- No. 1 Kansas will face No. 25 Illinois in exhibition play on Sunday, Oct. 29, at 5 p.m. at State Farm Center in Champaign, Illinois. The meeting was originally scheduled as a secret scrimmage but KU head coach Bill Self and Illini coach Brad Underwood made the game a fundraiser to providing financial resources for rapid response and recovery for the devastating wildfires on Maui.
- Kansas Athletics is partnering with the Maui Invitational Hoops for 'Ohana online auction in conjunction with the Hawai'i Community Foundation's Maui Strong Fund, which is dedicated to providing financial resources for rapid response and recovery for the devastating wildfires on Maui. Fans will have the opportunity bid on the jerseys worn by the men's basketball team Oct. 29 and additional experiences and merchandise donated by Kansas Athletics. All proceeds will benefit the Maui Strong Fund. You can visit mauivinational.com/hoopsforohana and the auction will remain Oct. 29 now through Nov. 22, 2023.
- This is actually Kansas' third exhibition game this season. The Jayhawks went 2-1 in three exhibition contests in Puerto Rico, Aug. 3-7. KU senior Hunter Dickinson led the team with a 19.0 ppg and 7.0 rpg. Redshirt-senior Dajuan Harris Jr. paced KU with 6.7 assists per contest and 3.6 steals per game.
- Kansas coach Bill Self coached three seasons at Illinois from 2000-01 to 2002-03 before taking over at KU. Self was 78-24 at Illinois with two regular-season Big Ten titles (2001, 2002), one Big Ten tourney title (2003). This is Self's first trip back to Champaign.
- The Kansas-Illinois series is tied at 3-3. This will be the first meeting in Champaign. The last meeting between the two schools was in the second round of the 2011 NCAA Tournament in Tulsa. Kansas won 73-59 en route to an Elite Eight appearance.
- Kansas is No. 1 in the Associated Press poll for the fourth time in poll history with all four in the Bill Self era - 2004-05, 2009-10, 2018-19 and 2023-24.

ABOUT KANSAS

Kansas is coming off a 28-8 season in which it won the Big 12 regular-season title with a 13-5 league record. It was KU's NCAA-record 63rd conference regular-season title and 16th under head coach Bill Self in his 20 seasons at Kansas.

Kansas returns three starters – KJ Adams Jr., Dajuan Harris Jr. and Kevin McCullar Jr. – and eight letterwinners from last season's. KU welcomes nine newcomers including the 2023-24 coaches' Big 12 Preseason Player of the Year and the Big 12 Preseason Newcomer of the Year Hunter Dickinson who was named Oct. 12. Dickinson, Harris and McCullar were on the All-Big 12 Preseason team as well.

In August 2023, Kansas went 2-1 in three exhibition contests in Puerto Rico, Aug. 3-7. KU senior Hunter Dickinson led the team with a 19.0 ppg and 7.0 rpg. Redshirt-senior Dajuan Harris Jr. paced KU with 6.7 assists per contest and 3.6 steals per game.

With Dickinson leading the way, Kansas had four players average in double figures in Puerto Rico with McCullar at 13.6 ppg, Adams at 13.0 ppg and freshman Elmarko Jackson at 10.6 ppg. Adams shot a team-best 71.4 percent from the field, including 2-for-3 from three-point range. McCullar was second on the team with a 6.3 rebound average. Graduate Nicolas Timberlake made a team-high six threes in the three contests.

ABOUT ILLINOIS

Located in Champaign, Illinois, with an enrollment of 56,644, Illinois will be playing its second exhibition game of the 2023-24 season. The Illini defeated Ottawa (Kan.), 116-65, on Oct. 20 in Champaign.

The Illini are coached by Brad Underwood who is 114-79 in his seventh season at Illinois and 223-106 in his 11th season overall. Prior to Illinois, Underwood was a head coach at Stephen F. Austin for three seasons (2013-14 to 2015-16) and on at Oklahoma State (2016-17). Underwood was 0-2 against Kansas while at OSU.

Illinois is coming off a 20-13 season where it finished tied for fifth in the Big Ten with an 11-9 league record.

In the Ottawa win, Illinois was led by fifth year guard Terrence Shannon Jr. who scored 18 points on 6-of-9 shooting. Freshman guard Dra Gibbs-Lawhorn had 15 points, while freshman forward Amani Hansberry added 14 points and led all rebounders with 12. Graduate guard/forward Marcus Domask led Illinois with six assists.

THE KANSAS-ILLINOIS SERIES

KANSAS IN EXHIBITION PLAY

Kansas is 94-10 in exhibition history after going 2-1 in Puerto Rico in early August. The 87-81 loss to the Bahamian National Team on Aug. 7, ended a 35-straight exhibition winning streak for Kansas, a streak that dated back to Oct. 30, 2012. KU has won the last 54 exhibition games in Allen Fieldhouse beginning in 1994. With the 106-71 win versus Puerto Rico Select Team on Aug. 3, 2023, Kansas has scored 100-plus points in 31 exhibition games, including 15 under head coach Bill Self. The Jayhawks are 62-3 in exhibition play in Self's 20 seasons at KU.

BILL SELF & NORM ROBERTS RETURN TO CHAMPAIGN

Kansas head coach Bill Self will be making his first trip back to Champaign, Illinois where he coached three seasons from 2000-01 to 2002-03 before taking over at KU. Self was 78-24 at Illinois with two regular-season Big Ten titles (2001, 2002), one Big Ten tourney title (2003). This is Self's first trip back to Champaign.

KU assistant coach Norm Roberts was on Self's staff at Illinois where he was an assistant coach the first two seasons in 2000-01 and 2001-02 and associate head coach in 2002-03. Roberts is in his 13th season at Kansas which includes the 2003-04 campaign. After a head coaching stint at St. John's and assistant coach position at Florida, Roberts returned to Kansas in June 2012.

JAYHAWKS NO. 1 IN PRESEASON POLLS

Kansas enters the 2023-24 season No. 1 in both the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' polls. This marks the fourth time KU has been No. 1 in the preseason AP poll with all four in the Bill Self era - 2004-05, 2009-10, 2018-19 and 2023-24. This is the fifth time in the coaches' poll that the Jayhawks have been No. 1 in the preseason poll with four in the Self era - 1996-97, 2004-05, 2009-10, 2018-19 and 2023-24.

Under 21st-year and Hall of Fame head coach Bill Self, this is the 18th time that Kansas entered the season ranked seventh or higher in the Associated Press preseason poll. Historically, the No. 1 ranking marks the 26th time since the 1992-93 season that Kansas will enter the season seventh or higher.

The No. 1 ranking marked the 10th-straight year Kansas has entered the season No. 5 or higher in the coaches' poll dating back to 2014-15. Additionally, it is the 18th time in the Self era the Jayhawks have been preseason seventh or higher, including each of the last 12 seasons.

KU PICKED FIRST IN THE PRESEASON BIG 12 POLL

For the 20th time in the 27-year history of the coaches' preseason Big 12 poll, Kansas has been selected as the favorite to win the conference as preseason poll was announced Oct. 13.

For the 2023-24 poll, the Jayhawks collected 12 of a possible 13 first-place votes and finished with a total of 168 points. Houston received two first-place nods and was second with 153 points. Texas was third with 143 points, while Baylor was fourth 137 points and TCU fifth with 113 points to round out the top five. The remaining outcome went No. 6 Kansas State (106), No. 7 Iowa State (95), No. 8 Texas Tech (80), No. 9 West Virginia (70), No. 10 Oklahoma State (57), No. 11 Cincinnati (55), No. 12 Oklahoma (54), No. 13 BYU (29) and No. 14 UCF (14).

PRESEASON ALL-BIG 12

Kansas men's basketball senior Hunter Dickinson, redshirt-junior Dajuan Harris Jr. and graduate Kevin McCullar Jr. were named to the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big 12 Team as voted on by the league coaches, the conference announced Oct. 12.

Dickinson is the Big 12 Preseason Player of the Year and the Big 12 Newcomer of the Year, becoming the first player in conference history to earn both honors in the same season. Dickinson is joined on the Preseason All-Big 12 First Team by Harris, while McCullar is an honorable mention honoree.

Historically, Dickinson is the 11th Jayhawk to collect the preseason player of the year award and the fifth to earn preseason newcomer. Kansas has had at least one player on the Preseason All-Big 12 First Team in all but two of the 28 seasons the conference has existed, since 1996-97. Dickinson and Harris are the 39th and 40th Jayhawks to be listed on the preseason all-league first team.

FOUR JAYHAWKS ARE ON STARTING FIVE WATCH LISTS

In October, the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame announced watch lists for its "Starting Five" for the 2023-24 season. Four Jayhawks were among the 20 watch list honorees with Dajuan Harris Jr. on the Bob Cousy Point Guard Award, Kevin McCullar Jr. on the Jerry West Shooting Guard Award, Johnny Furphy on the Julius Erving Small Forward Award and Hunter Dickinson on the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center Award.

A national committee of top college basketball personnel determined the watch lists of 20 candidates for every starting five.

College basketball fans are encouraged to participate in Fan Voting presented by Dell Technologies in each of the three rounds. In late January, the watch list of 20 players for each honor will be narrowed to 10 and then in late February to five. In March, the Hall of Fame's selection committee will determine the winners.

Historically, Kansas' Jalen Wilson was the 2023 Julius Erving Award recipient and Jayhawk Frank Mason III won the 2017 Bob Cousy Award.

KANSAS TO HOST MCLENDON CLASSIC NOV. 5-6

Kansas Athletics will host the inaugural McLendon Classic over the weekend of Nov. 5-6 on the campus of the University of Kansas. On Sunday, Nov. 5, at 5 p.m. CT, KU will host the McLendon Classic Community Event at the Lied Center. The two-day recognition will conclude when Kansas basketball hosts North Carolina Central on Monday, Nov. 6, at 7 p.m. in Allen Fieldhouse.

The McLendon Classic Community Event will feature a screening of Fast Break: The Legendary John McLendon. Following the showing, there will be a round table discussion featuring KU professor and Emmy Award winning director Kevin Willmott, KU director of equity and success initiatives Melissa Peterson, North Carolina Central head coach LeVelle Moton and KU head coach Bill Self. KU professor Shawn Alexander will serve as moderator to the round table discussion, and the group will share their thoughts about the documentary while exploring the profound impact that John McLendon had on the University of Kansas, the game of basketball and society at large. The McLendon Classic Community Event is free to the public and attendees will have the option to donate resources to the NCCU Black Student-Athlete Summit Experience Fund.

The Nov. 6 basketball game will honor McLendon during the contest. Both teams' coaching staffs will wear patches and feature special pregame shooting shirts. There will be recognitions throughout the contest honoring McLendon as well as moments to highlight current affinity groups at KU that are continuing McLendon's legacy of inclusion, pro activity and perseverance.

Kansas will conclude exhibition play when it hosts Fort Hays State on Wednesday, Nov. 1, at 7 p.m. in Allen Fieldhouse. The contest will be televised on Big 12 NOW via ESPN+.

Kansas leads the series with Fort Hays State, 12-0, including a 10-0 record in exhibition contests. The last eight meetings have been in exhibition play, including a Kansas 85-56 win on Oct. 24, 2019, in Lawrence.
