KANSAS' WIN...

- Improved Kansas to 92-9 all-time in exhibition games.
- Extended KU's home exhibition winning streak to 54 games dating back to the 1994 season.
- Gave Kansas its 33rd-consecutive exhibition victory.
- Improved Kansas head coach Bill Self to 60-2 in exhibition play while at KU, including 36-0 in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Made KU 65-4 in exhibition games in Allen Fieldhouse.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas shot 39-of-70 (55.7 percent) from the field and 8-of-20 (40.0 percent) from beyond the arc.
- Kansas forced 27 turnovers and scored 32 points off those turnovers.
- Kansas assisted on 24 of its 39 made baskets.
- Thirty of Kansas' 39 points in the first half were scored in the paint. The Jayhawks finished with 62 points in the paint.
- Kansas started the second half on a 15-2 run.
- Kansas' bench scored 44 points compared to 19 bench points for Pittsburg State.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Redshirt junior Jalen Wilson finished with a game-high 23 points on 9-of-17 shooting (52.9 percent) and four rebounds in 25 minutes.
- Freshman Gradey Dick scored 20 points on 7-of-9 shooting (77.8 percent) and grabbed four rebounds in 23 minutes off the bench.
- Redshirt senior Kevin McCullar Jr. contributed 13 points, three rebounds and three assists, two blocks and a game-high five steals in 23 minutes of action.
- Redshirt junior Dajuan Harris Jr. dished out a game-high 10 assists and added six points, two rebounds, one block and three steals in 25 minutes.
