TEAM NOTES

Kansas State quarterback Skylar Thompson is the first quarterback to finish with over 100 yards rushing (127) against the Jayhawks since Greg Windham of Ohio finished with 146 yards on the ground in 2016.

- **OFFENSIVE NOTES** · With 13 completions on the day, senior quarterback Carter Stanley moves to third all-time on the KU career pass completions
 - Stanley's 23 pass attempts also moved him up to fifth place all time on the KU career pass attempts list with 652.
 - With 61 total rushing yards, sophomore running back Pooka Williams Jr., moved into 14th place on the KU career rushing yards list. He currently sits at 1.890 yards.
 - Senior wide receiver **Daylor Charlot** recorded a season-long reception of 32 yards in the fourth quarter.
 - Senior quarterback Manny Miles recorded his first-career rushing touchdown at Kansas with 35 seconds remaining in the fourth quarter. Miles also finished with a season-high 65 yards passing.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Senior Codey Cole III recorded his first sack of the seasin with a 4-yard loss on Kansas State quarterback Skylar Thompson with 25 seconds remaining in the second quarter.
- Sophomore **Davon Ferguson** set a new career high in tackles with eight.

• Junior **Liam Jones** made a 34-yard field goal in the first quarter for his eigth made field goal of the season.
