KANSAS' WIN...

- Made Kansas 11-5 or better for the 15th-straight season beginning in 2006-07.
- Made Kansas 5-4 in Big 12 play.
- Gave Kansas its eighth- straight win against TCU and made the series 22-2 in favor of KU (10-0 in Lawrence meetings, 9-0 in the Allen Fieldhouse).
- Made Kansas 7-1 in Allen Fieldhouse this season, 809-115 all-time in the venue, including 271-15 under head coach Bill
- Improved Self to 512-114 while at Kansas, 719-219 all-time and 26-5 against TCU, 19-2 while at KU.
- Made Kansas 2.313-867 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- This is the 14th time the starting combination of Marcus Garrett, Christian Braun, Jalen Wilson, Ochai Agbaji and David McCormack have started together with a record of 9-5.
- Kansas 59 points marks its second win scoring 60 or fewer points this season.
- Kansas improved to 10-0 when leading the game with 5:00 left in regulation this season.
- Kansas earned this first win when outrebounded by their opponent this season.
- The Jayhawks tied a season-best for block shots with seven blocks.

OPPONENT NOTES

- TCU finished the first half with 19 points, last time TCU scored less than 20 points in the first half was 18 at Texas on February 19th, 2020.
- TCU made 5 free throws, tying the fewest by a Kansas opponent this season.
- TCU committed 22 turnovers, the most by a Kansas opponent this season.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- DaJuan Harris set a tied career high in points, scoring seven points on 3-of-4 from the field on the night.
- Ochai Agbaji scored 13 points on 5-of-14 from the field. He has scored in double figures in all but one game this season.
- With his 15 points on Thursday, David McCormack has scored in double figures eight games this season, including five against Big 12 opponents.
- Mitch Lightfoot registered his seventh charge taken this season which is the most by a Jayhawk this season.
- David McCormack made his first career three pointer, making him 1-of-3 in his career.
- Marcus Garrett recorded his fifth-straight game with two or more assists.
- Ochai Agbaji played 38 minutes, tying the most by a Jayhawk this season.
- Agbaji recorded four assists on the night tying his career high. This is the third straight game that he has recorded an assist; he has now recorded an assist in fourteen games this season.
- With Mitch Lightfoot's three blocks tonight, he moved up to 16th on KU's all-time blocks list with 114 in his career.
- With two steals tonight, Garrett now has a career total 156 steals; which moves him 20th in all-time steals.
