KANSAS VS. IOWA

Kansas travels to Iowa City, Iowa for its third-road series of the season March 10-11. KU last hosted Indiana State for a three-game series, winning the opener and dropping the final two games. Iowa enters the two-game midweek series 8-5 and last played in the Snowbird Class, finishing 2-1

OPPONENT PREVIEW: IOWA

Iowa is coached by Rick Heller in his seventh season with the Hawkeyes. Heller has had previous stints at Indiana State and Northern Iowa.
Izaya Fullard leads Iowa in batting average (.385), hits (20), runs (17), RBI (20), total bases (31) and slugging percentage (.596). Fullard is also tied for the team lead in doubles with three and home runs (2). Peyton Williams is second on the team in RBI (15) and has a .292 average. As a team the Hawkeyes have 14 stolen bases in 20 attempts with Ben Norman having a team-high five steals.
Grant Judkins, Jack Dreyer and Duncan Davitt each have started four games for the Hawkeyes this season with Dreyer tallying a team-high 21.2 innings pitched. Judkins is the leader in strikeouts (24) and has 21.0 innings pitched. As a team, Iowa has a 3.94 ERA in 112.0 innings pitched.

HAZELWOOD NAMED BIG 12 CO-NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK

Everhett Hazelwood was named Big 12 Co-Newcomer of the Week after his 12-strikeout and one-walk performance at Charleston Southern Feb. 22. Hazelwood's strikeout total was a season-high.

Cole Larsen is 2nd in the Big 12 in strikeouts-to-walks ratio (10.00) and third in walks allowed per nine innings (1.02).

GET ON BASE ...

Benjamin Sems compiled a streak of 11-consecutive plate appearances reaching base, which included three hits, five walks and three hit by pitches. The streak started in the series finale against Charleston Southern Feb. 23 and ended against Ball State Feb. 29.
Skyler Messinger had a streak of 10-consecutive game reached base streaks which started against Belmont Feb. 15 and ended March 4 against Creighton.

BULLPEN STRENGTH

Blake Goldsberry and Jonah Ulane each have amassed a 0.00 ERA and have pitched in nine innings and 5.1 innings, respectively. Nathan Barry has a team-high 12.1 innings pitched out of the bullpen with a 2.16 ERA, while Daniel Hegarty has pitched 8.1 innings with a 2.16 ERA.

GORZELANNY | KANSAS CONNECTION

Iowa's Director of Player Development - Tom Gorzelanny - was a member of the Kansas Jayhawks in 2002. Gorzelanny transferred to Triton Community College before being selected in the second round of the 2003 MLB Draft. Gorzelanny spent 12-years in Major League Baseball.

NEWCOMER IMPACT

Seven newcomers played against the Belmont Bruins with Anthony Tulimero, Logan Williams, Zach Hanna, Blake Ebo and Everhett Hazelwood all earning starts in the three-game series. Tulimero, a freshman from Temecula, California, started all three games of the Belmont series behind the plate, tallying two successful throw outs and a pick off at first base. Tulimero earned three more starts against Charleston Southern.
Hazelwood was dealing in his second start of the season, finishing with 12 strikeouts to one walk against Charleston Southern. Hazelwood is the team leader in strikeouts (7), while fellow junior college transfer Cole Larsen is second with 20.

KANSAS VS. INDIANA STATE | MARCH 6-8

• KU opened its first home series of the season with a victory over Indiana State March 6. Ryan Cyr notched his first win of the season and received six runs of support in the fifth inning.
• The Jayhawks dropped the final two games of the series to the Sycamores, 9-3 and 8-2. Kansas held opened the series finale with a two-run first inning but ISU tied the score in the second inning and recaptured the lead in the third.

KANSAS VS. CREIGHTON | MARCH 4

• Kansas earned a victory in its 2020 home opener vs. Creighton, 3-2, at Hoglund Ballpark. Kansas received three innings each from Steve Washilewski and Cole Larsen, while Nathan Barry (winning pitcher), Blake Goldsberry and Jonah Ulane each pitched one inning with Ulane earning his second save of the season. Nolan Metcalf finished with two RBI, including a single through the left side of the infield to plate the winning run in the seventh.

FIRST PITCH INVITATIONAL | FEB. 28 - MARCH 1

• Kansas opened the First Pitch Invitational against Michigan State and rallied in the last inning to tie the game at 7-all. MSU earned the walk-off victory on a single to right center.
• KU earned its lone victory of the FPI, beating Ball State, 9-3, in game one of its doubleheader vs. the Cardinals. Everhett Hazelwood earned his second win at Kansas, while the Jayhawks scored seven runs in the sixth inning.
• In the second game of the doubleheader, Kansas jumped out early but was unable to stop a late offensive attack by BSU, which scored two runs in the sixth and three in the seventh to capture the 7-4 win.
• In the final game of the First Pitch Invitational, Kansas faced Western Carolina, falling to the Catamounts, 5-3. WCU scored five runs through four innings and held a 5-1 advantage until the seventh. Anthony Tulimero hit his first career home run - a two-run blast over the Green Monster at Fluor Field.

BELMONT SERIES | FEB. 14-16

• Kansas opened the series against Belmont Friday, Feb. 14, falling to the Bruins, 0-6, but rebounded to win the series with 5-1 and 7-6 victories in the Saturday and Sunday contests, respectively.

ABOUT SKIP ...

Known for being a tireless worker and enthusiastic recruiter, Ritch Price enters his 18th season directing the Kansas baseball program in 2020. Price has instilled an atmosphere of closeness and competitiveness between his players during his tenure that pushes the Jayhawks to challenge each other every day, creating a roster ready to compete – and win – in the Big 12 Conference.

That unprecedented work ethic by the Jayhawks' skipper, since being hired on July 1, 2002, has rewarded the program with three trips to the NCAA Tournament (2006, 2009 and 2014), which is more than the combined number of appearances the program achieved nearly 100 years before Price.

Because of that, the 33rd head baseball coach at Kansas has propelled himself to the top of the record books, becoming the all-time winningest coach in the history of the program on March 4, 2017, with an 11-7 win over Northwestern State. That 439th win on that day broke a record that stood 35 years, nine months and 27 days by legendary head coach Floyd Temple (438).

Price's 531 wins at Kansas account for 26 percent of the program's 1,951 victories spanning 127 seasons. He enters the 2020 campaign as the longest-tenured coach in the Big 12 Conference and has managed in more league games than any of the other eight skippers.

In his 17 seasons holding the reins at KU, Price has mentored players to 108 all-conference selections, 100 academic all-conference honorees, 72 professional contracts, two Big 12 Newcomers of the Year (Jordan Piché in 2013 & Ben Krauth in 2015), two All-Americans (Don Czyz in 2006 & Tony Thompson in 2009) and one National Stopper of the Year (Czyz in 2006).

2008 USA BASEBALL NATIONAL TEAM

• Ritch Price was named an assistant coach on the 2008 USA Baseball National Team and helped lead the Americans to a perfect 24-0 record during its 2008 tour and its third-straight FISU World Championship. Price also helped Team USA defeat Cuba twice during the summer, marking the first time an American team accomplished the feat.

HALL OF FAMER

• Price spent eight seasons at De Anza Community College in Cupertino, California and was selected to the California Community College Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame in 2008.

• In the series finale, Kansas jumped out early on the CSU starter after an opening-home run by Casey Burnham. KU piled on nine runs, while Eli Davis earned his second victory of the season.

• Senior shortstop Benjamin Sems was named to the 2020 Preseason All-Big 12 Team. Sems is the Jayhawks' top-returning player, finishing with a .305 average in 197 plate appearances with 12 doubles and four home runs last season. The Chesterfield, Missouri native led the Jayhawks with 14 steals on 17 attempts.
