#### KANSAS' WIN...

- Made Kansas 12-6 overall and 6-4 in Big 12 play.
- Gave KU four-straight wins against Kansas State and made the all-time series 200-94 in favor of the Jayhawks.
- Gave Kansas 15-straight wins against Kansas State in Allen Fieldhouse, a streak which started in 2007.
- Made KU 8-1 in Allen Fieldhouse this season, 811-115 all-time in the venue, including 272-15 under head coach Bill Self.
- Improved Self to 513-115 while at Kansas, 720-220 all-time and 36-6 against Kansas State, all while at KU.
- Made Kansas 2,314-868 all-time.

#### TEAM NOTES

- Four Jayhawks scored in double figures this season, marking the fifth time KU had four or more scorers in double digits. When having four or more players with 10+ points, Kansas is 3-1 this season.
- The Jayhawks outrebounded the Wildcats, 41-34, marking the 12th time this season Kansas has outrebounded its opponent. The Jayhawks are 11-1 in those games.
- Kansas held Kansas State to 51 points, marking the sixth time this season the Jayhawks held their opponent to 59 points or less. Kansas is 6-0 in those games.
- Kansas only turned the ball over six times on Tuesday, the lowest amount this season and the fewest in a conference game since turning the ball over four times on January 14, 2019.
- Kansas' eight free throw attempts were the fewest this season and the fewest in a conference game since having six attempts against Baylor Jan. 7, 2015.

#### INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Junior Ochai Agbaji scored 15 points on 6-of-10 from the field, marking his 16th double-figure scoring game this season and 38th of his career.
- Agbaji shot 2-of-5 from beyond the arc on Tuesday, connecting on multiple 3-pointers in 15 of 18 games this season.
- Tristan Enurana now has four blocked shots this season, two of which have come in the last three games.
- Junior David McCormack scored 18 points, marking his 23rd-career game in double-figures, including his third-straight and 10th game this season.
- Paired with his 18 points, McCormack grabbed 10 rebounds, marking his fourth double-double this season and the fifth of his career.
- Sophomore Christian Braun registered 18 points on 6-of-11 from the field on Tuesday, marking his 11th career game in double digits scoring, including his fifth this season.
- Braun connected on 4-of-9 from beyond the arc, marking the sixth game this season with three or more 3-pointers, including the 13th of his career.
- Redshirt freshman Jalen Wilson scored in double figures for the 12th time this season, scoring 10 points.
- Redshirt freshman DaJuan Harris was 5:0 in assist-to-turnover ratio on Tuesday, while in his last four games he has recorded 13 assists 0 turnovers, while he has recorded 43 assists and 13 turnovers on the season.
