KANSAS' WIN...

- Made Kansas 21-8 and gave KU 21 victories for the 32nd consecutive season beginning in 1989-90.
- Made KU 4-1 in neutral-site games this season.
- Gave KU its 14th-straight NCAA Tournament first- game victory, which started in 2007.
- Made KU 35-2 in its last 37 NCAA Tournament round-of-64 games, beginning in 1981.
- Made KU 9-4 all-time as the No. 3 seed and 5-1 versus the No. 14 seed.
- Made KU 2-0 all-time against Eastern Washington and 15-0 versus current membership of the Big Sky Conference.
- Made Bill Self 522-117 while at Kansas, 729-22 all-time, 49-20 all-time in the NCAA Tournament (39-15 while at KU) and 2-0 all-time versus Eastern Washington.
- Made Kansas 2,323-870 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Junior Ochai Agbaji started his 76th consecutive game on Saturday, which is the 12th longest on the KU career charts.
- Senior Mitch Lightfoot started his first game since his sophomore season on Saturday, which was against Seton Hall in the first round of the 2018 NCAA Tournament. Saturday's start marked the eighth of his career.
- Saturday's game was just the second game this season that David McCormack did not jump tip. Lightfoot jumped the opening tip for the first time this season.
- Senior Marcus Garrett secured his fourth-straight double-digit scoring effort on Saturday, scoring 20 points on 8-of-12 from the field. Garrett has scored in double figures 14 times this season and 38 times in his career, while it was his third game this season and fifth of his career with 20 or more points.
- Garrett connected on 3-of-5 from beyond the arc, marking his third game this season with three or more made 3-pointers. Garrett also hit three or more from long range against Oklahoma and West Virginia.
- Kansas iunior Da
- vid McCormack scored 22 points and pulled down nine rebounds, marking his 19th game scoring in double figures and 18th game with five or more rebounds this season. Five of McCormack's nine rebounds came on the offensive end.
- Redshirt freshman Dajuan Harris scored a career-high 13 points on Saturday. His previous high of seven points came against TCU (twice).
- Harris connected on 3-of-4 from beyond the arc, his first career game with multiple 3-pointers.
