THE RESULT...

Improves the Jayhawks to 16-7 on the year and 6-6 in Big 12 play.

Gives KU its second-straight season sweep of Texas Tech.

Is the Jayhawks second-consecutive win.

Improves the Jayhawks to 16-25 all-time versus Texas Tech and 7-13 in Lubbock.

TEAM NOTES

The Jayhawks shot a season-high 54.9% going 28-of-51 from the field and 7-of-17 from behind the arc.

This is the second-consecutive game where the Jayhawks have scored 70+ points and won those games. This marks the 16th time this season where they have scored 70+ points.

The Jayhawks outrebounded Texas Tech 32-29 making it the third consecutive game in where Kansas has outrebounded their opponent and marking the fifth time in Big 12 play.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

Senior center Taiyanna Jackson has scored a career-high with 24 points and secured 11 rebounds in the game to record her 16th double-double of the season and the 20th in her career. That makes it her third consecutive game where she has posted a double-double. Makes it the fourth time this season where she has had 20 or more points in a game. Jackson has tied her career-high with six free throws made, which she has accomplished three times this season.

Senior guard Zakiah Franklin scored 20 points and dished out five assists. She has now scored in double-figures in eight consecutive games this season. She passed her milestone of 1,300 points with 1,313.

Junior guard Chandler Prater scored eight points and dished out a career-high with six assists. This is the third time this season where she has had five or more assists in a game.

Senior guard Holly Kiersgieter scored 18 points with three rebounds, shooting 4-of-7 from behind the arc. She has scored in double-figures in four of the last five games.

Sophomore guard Sanna Strom scored eight points while matching her career-high in rebounds with five. Strom has posted five or more rebounds in a game three times this season.

Holly Kiersgieter went 4-of-4 (100.0%) and Zakiah Franklin 5-of-5 (100.0%) from the foul line. Kansas has had at least two players record 100% from the free throw line 18 times this season.
