KANSAS' LOSS...

- Dropped its record to 10-4 in games not played in Allen Fieldhouse this season.
- Made Self 752-228 all-time, including 545-123 while at Kansas.
- Made Kansas 2,346-876 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas scored 22 second chance points, a season high in conference play.
- Kansas grabbed 16 offensive rebounds on Saturday. KU has secured 10+ offensive rebounds in 17 games this season.
- Kansas and Baylor split the season series for the third consecutive year.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior Ochai Agbaji finished with a game-high 27 points, six rebounds and three assists in 33 minutes. He now has 1,471 career points which puts him at 26th on the all-time KU scoring list. His 228 career three-point field goals have him at seventh on the all-time KU list.
- Agbaji has scored in double figures in 27 games this season, which is tied for the fourth-longest streak in the Bill Self era with Marcus Morris and Thomas Robinson. Agbaji has scored at least 20 points in 16 games this season and 23 times in his career.
- Junior Christian Braun posted his second double-double of the season (third career) with 17 points and 10 rebounds in 38 minutes. Braun has scored in double figures in 25 games this season.
- Senior David McCormack recorded his eighth double-double of the season with 10 points and a game-high 13 rebounds, to go along with two steals in 31 minutes. McCormack leads the Big 12 with seven of those double-doubles coming in conference games.
