THE WIN...

- Made Kansas 12-1 in Allen Fieldhouse this season, 842-117 all time in the venue, including 304-17 in the Bill Self era
- Made Bill Self 575-129 while at Kansas, 778-234 all-time and 27-12 versus Texas, 27-10 while at KU
- Made Kansas 2.376-882 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas has won 40-straight Big Monday games on ESPN. Head Coach Bill Self has won 36 straight.
- Kansas scored 42 points on 18-of-38 shooting in the first half, the most since Jan. 7 at West Virginia (42).
- Five Jayhawks scored in double-figures, the fifth time this season that at least five Jayhawks have scored in double-figures. (Dick-21, Harris-17, McCullar-16, Yesufu-14, Adams-10).
- KU pulled down 14 offensive rebounds, the most in a conference contest this season. Kansas has 10 or more offensive rebounds in 17 of their 24 games this season.
- Kansas is 15-0 when KU outrebounds its opponents.
- Kansas forced 15 turnovers from the Longhorns. The 15 TO's ties for the most against a Big 12 conference foe this season (Jan. 21 vs. TCU, Jan. 17 at Kansas State and Jan. 3 at Texas Tech).
- Despite score 88 points, Kansas only made two three-pointers, the least in a conference game since Feb. 3, 2020 vs. Texas.
- The Jayhawks scored 50 points in the paint, which ties for the most points scored in the paint this season (vs. Indiana and vs. Southern Utah).
- Kansas was running, scoring 24 points in the fast break, the most fastbreak points Kansas has scored this season.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Freshman Gradey Dick finished with 21 points (7-of-11), four rebounds and two steals. This is the sixth time this season Dick has scored 20 or more points.
- Redshirt junior Dajuan Harris Jr. scored 17 on 50 percent shooting (8-of-16) from the floor. His eight made field goals set a new career-high. Harris also pulled down a career-high six rebounds in the contest, along with four steals, tying his career-high.
- Redshirt senior Kevin McCullar Jr. scored 16 points, 10 of which coming from the charity stripe (10-of-13).
- Junior Joseph Yesufu scored a Kansas career-high-tying 14 in the game, going perfect from the free throw line (5-of-5).
- Sophomore KJ Adams Jr. pulled down eight rebounds and scored 10 points (4-of-7) in 30 minutes. His seven offensive boards are the most since David McCormack at Baylor, Feb. 26, 2022 (7).
