KANSAS' WIN...

- Made Kansas 6-1 in Big 12 play or better for the 14th time in the Bill Self era which began in 2003-04.
- Made the Kansas-Oklahoma State series 117-59 in favor of KU, including a 38-35 edge in meetings in Stillwater and 36-35 edge in Gallagher-Iba Arena clashes.
- Gave KU its fifth straight road win.
- Made Kansas 5-1 in true road games this season and 9-2 in games not played in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Improved Self to 490-109 while at Kansas, 697-214 for his career and 21-13 against Oklahoma State, 20-10 while at Kansas.
- Made Kansas 2,291-862 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- OSU's 50 points were the fewest conceded by the Jayhawks in a road conference game since KU topped Texas Tech 60-46 in Lubbock on Jan. 12, 2013.
- KU held its 13th opponent to less than 60 points this season. The Jayhawks have held nine of their last 11 foes to 60 or fewer points.
- Kansas held the Cowboys to 28.1% (18-of-64) shooting, the lowest percentage by a Big 12 opponent on its home floor since Colorado hit 27.3 percent of its shots against KU on Feb. 14, 2007.
- KU never trailed in the contest, taking the lead 25 seconds into the game and never relinquishing its advantage. The Jayhawks' 39:35 time in the lead was its longest of the year.
- The Jayhawks' connected on 11 3-pointers, there most in a conference game since also hitting 11 triples against Oklahoma State on Feb. 9, 2019.
- The KU defense limited OSU to just one field goal over the first seven minutes of regulation. KU jumped out to 12-2 lead in that span.
- All six of the Jayhawks' field goals during an 18-5 first-half run came from 3-point range. KU went 6-for-9 from deep in that run.
- The Cowboys responded with a 17-1 run to cut the KU lead to one point at 25-24. During this six-minute stretch, KU went without a field goal, going 0-for-9 from the field during that span.
- KU went on a 16-2 run in the early minutes of the second half to turn a 3-point edge back into 17 points less than seven minutes after the restart.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

Freshman Christian Braun

- Notched first-career start, leading the team in scoring for the second time in his last three outings.
- His nine total rebounds (three offensive, six defensive) were a new seaso-n and career-high,
- After going 4-of-8 from 3-point range, his 11-of-22 (50%) from deep over his last three games.

Senior Udoka Azubuike

 His five blocks marked his second-most this season. Over his last six outings, has totaled 24 rejections, good for a 4.0 bpg average in that span.

Junior Marcus Garrett

- Dished out a career-best nine assists on the night, his 10th game this season with five or more assists
- Also scored seven points and pulled down eight rebounds (all eight were in the first half) in 34 minutes of action
- His nine assists tied Dotson for the most by a Jayhawk this season.

Sophomore Devon Dotson

His 11 points marked his 18th game of the season scoring in double-digits.

Senior Isaiah Moss

- Scored in double-figures (13) for the sixth time this season and 49th time in his career.
- Posted his fifth game of the season with three or more 3-pointers made.
