THE WIN...

- Made Kansas 15-1 or better for the seventh time in head coach Bill Self's 20 seasons at KU.
- Made Kansas 4-0 in Big 12 play for the ninth time in the Bill Self era and the first time since the 2016-17 season.
- Gave Kansas its season-long ninth-straight win.
- Gave Kansas its 22nd-straight win in Allen Fieldhouse against Oklahoma.
- Gave KU its fourth-consecutive win against Oklahoma.
- Gave KU its 15th-straight win in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Made Kansas 9-0 in Allen Fieldhouse this season, 839-116 all-time in the venue, including 301-16 in the Bill Self era.
- Made Kansas 2,372-878 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas finished the game on an 18-4 run over the final 5:19 of the game.
- Kansas' 31 free throws and 39 free throw attempts are the most since the Jayhawks made 33 free throws on 44 attempts against West Virginia on Feb. 13, 2017.
- The Jayhawks made 24 free throws in the second half, the most FTM in a half since Kansas made 24 in the second half on Dec. 1, 2008 vs. Kent State. The 24 FTM are the most in a half of a conference game since making 26 free throws in the second half on Feb. 9, 2008 vs. Baylor. The 31 attempts are the most since the Jayhawks attempted 32 from the charity stripe in the second half of the same contest.
- Kansas allowed a season-low two three-point field goals and a season-low 11.8 percent (2-of-17) shooting from the three-point arc. That is the fewest 3FGM allowed since Jan. 27, 2020 at Oklahoma State. Kansas has only allowed one three-pointer in each of the last three consecutive halves.
- The Jayhawks committed a season-low six turnovers, which is the fewest since KU turned it over five times at Baylor on Feb. 26, 2022.
- Kansas is 14-0 when leading at the half this season.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Sophomore forward Zach Clemence scored eight first half points off the bench, finishing with a season-high 10 points (3-of-6) in the contest. Clemence made two three-pointers, the first time he has multiple threes since Nov. 18, 2021 vs. Stony Brook (2).
- Sophomore forward KJ Adams Jr. finished with a career-high 22 points (8-of-13), the first time he has scored 20+ points in his career and his ninth consecutive game in double-figures. Adams also had two blocks, the seventh time in his career he has had multiple blocks. Adams also made a career-high-tying six free throws from the charity stripe.
- Redshirt junior Jalen Wilson made a career-high 10 free throws (10-of-12 FT), the most by a Jayhawk this season, to go along with 17 points and eight rebounds. Wilson has now scored 1,072 points in his career, passing Kelly Knight (1,057), Otto Schnellbacher (1,062), Rex Walter (1,064) and Udoka Azubuike (1,069) to move into 50th on the all-time scoring list.
- Wilson's 10 free throws and 12 free throw attempts were all in the second half, the most made free throws in a half by a Jayhawk since Devonte Graham made 13 free throws in the second half against Texas Tech on Jan. 2, 2018. The 12 attempts were the most in a half by a Jayhawk since Remy Martin attempted 13 vs. Providence in the 2022 NCAA Tournament.
- Redshirt junior Dajuan Harris Jr. dished out five assists and scored 11 points, finishing in double-figures for the third-straight game and the eighth time this season.
