Team Notes

- Kansas' all-time record goes to 589-664-58.
- Oklahoma State won the toss deferred to the second half, Kansas received the opening kickoff.
- Head coach Lance Leipold moved to 1-7 with the Jayhawks, and 147-46 in his career.

Offensive Notes

- In the third quarter, redshirt freshman Trevor Kardell recorded his first career catch on a five yard pass from super-senior Miles Kendrick. Kardell went on to have two catches for 12 yards.
- Super-Senior Kwamie Lassiter II caught two passes for 10 yards, moving into sole possession of ninth in KU history with 119 career catches. Clark Green stands in eighth with 122 career catches to his credit.
- Kendrick led the team in rushing with five rushes for 32 yards, marking the fourth game this season that a quarterback led the Jayhawks in rushing.

Defensive Notes

- In the first quarter, safety Kenny Logan Jr. recorded his first tackle-for-loss on the season, taking down Oklahoma State's Dominic Richardson for a loss of 1 yard on third down.
- In the second quarter, Kansas' Zion Debose and Ronald McGee paired for a sack on Oklahoma State's Shane Illingworth, resulting in a loss of 2 yards. The sack was the first of their career for both players.
- Rich Miller led the Jayhawks with nine tackles, marking the third game this season that he led the team in tackles. He now has 47 tackles to his credit this season.

Special Teams Notes

- In the third quarter, Jacob Borcila connected on a 45-yard field goal, his sixth field goal of the season. His long of 50 yards came at Duke on September 25.
