- Dropped Kansas to 82-29 in league tournament play, including 52-13 in the Big 12 Championship.
- Made Kansas 48-11 all-time in the T-Mobile Center, including 2-1 this season.
- Made Kansas 2,384-884 all-time.

## **TEAM NOTES**

- The starting lineup of Yesufu, Harris, Dick, Wilson and Adams opened the game for the third time this season, most recently in the Big 12 Quarterfinal win against West Virginia on March 9.
- This combination is now 3-1 in games started this season, while the five have combined for 241 starts.
- Kansas won the opening tip, marking the 17th time this season the Jayhawks controlled a jump ball.
- Junior Joseph Yesufu scored Kansas' first points on a jumper, marking the second time this season that Yesufu scored Kansas' first points and the 10th time the opening points came on a jump shot.
- Kansas trailed at halftime, 39-33, marking the ninth time Kansas has trailed at the break this season. Kansas is now 2-7 in games after trailing at half.

### **INDIVIDUAL NOTES**

- Redshirt junior Jalen Wilson scored 24 points on 9-of-19 from the field on Saturday, marking his 72nd career game in double figures and 32nd of the season. Wilson has scored in double-figures in each of the last six games.
- With Wilson's 24 points, he moved into 27th on KU's career-scoring list with 1,435 points, passing Wilt Chamberlain (1,433 points).
- Wilson's 24 points also marked his 27th career game with at least 20 points, including his 20th this season and his fifthstraight.
- Wilson went 2-of-5 from beyond the arc on Saturday, moving him into a tie for 14th on KU's all-time 3-point field goal attempts list. He surpasses Mario Chalmers (430), Elijah Johnson (430) and ties Tyrel Reed (433).
- Yesufu scored 11 points on 5-of-11 from the field, marking his fourth 10+ point performance, all of which have come this season. Yesufu's career-high of 14 points has occurred three times this season, most recently against Texas on Feb. 6.
- Freshman Gradey Dick recording one steal, moving him into a tie for seventh in KU history on Kansas' freshman steals list, tying with Devon Dotson (2019) with 49 steals.
- Wilson and Dajuan Harris were named to the Big 12 All-Tournament team.
