TEAM NOTES

Today's season finale against Baylor served as a send off for the 23-man senior class, which has helped shape the Jayhawk football program during their time in Lawrence. The following individuals were honored prior to the game, for Senior Day: Hakeem Adeniji, Jelani Brown, Daylon Charlot, Codey Cole III, Hasan Defense, Kevin Feder, Kezelee Flomo, DeAnte Ford, Hudson Hall, Kolin Hayes, Elmore Hempstead Jr., Azur Kamara, Mike Lee, Willie McCaleb, Clyde McCauley III, Jeremiah McCullough, Manny Miles, Darrius Moragne, Shaquille Richmond, Carter Stanley, Naiee Stevens-McKenzie, Bryce Torneden and Andru Tovi.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- Senior OL Hakeem Adeniji started his 48th-consecutive game on the Jayhawk offense, dating back to his freshman year in Lawrence. In his time donning the Crimson and Blue, Adeniji started every single game of his collegiate career.
- Senior QB Carter Stanley attempted 23 passes in the first half of play to surpass Kelly Donohoe (745) and David Jaynes (754) on the KU career pass attempts all-time charts. He entered today's game with 733 pass attempts, so he entered the second half of play with 756 career pass attempts in his KU career.
- Stanley has had a memorable senior season and has ensured that he will be remembered long after his time in the Crimson and Blue, as he became just the fifth Jayhawk in Kansas history to throw for 5,000 or more career yards on Saturday.
- Senior QB Manny Miles saw playing time under center in the third and fourth quarters, completing 3-of-6 passes for a total of
- With his 11-yard TD reception in the third quarter from QB Manny Miles, junior WR Andrew Parchment recorded his seventh TD reception of the season, moving him into a seven-way tie for eighth place on the list for TD receptions in a season. Fellow junior WR Stephon Robinson Jr., is among those tied for eighth place on the records list. The last time two KU wide receivers caught a combined 15 touchdown passes came in 2009.
- Sophomore RB Pooka Williams Jr., accomplished a feat that has only been done once before in Kansas football history on Saturday, as he surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in back-to-back seasons, joining James Sims (2012-13) as the only other Jayhawk to rush for 1,000 or more yards in consecutive seasons and the fourth Jayhawk to break 1,000 or more season rushing yards more than once in their KU career.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Junior HAWK Kyron Johnson recorded his first sack of the season in the second quarter, taking down Baylor QB Charlie Brewer at the BU 5-yard line. The sack was Johnson's third of his career.
- Junior S Ricky Thomas picked off a Baylor Bears' pass toward the end of the second quarter of play, his first interception of the 2019 season. The interception was the second of his career, with his first coming against Central Michigan in 2018.
- Twenty-four different players contributed to the Jayhawks' defensive effort, having registered at least one solo tackle on the day. Johnson and freshman LB Gavin Potter led the way with six tackles apiece, while Hasan Defense finished with five.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

Junior P Kyle Thompson 73-yard punt in the second quarter was his season's best, previously 62 yards at TCU. His punt today fell just shy of his KU-career high of 76 yards, set vs. Texas in 2018.
