KANSAS' LOSS...

- Made Kansas 11-6 overall, its first 11-6 record since the 2005-06 season when KU was also 11-6.
- Made Kansas 5-3 in the SEC/Big 12 Challenge and 9-5 in conference challenges dating back to 2007.
- Made KU 4-4 against ranked foes in 2020-21.
- Gave Kansas a 4-5 record in games not played in Allen Fieldhouse this season, including 2-4 in true road games.
- Ended Kansas' three game winning streak against Tennessee and made the all-time series 4-2 in favor of KU.
- Made Bill Self 512- 115 while at Kansas, 719-220 all-time and 5-2 against Tennessee, 4-2 while at KU.
- Made Kansas 2,313-868 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas trailed 40-26 at halftime, the largest halftime deficit KU faced this season. The Jayhawks trailed by 13, 41-28 against Baylor on January 18.
- After starting 0-15 from beyond the arc, Kansas finished the game shooting 6-of-24 (25%) from beyond the arc.
- The final score of 80-61 is the second-largest defeat Kansas faced all season, behind only Texas on January 2 (25).

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Kansas redshirt freshman DaJuan Harris made his second career start on Saturday, following his firstcareer start against TCU on Thursday.
- Senior Marcus Garrett made his 67th-career start, including his 16th of the season.
- Junior Ochai Agbaji made his 64th-consecutive start on Saturday, starting all 17 games this season.
- Garrett scored 15 points on Saturday, marking his 30th career game in double figures, including his sixth this season.
- Garrett connected on two 3-pointers on Saturday, marking his fourth game with multiple 3-pointers made, including his second in his last three games.
- Junior David McCormack scored 17 points on 8-of-12 from the field on Saturday, registering his 22nd career game in double figures scoring and his eighth this season.
- Redshirt freshman Jalen Wilson finished with 10 points, marking his 11th game in double-figures, including his eighth game with multiple 3-pointers made.
