THE RESULT...

- Dropped KU to 12-2 on the season and 2-1 in conference play this year.
- Gave KU its first loss at Allen Fieldhouse this season, ending an eight-game home winning streak.
- Extended Baylor's winning streak to 18 consecutive games against Kansas.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas shot a season-high 50.0 percent (5-of-10) from three-point range.
- Kansas held a 16-6 advantage on fast break points.
- The 11 steals by Kansas were the most in a conference game this season and marked the seventh time with at least 10 steals in a game this year.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior center Taiyanna Jackson blocked six shots tonight, moving her into third place past Carolyn Davis (131 blocks) on the all-time blocks list at KU.
- Senior guard Holly Kersgieter surpassed 500 rebounds for her career in the first quarter. Kersgieter also tallied her 11th-straight double-digit scoring game with 11 points.
- Junior guard Wyvette Mayberry finished with 19 points and five rebounds in 36 minutes. Her 19 points were her second-highest total of the season (20 points vs. UTA earlier on Nov. 16, 2022).
- Junior guard Chandler Prater added 11 points and three steals in 30 minutes. She has seven double-digit scoring efforts this season.
