### THE RESULT...

- Improved the Jayhawks to 12-1 on the year and 2-0 in Big 12 conference play.
- Gives KU a 2-0 start in league play for just the fourth time since the formation of the Big 12 conference and the first time since the 2012-13 season.
- Gave Kansas its third-straight victory over Texas tech.
- Made KU 8-19 all-time in conference openers.
- Keeps the Jayhawks perfect at home, improving to 8-0.

### TEAM NOTES

- This was the largest win for Kansas over Texas Tech since Jan. 25, 2012 (62-43).
- Kansas led or tied the whole game. The Jayhawks suffocated the Lady Raiders, holding them to 21/52 (40.4%) from the floor and 4/18 (22.2%) from three.
- Kansas dominated down low, out scoring the Lady Raiders 44 to 26 in the paint.
- The Jayhawks dished out a season-high-tying 16 assists, the most since Dec. 4, 2022 vs. Southeast Missouri State.

### INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior guard Holly Kersgieter scored 26 points (10-of-21) and grabbed 5 boards, scoring 11 of her points in the first quarter. This was Kersgieter's first time scoring 20+ points in back-to-back games in her career. With tonight's game, Kersgieter passed Angel Goodrich (1,262 points) and Sade Morris (1,276 points) to move to 17th all-time in scoring.
- Senior guard Zakiyah Franklin finished with 26 points. Franklin has scored in double-figures in 11 games this year. Franklin also dished out 5 assists, which tied her season high and also moved her to 7th all time in assists, passing Kay Kay Hart (356).
- Senior center Taiyanna Jackson corralled 18 rebounds tonight, moving her past 400 career rebounds. Jackson tallied 10 rebounds in the first quarter. With Jackson's 5 blocks, she passed Lynette Woodard and Vickie Atkins (126 blocks each) to move to 5th all-time at KU for blocked shots.
- With Jackson's statline of 15 points and 18 rebounds, it was her 4th straight double double and her 13th of her career.

### THE LAST TIME...

- Both Zakiyah Franklin and Holly Kersgieter scored 20-plus points. This is the first game two Jayhawks scored 20-plus points since Feb. 20, 2021 at Texas Tech.
