KANSAS' WIN...

- Made Kansas 3-1 for the eighth time in the Bill Self era (2003-04, 2006-07, 2008-09, 2011-12, 2012-13, 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17).
- Made the KU-ETSU series 4-0 in favor of the Jayhawks.
- Made Kansas 13-0 against current membership of the Souther Conference.
- Gave KU its 24th-straight home win, including 23 in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Made Kansas 15-6 in the Maui Jim Maui Invitational.
- Made KU 791-113 all-time in Allen Fieldhouse, including 253-13 under Self
- Improved Self to 476-107 while at Kansas and 683-212 for his career.
- Made Kansas 2,277-860 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas used a 23-5 run to jump out to a 27-10 lead with 8:53 remaining in the first half. During the run, Kansas held East Tennessee State without a bucket for a span of 2:48.
- The Dotson, Azubuike duo finished the night accounting for 40 of Kansas' 75 points.
- Kansas held a 43-31 lead at the half, marking the third time the Jayhawks have had the lead at the break this season. Kansas is now 3-0 in those contests with a record of 386-31 in the Self era.
- The Jayhawks held a 65-56 advantage with 5:00 remaining. Kansas is now 3-0 when leading at the 5:00 mark this season, the Jayhawks hold a 436-17 mark in the Self era.
- KU finished the night 1-for-14 from three, marking the fewest three point
 makes since the Jayhawks made none against TCU on Mar. 12, 2015.
 Kansas' 7.1 percent from deep was the lowest by a Jayhawk team since
 that game as well.
- The Jayhawks outscored ETSU 54-24 in the paint, marking the secondconsecutive game that Kansas has outscored its opponent by 20 or more in the paint.
- The Jayhawks shot 56 percent on the night, the second time this season KU has shot 50 percent or better. Kansas is 2-0 in those contests to go with a 253-9 record in the Self era.
- Kansas was outrebounded for the first time this season (33-32).
 Under Self, the Jayhawks are now 101-54 when outrebounded by their opponent.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

Senior Udoka Azubuike

- Became just the third Jayhawk since 1996-97 (Andrew Wiggins and Eric Chenowith) to post 20+ points, 7+ rebounds, 4+ blocks and 3+ steals in a game.
- His 10 2-point field goals were the most by a Jayhawk since Dedric Lawson tallied 11 against Iowa State on Jan. 21, 2019.
- Led the Jayhawks with 21 points on a 10-for-13 night.
- Grabbed a team high seven rebounds while adding four blocks.
- Azubuike's four blocks moved him to 20th all-time with 100 blocks as he surpassed both Mitch Lightfoot and Paul Pierce who each tallied 98.
- Tied his career high with three steals, a mark he set against Oklahoma on Feb. 19, 2018.

Junior guard Marcus Garrett

• Finished 4-of-6 from the field as Garrett scored a season high 13 points while grabbing six rebounds and adding three assists.

Junior Silvio De Sousa

• Blocked a career high three shots replacing his previous high of one which he had set four times, the latest against Monmouth on Nov. 15, 2019.

Freshman Tristen Enaruna

 His four steals marked the most by a KU freshman since Marcus Garrett pilfered four against South Dakota State on Nov. 17, 2017.

Sophomore Devon Dotson

- Posted his fourth-straight double-digit game this season, tallying 19 points with six assists and three rebounds.
- Went a perfect 6-for-6 from the free throw line as Dotson improved his season total to 27-for-31.
