KANSAS VS. INDIANA STATE

Kansas is slated to host Indiana State March 6-8 at Hoglund Ballpark in its first home series of the season. The Jayhawks last competed against Creighton March 4, beating the Bluejays, 3-2. Indiana State boasts a 6-5 record, and last played against San Diego, March 2, earning the 5-1 victory over then 9-2 Toreros.

OPPONENT PREVIEW: INDIANA STATE

Indiana State enters the Jayhawks' first home series of the season 6-5 and is on a four-game winning streak. The Sycamores recently swept Elon (Feb. 28-March 1) and beat San Diego in a midweek clash March 3.
The Sycamores probable starters against the Jayhawks are Tristan Weaver (Friday), Colline Liberatore (Saturday) and Cameron Edmonson (Sunday). Weaver is the team leader in inning pitched (19.2) and strikeouts (31), while boasting a 0.46 earned run average. Liberatore has made three starts this season, totaling 13 innings pitched, while recording a 5.54 ERA. Edmonson has appeared in four games with one start and has a 1.32 ERA in 13.2 innings pitched with 21 strikeouts.
Jordan Schaffer leads the Sycamores with a .366 average and has amassed a team-high 15 hits on the season. Brian Fuentes is the team leader in RBI (11), total bases (20), slugging percentage (.444) and home runs (11).

HAZELWOOD NAMED BIG 12 CO-NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK

Everhett Hazelwood was named Big 12 Co-Newcomer of the Week after his 12-strikeout and one-walk performance at Charleston Southern Feb. 22. Hazelwood's strikeout total was a season-high.

Kaimana Souza-Paaluhi is 31st in batting average (.455) and 21st in on base percentage (.571).
Jonah Ulane is 44th in the NCAA in saves (2).

BIG 12 RANKINGS

Kaiman Souza-Paaluhi is second in the Big 12 in batting average (.455).
Casey Burnham is third in the Big 12 in doubles (6) and doubles per game (0.50).
Benjamin Sems is second in the conference in hit by pitches (5) and hit by pitches per game (0.42). Sems is third in base on balls (11) and base on balls per game (0.92), and ranks first in the Big 12 in toughest to strikeout (12.7).
Everhett Hazelwood is sixth in the Big 12 with 23 strikeouts.
Cole Larsen is fourth in the Big 12 in strikeouts-to-walks ratio (9.50).

PROBABLE STARTERS VS. INDIANA STATE

Kansas will continue to use Ryn Cyr (Friday), Everhett Hazelwood (Saturday) and Eli Davis (Sunday) as its starting weekend rotation. All three have made three starts this season with Davis and Hazelwood boasting two wins.

GET ON BASE ...

Benjamin Sems compiled a streak of 11-consecutive plate appearances reaching base, which included three hits, five walks and three hit by pitches. The streak started in the series finale against Charleston Southern Feb. 23 and ended against Ball State Feb. 29.
Skyler Messinger had a streak of 10-consecutive game reached base streaks which started against Belmont Feb. 15 and ended March 4 against Creighton.

NEWCOMER IMPACT

Seven newcomers played against the Belmont Bruins with Anthony Tulimero, Logan Williams, Zach Hanna, Blake Ebo and Everhett Hazelwood all earning starts in the three-game series. Tulimero, a freshman from Temecula, California, started all three games of the Belmont series behind the plate, tallying two successful throw outs and a pick off at first base. Tulimero earned three more starts against Charleston Southern.

Hazelwood was dealing in his second start of the season, finishing with 12 strikeouts to one walk against Charleston Southern. Hazelwood is the team leader in strikeouts (23), while fellow junior college transfer Cole Larsen is second with 19.

IT'S ALL ABOUT SUNDAY

Dating back to last season against Baylor (March 31, 2019), Kansas had won 10-straight Sunday contests, ending against Western Carolina March 1, 2020. Redshirt-sophomore Eli Davis had started eight of the contests and had a 4.98 ERA and 5-0 record in that span.

KANSAS VS. CREIGHTON | MARCH 4

Kansas earned a victory in its 2020 home opener vs. Creighton, 3-2, at Hoglund Ballpark. Kansas received three innings each from Steve Washilewski and Cole Larsen, while Nathan Barry (winning pitcher), Blake Goldsberry and Jonah Ulane each pitched one inning with Ulane earning his second save of the season. Nolan Metcalf finished with two RBI, including a single through the left side of the infield to plate the winning run in the seventh.

FIRST PITCH INVITATIONAL | FEB. 28 - MARCH 1

Kansas opened the First Pitch Invitational against Michigan State and rallied in the last inning to tie the game at 7-all. MSU earned the walk-off victory on a single to right center.
 • KU earned its lone victory of the FPI, beating Ball State, 9-3, in game one of its doubleheader vs. the Cardinals. Everhett Hazelwood earned his second win at Kansas, while the Jayhawks scored seven runs in the sixth inning.
 • In the second game of the doubleheader, Kansas jumped out early but was unable to stop a late offensive attack by BSU, which scored two runs in the sixth and three in the seventh to capture the 7-4 win.
 • In the final game of the First Pitch Invitational, Kansas faced Western Carolina, falling to the Catamounts, 5-3. WCU scored five runs through four innings and held a 5-1 advantage until the seventh. Anthony Tulimero hit his first career home run - a two-run blast over the Green Monster at Fluor Field.

BELMONT SERIES | FEB. 14-16

Kansas opened the series against Belmont Friday, Feb. 14, falling to the Bruins, 0-6, but rebounded to win the series with 5-1 and 7-6 victories in the Saturday and Sunday contests, respectively.
 • Casey Burnham finished the series with four doubles, while James Cosentino tallied two home runs and four RBI.
 • Ryan Cyr (Friday, Feb. 14), Everhett Hazelwood (Saturday, Feb. 15) and Eli Davis (Sunday, Feb. 16) earned starts for the Jayhawks against the Bruins.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN SERIES | FEB. 21-23

After rain postponed the scheduled Thursday opener, Kansas and Charleston Southern opened the series on Friday, Feb. 21. KU received a standout pitching performance by Ryan Cyr, who tossed a season-high eight innings with six strikeouts. KU dropped the opener, 2-1.

ABOUT SKIP ...

Known for being a tireless worker and enthusiastic recruiter, Ritch Price enters his 18th season directing the Kansas baseball program in 2020. Price has instilled an atmosphere of closeness and competitiveness between his players during his tenure that pushes the Jayhawks to challenge each other every day, creating a roster ready to compete – and win – in the Big 12 Conference.

That unprecedented work ethic by the Jayhawks' skipper, since being hired on July 1, 2002, has rewarded the program with three trips to the NCAA Tournament (2006, 2009 and 2014), which is more than the combined number of appearances the program achieved nearly 100 years before Price.

Because of that, the 33rd head baseball coach at Kansas has propelled himself to the top of the record books, becoming the all-time winningest coach in the history of the program on March 4, 2017, with an 11-7 win over Northwestern State. That 439th win on that day broke a record that stood 35 years, nine months and 27 days by legendary head coach Floyd Temple (438).

Price's 530 wins at Kansas account for 26 percent of the program's 1,950 victories spanning 127 seasons. He enters the 2020 campaign as the longest-tenured coach in the Big 12 Conference and has managed in more league games than any of the other eight skippers.

In his 17 seasons holding the reins at KU, Price has mentored players to 108 all-conference selections, 100 academic all-conference honorees, 72 professional contracts, two Big 12 Newcomers of the Year (Jordan Piché in 2013 & Ben Krauth in 2015), two All-Americans (Don Czyz in 2006 & Tony Thompson in 2009) and one National Stopper of the Year (Czyz in 2006).

2008 USA BASEBALL NATIONAL TEAM

• Ritch Price was named an assistant coach on the 2008 USA Baseball National Team and helped lead the Americans to a perfect 24-0 record during its 2008 tour and its third-straight FISU World Championship. Price also helped Team USA defeat Cuba twice during the summer, marking the first time an American team accomplished the feat.

• Price spent eight seasons at De Anza Community College in Cupertino, California and was selected to the California Community College Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame in 2008.

• In the series finale, Kansas jumped out early on the CSU starter after an opening-home run by Casey Burnham. KU piled on nine runs, while Eli Davis earned his second victory of the season.

BENJAMIN SEMS | PRESEASON AWARDS

• Senior shortstop Benjamin Sems was named to the 2020 Preseason All-Big 12 Team. Sems is the Jayhawks' top-returning player, finishing with a .305 average in 197 plate appearances with 12 doubles and four home runs last season. The Chesterfield, Missouri native led the Jayhawks with 14 steals on 17 attempts.

• Five Jayhawks were honored by the Big 12 last season with Ryan Zeferjahn being the lone KU All-Big 12 First Team selection. Benjamin Sems was selected to the All-Big 12 Second Team, while Ryan Cyr, Jaxx Groshans and Rudy Karre were honorable mention selections.
