THE RESULT...

Improved the Jayhawks to 21-11 on the year, giving Kansas the second-straight 21-win season Made Kanas 11-5 all-time in the WNIT and 4-2 all-time in the second round of the event Advanced the Jayhawks to the third round of the NIT, where KU will face xx Made KU 45-38 all-time against Missouri Made Kansas 15-3 this season at Allen Fieldhouse

TEAM NOTES

- The Kansas starting five of Zakiyah Franklin, Holly Kersgieter, Wyvette Mayberry, Chandler Prater and Taiyanna Jackson have started 19 games this season, in which the Jayhawks are 12-7 when using this lineup
- All five starters for Kansas recorded double-digit scoring against the Tigers, marking the second consecutive game where five players scored in double figures
- The Jayhawks held the Tigers scoreless for the first 6:30, leading 9-3
- In the first half, Kansas shot 60.9% from the field on 14-of-23 shooting, including 66.7% on 6-of-9 shooting from three
- The duo of Zakiyah Franklin and Holly Kergieter shot a combined 5-5 from behind in the arc in the first half
- The Jayhawks won by a margin on 28 points, which is the largest margin of victory in KU WNIT history
- In the third quarter, the Jayhawks held the Tigers to six points on 2-13 shooting

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior Taiyanna Jackson swatted 2 shots in Kansas' win, setting a new single-season record of blocks with 96. Jackson surpassed the previous record of 95 blocks, which she set in the 2021-22 season. Jackson scored 14 points and brought down eight rebounds
- Jackson brought in eight rebounds to go with her 14 points, good for her 651th rebound of the season
- Senior guard Holly Kergieter scored 12 points, with that, she has scored 1,502 points in her career
- Senior Zakiyah Franklin dropped her 10th 20-point game of the season with 21 points on 7-9 (77.8%) against the Tigers. Franklin also shot 5-of-6 from the arc, setting a new Kansas WNIT record of 3-Point Field Goals made in a single game
- Junior guard Wyvette Mayberry cashed in for 16 points, while dishing out seven assists. Mayberry drained three threes against Missouri for her 100th career 3-Point Field Goal
