#### KANSAS' WIN...

- Made Kansas 13-7 overall and 7-5 in Big 12 play.
- Made KU 5-5 against ranked teams in 2020-21.
- Made the KU-OSU series 119-60 all-time in favor of KU, including 65-12 in meetings in Lawrence, 50-10 in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Extended Kansas' home win streak on Big Monday games to 36-straight, as the Jayhawks hold a 44-1 record all-time in Big Monday games inside Allen Fieldhouse.
- Made KU 812-115 all-time in Allen Fieldhouse, 273-15 under Bill Self, including 9-1 this season.
- Was the first win for an unranked KU team over a ranked opponent since January 3, 2009, when the unranked Jayhawks took down No. 14 Tennessee.
- Improved Bill Self to 514-116 while at Kansas, 721-221 all-time and 23-14 against Oklahoma State, including 22-11 while at KU.
- Made Kansas 2,315-869 all-time.

## **TEAM NOTES**

- Kansas had five players score 10 or more points, with David McCormack leading the team with 23 points. Kansas has now had five players in double figures four times, including the second straight game, while the Jayhawks are 3-1 in those games.
- Three Jayhawks registered a double-double on Monday, including David McCormack, Jalen Wilson, Christian Braun. The last time three Jayhawks accomplished such a feat was against on February 11, 2019.
- Kansas out-rebounded the Cowboys, 45-35, making this the 14th time this season. The Jayhawks improve to 12-2 when this happens.
- Kansas scored 50 points in the second half on Monday, marking the third time this season the Jayhawks have scored 50 points in a half this season.
- Kansas set season highs with 27 free throws and 34 free throw attempts.

#### **INDIVIDUAL NOTES**

- Marcus Garrett had 12 points in the first half. He went 5-5 from the field and 2-2 from the free throw line. Garrett went on to finish with 17 points, marking his second straight and 8th game this season scoring in double figures.
- Christian Braun had 10 rebounds against Oklahoma State, marking his second-straight game and 10th this season where he pulled down five or more rebounds.
- Braun's 10 rebounds were paired with 15 points which made for his first career double-double.
- Jalen Wilson had 11 rebounds against Oklahoma State. He has had seven or more rebounds in 12 games this season including each of his last two and three of his last four appearances.
- Paired with his 11 rebounds, Wilson added 11 points. This marks his fifth career double-double, all of which have come
- David McCormack had 23 points, including 21 in the second half. He has now scored in double figures for five straight games and scored over 20 in three games this season. McCormack's 21 points in the second half are the most since Jalen Wilson scored 21 against Kentucky earlier this season.
- McCormack shot 9-of-12 from the free throw line, all of which came in the second half, marking the most free throws made and attempted in a game this season. McCormack's 12 attempts in the second half were the most since Devonte' Graham attempted 13 in the second half against Texas Tech on January 2, 2018.
- Ochai Agbaji had 10 points which marked his 18th game this season scoring in double figures.
- Agbaji also tied a Jayhawk season-high four steals on Monday, tying his career-high previously set against Duke November 5, 2019.
- Senior Mitch Lightfoot registered three blocks on Monday, tying the Jayhawk season-high. He has done it four times this season, while David McCormack registered three blocks once.
