THE RESULT...

Improves the Jayhawks to 15-7 on the year and 5-6 in Big 12 play.

Makes the Jayhawks 11-2 at home on the season.

KU's third-straight win over TCU.

Gives KU a win over TCU in Lawrence for the third consecutive season.

Improves the Jayhawks to 10-15 all-time verus TCU and 6-5 in Allen Fieldhouse.

TEAM NOTES

For the third time in Big 12 play, Kansas held a team to 10 or fewer points in the first quarter.

The Jayhawks outrebounded TCU 46-27 and KU is now 14-3 this season when outrebounding the opponent.

In the first half, the Jayhawks held the Horned Frogs to 5-of-25 (20.0%) resulting in 19 points. Making it the third time Kansas has held a team to less than 20 points in the first half this season.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

Junior guard Chandler Prater tied her career high points with 19 and posted 3-of-4 field goals from behind the arc, which surpasses her career high three-point field goals. Prater scored double-digits in the second quarter tallying 12 points.

Senior center Taiyanna Jackson scored 13 points with 10 rebounds to record her 15th double-double of the season and 19th in her career. Jackson secured her second consecutive double-double and her fifth in the past six games.

Senior guard Zakiyah Franklin scored 18 points and tied her season-high assists with seven. Franklin has scored in double-digits in seven consecutive games

Senior guard Holly Kersgieter scored 13 points with seven rebounds against TCU. Kersgieter drained three three-point field goals moving her into fourth place on the all-time career rankings list for three-point field goals made with 184, surpassing Erica Hallman (181).

Making her first career start, freshman forward Zsofia Telegdy pulled down a career-high seven rebounds, surpassing her previous best of four.
