Kentucky (12/1), under Bill Self, KU is 103-53 against AP-ranked opponents, including 1-1 this season. In his 18th season, Self's KU has collected four wins or more over top-25 ranked foes in 14 of those seasons, which includes a 48-25 record from 2014-present.

Kansas' record against top-10 ranked opponents is even more impressive. KU is 19-7 against foes ranked inside the top-10 of the AP poll since 2013-14, including 1-2 in 2019-20, 2-1 in 2018-19 and 4-1 in 2017-18. Since Bill Self's first season, the Jayhawks are 13-4 against AP top-10 teams inside Allen Fieldhouse, which includes KU's wins in nine of those last 10 meetings.

PRESEASON BIG 12 POLL

Kansas found itself in an unusual spot when the coaches Big 12 preseason poll came out for 2020-21. Kansas finished runner-up to Baylor in the preseason poll, ending a nine-year and 19th time in the 25-year history of the league, Kansas was the coaches' top choice in the poll. The coaches were not allowed to vote for their own team.

KU has won 19 outright or shared Big 12 regular-season titles in the previous 24 years since the inception of the league in 1996-97. Included was an NCAA-record 14 consecutive from 2005-18. KU's 62 overall conference titles is also an NCAA record.

Historically, the other 19 times Kansas has been named the preseason favorite, the Jayhawks won the Big 12 regular-season on 15 occasions. This includes the first preseason poll in 1996-97 in which only a media poll was conducted.

PRESEASON STARTING FIVE

Kansas is well represented on the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame's Starting 5 awards released Nov. 2-6. Of the five awards announced, which consisted of 20 candidates per category, Kansas is listed on two of the watch lists. Senior Marcus Garrett is up for the Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Award, while junior Ochai Agbaji is on the Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award list.

Historically, Kansas has had numerous student-athletes named as candidates and finalists, including last year with Devon Dotson for the Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Award and Udoka Azubuike for the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award. In 2017, Frank Mason III was the recipient of the Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Award.

CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Kansas has won 19 of the 24 Big 12 regular-season titles (includes ties), including an NCAA record 14 straight from 2005-18. Kansas' 62 conference titles are the most in NCAA Division I. Kentucky is second with 55 and Penn third at 37. KU's NCAA record 14-straight league titles all came under head coach Bill Self.

TOP-10 TRIUMPHS

The Jayhawks have been stellar when taking on a top-10 team in the regular season during the Bill Self era. The Jayhawks have lost only five regular-season contests against top-10 teams in their last 26 tries. One of those losses came at then-No. 8 Kentucky (1.26.19), a game result which ended an astounding 13-game regular-season winning streak against top-10 foes.

Kansas is an incredible 21-4 in its last 23 regular-season contests against top-10 ranked squads. Since Bill Self took the reins of the Jayhawks in 2003, KU is 41-22 against top-10 teams, a number which includes postseason play.

Kansas continues its five-game homestand when it plays host to No. 9/11 Creighton on Tuesday, Dec. 8, at 4 p.m. (Central). The contest will air on ESPN and it will be the first game where fans will be able to attend the contest in Allen Fieldhouse with an estimated 2,500 capacity.

This series dates back to 1923 and the last meeting was March 14, 1974, a KU 55-54 win in Tulsa in the NCAA Tournament Midwest Regional. Kansas leads to overall series with Creighton, 9-6, and has won the last four matchups.

The Jayhawks are 16-6 all-time in games played on Dec. 5

Dec. 5, 1939: The 1939-40 Kansas team opened the season with a 34-30 win over Oklahoma State in Lawrence. Led by All-Big Six players Ralph Miller, Bob Allen and Howard Engleman, the team tied for first in the conference and finished the season with a 19-6 record overall. In the first-ever NCAA Tournament – the brainchild of coach Phog Allen – the Jayhawks made it to the championship game before losing to Indiana.

2019-20 TOP MOMENTS

- Kansas finished No. 1 in both the Associated Press and *USA TODAY* Coaches' polls. It marked the fourth time KU finished No. 1 in the AP poll (2016, 2010, 1997) and the second time in the coaches' poll (2008).
- Going 28-3 overall, Kansas won 25 or more games for the 15th-straight season, which is an NCAA DI record. The streak started in 2005-06.
- KU went 17-1 in Big 12 play and is the first team in Big 12 history to win 17 league games, surpassing 16 won three previous times (2002, 2012, 2017). KU also became the first team to go undefeated on the road in league play (9-0) under the current double round-robin format (began in 2012-13).
- Kansas won its final 16 games and its 16-game winning streak is the third-longest nationally heading into 2020-21. It is also tied for the fifth-longest in the Bill Self era (since 2003-04).
- KU ended No. 2 in the NET rankings. The Jayhawks' strength of schedule was No. 1. Kansas was the only school with 12 Quadrant 1 wins. KU's 20 Q1 and Q2 combined wins were also more than any other school.

In his honor, there is a cutout of JP near in the KU bench area for home contests and he also has a locker dedicated to him

KANSAS NOTABLES

- Kansas men's basketball great Paul Pierce is one of eight individuals to be inducted into the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2021, the organization announced on Nov. 29. The College Basketball Hall of Fame opened in 2006 with 11 KU-related players and coaches being part of the founding class. Pierce joins Danny Manning (2008) and Clyde Lovellette (2012) as formally being inducted from Kansas. Pierce will be inducted in Nov. 2021.
- Kansas entered the season ranked No. 6 in the preseason Associated Press and No. 5 *USA TODAY* Coaches' top-25 polls. The Jayhawks have been ranked sixth or higher in each of the last eight preseason AP polls and in the top five in the last seven coaches' polls.
- Marcus Garrett has 140 career steals. He is 15 thefts from the KU top 20.
- Redshirt-senior Mitch Lightfoot became the 21st player in KU history to record 100 career blocked shots. Lightfoot has 102 all-time swats and is 24 from the top 15.

- Kansas has 2,305 all-time victories, second most in NCAA Division I history (Kentucky - 2,319).
- Over the last 17 seasons, Kansas has more regular-season conference championships (15) than it has losses at Allen Fieldhouse (14).
- From the 2008-09 season to the present (11 seasons) Kansas has held 411 of its last 440 opponents under 50% shooting.

- The Jayhawks have won 21 of their last 25 regular-season games against AP top-10 teams. Under Bill Self, KU is 41-22 against top-10 opponents, a figure that includes postseason play.
- KU has now won at least 12 league games for 20-straight years, which is the longest active streak in the nation.
- Each KU senior class since 1986-87 has won at least 100 games.
- Kansas has won 25 or more games in each of its last 15 seasons, an NCAA DI record.
- Kansas is the only team in the Big 12 to have a .500 winning percentage or better series record against every conference foe.
- KU is the only Big 12 school to have won a regular-season championship with two different coaches (Roy Williams and Bill Self).
- Kansas is first in the conference in wins with a 331-71 record in Big 12 regular-season games. Texas is next at 242-160. Including the league postseason championship, Kansas is tops at 377-84, while Texas is second at 267-183.
- Under Bill Self, Kansas is 136-9 (93.8%) in Big 12 home games: 8-0 in 2004, 7-1 in 2006, 7-1 in 2007, 8-0 in 2008, 8-0 in 2009, 8-0 in 2010, 7-1 in 2011, 9-0 in 2012, 8-1 in 2013, 9-0 in 2014, 9-0 in 2015, 9-0 in 2016, 8-1 in 2017, 7-2 in 2018, 9-0 in 2019 and 8-1 in 2020.
- Under Bill Self, Kansas has experienced only one regular-season conference sweep by a Big 12 opponent. In 120 regular-season Big 12 home-and-home series during the Self era, Kansas has 81 sweeps, 38 splits and has been swept once.

- Bill Self was named the eighth coach in Kansas basketball history on April 21, 2003.
 - In September 2017, Self was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield, Massachusetts.
 - Self won his 700th career game on Feb. 8, 2020, with KU’s 60-46 win at TCU. He became the 31st coach in NCAA Division I to accomplish the feat, the second youngest and the sixth fastest.
 - While at Kansas, Self has won a national championship, 15 regular-season Big 12 Conference titles, including a KU- and NCAA-record 14-straight titles from 2005-18, and eight league tournament championships.
 - At Kansas, Self has won more regular-season league titles (15) than he has home losses (14) in Allen Fieldhouse. With KU’s win versus Siena (11/18/16), Self became the winningest coach in Allen Fieldhouse, posting his 207th victory in the venue.
 - In his first trip to the Final Four in 2008, Self’s team won the title. Self is one of 11 active coaches in NCAA Division I to have won a national title.
 - In Self’s first 15 seasons at Kansas, he has coached 11 NBA Lottery selections including Andrew Wiggins and Joel Embiid, the No. 1 and No. 3 overall selections in the 2014 NBA Draft. Wiggins was the second-ever Jayhawk to go No. 1 with the other being Danny Manning in 1988.
 - Self has guided his teams to 21-straight 23-win seasons dating back to 1998-99.
 - Self’s teams have won 18 league crowns in the last 21 years. His teams have never finished lower than third in the conference.
 - Kansas’ four-straight 30-win seasons from 2009-10 to 2012-13 are tied for the most consecutive 30-win seasons in NCAA history along with Gonzaga from 2017-20 (note: Memphis did it from 2006-09 yet later vacated the 2008 season).
 - Self was the head coach for Team USA’s U18 team that competed and won gold at the 2018 FIBA Americas Championship held in St. Catherines, Canada, in the summer of 2018.
 - Self is one of five coaches in NCAA Division I history to have led three different teams - Tulsa, Illinois and Kansas - to the NCAA Elite Eight, including seven times with KU (2004-07-08-11-12-16-17). The other coaches are: Gene Bartow, John Calipari, Rick Pitino and Eddie Sutton.
 - A 1985 graduate of Oklahoma State, Self began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Kansas in 1985-86 under head coach Larry Brown. He then returned to his alma mater as an assistant for seven seasons under coaches Leonard Hamilton and Eddie Sutton. His first head coaching job was at Oral Roberts in 1993-94, then Tulsa (1997-98), Illinois (2000-03) and Kansas (2003-present).

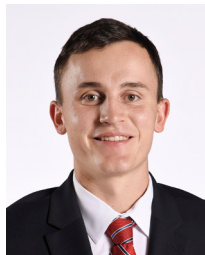
