#### THE WIN...

- Makes Kansas 8-1 or better for the fifth-straight season and 13th time in head coach Bill Self's 20 seasons at KU.
- Makes Kansas 3-1 in the Big EAST/Big 12-Battle.
- Marks the 12th straight win in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Makes Kansas 835-116 all-time in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Makes Kansas 2,365-878 all-time.

# **TEAM NOTES**

- Kansas scored a season-high 91 points in the win.
- The Jayhawks scored 51 points in the second half, marking the most since February 22, 2022 vs. Kansas State.
- The Jayhawks had six players score in double figures for the first time since November 15, 2019 vs. Monmouth (McCullarr 17, Dick 15, Wilson 15, Adams Jr. 11, Harris Jr. 10, Udeh Jr. 10). Against Monmouth, the six double-digit scorers were Isaiah Moss (21), Devon Dotson (17), David McCormack (17), Udoka Azubuike (12), Christian Braun (11), Silvio De Sousa (11).
- Kansas has led by 10 or more points at the half in each of its last two games and five times this season.
- Kansas grabbed 11 offensive rebounds. The Jayhawks have at least 10 offensive rebounds in eight of their nine games this season.
- Kansas shot a season-best 56.9 percent (33-of-58) from the floor, which is the team's best since shooting 64.1 percent (41-of-64) on February 22, 2022 vs. Kansas State.
- The Jayhawks shot a season-best 85.7 percent (18-of-21) from the charity stripe, which is the best since shooting 95.0 percent (19-of-20) on March 19th, 2022 vs. Creighton.
- KU forced 16 turnovers, tying its season high (November 25th vs. Tennessee).
- The Jayhawks swiped a season-high 15 steals from the Pirates, led by redshirt senior Kevin McCullar (4). The 15 steals are the most since the Jayhawks also had 15 on November 11th, 2011 vs Towson (15).

#### **INDIVIDUAL NOTES**

- Redshirt junior Jalen Wilson recorded his fifth double-double of the season, finishing with 15 points and 13 rebounds. His 21 career double-doubles puts him 11th on the Kansas all-time career double-doubles list, tied with Eric Chenowith (1998-2001).
- McCullar finished the night with 17 points and 10 rebounds. This is McCullar's second double-double of the season.
- Freshman Ernest Udeh shot 4-of-4 from the field, scoring a career-high 10 points. Udeh also had a career-high four dunks, leading the team in dunks with 10 on the season.
- Freshman Gradey Dick scored 15 points (4-of-9) in 28 minutes. Dick has scored in double-figures in all but two
- Sophomore KJ Adams Jr. scored a career-high 11 points, while also producing three assists. His three steals also marked a new career best.
- Redshirt junior Dajuan Harris Jr. scored 10 points and dished out seven assists. This is the seventh time he posted five or more assists in a game this season.
