KANSAS' WIN...

- Makes Kansas 3-0 for the 10th time in head coach Bill Self's 19 season at KU.
- Makes Kansas 2-0 in Allen Fieldhouse this season, 279-15 under Bill Self and 817-115 all-time in the venue.
- Gave Kansas its 21st straight-win in Allen Fieldhouse against non-conference opponents and 135-5 overall under Self.
- Made Bill Self 524-118 while at Kansas, and 732-223 overall.
- Made Kansas 2,326-871 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas shot 50.0% (35-of-70) from the field, its second straight game shooting at least 50%. The last time the Jayhawks shot 50% or better in back-to-back games was the first two games of the 2020 season (Nov. 26-27, 2020).
- Kansas had four players score in double figures (Ochai Agbaji 25, David McCormack 12, Christian Braun - 11, Zach Clemence - 11).
- Kansas scored 36 points off the bench, its most since they scored 47 vs. Omaha on December 11, 2020.
- The Jayhawks knocked down 10 three-point field goals, the first time this season they have hit double-digits.
- Kansas held a 48-20 advantage on points in the paint.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior Ochai Agbaji finished with 25 points on 52.6% (10-of-19) shooting, four rebounds, three assists and two steals in 30 minutes. He has finished with 20+ points in all three games this season and it is his 10th career game with at least 20 points. Agbaji is one point shy of 1,000 career points.
- Agbaji also extended his consecutive games started streak to 80.
- Senior David McCormack had 12 points on 62.5% (5-of-8) shooting and a team-high eight rebounds in 15 minutes of action.
- Freshman Zach Clemence contributed 11 points and six rebounds, both career bests, in 12 minutes off the bench.
- Junior Christian Braun added 11 points on 80.0% (4-of-5) shooting and seven rebounds in 24 minutes.
