TIPOFF

- The 55th season of intercollegiate women's basketball at the University of Kansas tips off on Wednesday, Nov. 9, at Allen Fieldhouse as the Jayhawks host Jacksonville.
- Tipoff is set for 7 p.m. CT and the game will be televised by Big 12 NOW with Josh Klingler and Brenda VanLengen on the call.
- While Kansas will be opening the 2022-23 season on Wednesday night, Jacksonville comes to Lawrence 1-0 following a 109-23 victory over Johnson University on Monday. It will be the first all-time meeting between the programs.
- The Jayhawks return four starters and 11 letterwinners from the breakthrough 2021-22 season. Kansas finished 21-10 and returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2013 under the tutelage of Big 12 Coach of the Year Brandon Schneider.
- Schneider enters his eighth season as the head coach at Kansas in 2022-23, which is his 25th season overall as a head coach. Last season, he guided Kansas to the largest win improvement in program history (+14) and a fifth-place finish in the Big 12 at 11-7.
- Kansas has been tabbed for a fifth-place finish in the Big 12 Conference during the upcoming 2022-23 season. The poll, which is voted on by the league's head coaches, was announced on October 6 by the conference office.

KANSAS NOTES

- Kansas had three players earn a spot on the 2022-23 Preseason All-Big 12 Team. Senior guard Holly Kersgieter was selected to the team while senior guard Zakiyah Franklin and senior center Taiyanna Jackson received honorable mention.
- Kersgieter earned preseason recognition from the Big 12 for the third-straight season, having

previously garnered honorable mention prior to each of the past two seasons. She was named 2022 All-Big 12 First Team as a junior after leading the Jayhawks in scoring at 13.4 points per game.

- Franklin earned All-Big 12 Honorable Mention honors last season after averaging 12.0 points per game and led the Jayhawks with 4.0 assists per game
- Jackson became the first-ever Jayhawk selected to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team last season after setting a new single-season school record with 95 blocked shots, which ranked fourth in the nation.
- The Jayhawks are 6-1 in season openers under head coach Brandon Schneider, including victories in each of the past five years.
- Kansas Women's Basketball is 43-11 all-time in season openers and has played the season opener at Allen Fieldhouse in each of the past 15 seasons. The last time KU started the season away from its home court was in 2006-07, when the Jayhawks played their first two games in Kansas City.
- The Jayhawks have an all-time record of 48-6 in the first home game of the season, including victories in five consecutive home openers.

ABOUT THE JAYHAWKS

- Among the four starters returning for Kansas are Preseason All-Big 12 selections Holly Kersgieter, Zakiyah Franklin and Taiyanna Jackson.
- Kersgieter earns preseason recognition from the Big 12 for the third-straight season, having previously garnered honorable mention prior to each of the past two seasons. She was named 2022 All-Big 12 First Team as a junior after leading the Jayhawks in scoring at 13.4 points per game. During the 2021-22 season, Kersgieter surpassed the 1,000-point milestone for her career and she enters the year ranked No. 24 on KU's all-time scoring list with 1,103 points.
- Franklin, who earned All-Big 12 Honorable Mention honors last season, after averaging 12.0 points per game and led the Jayhawks with 4.0 assists per game as a junior. She enters her senior season ranked 10th on KU's career assists list with 318, and was second in the Big 12 in free throw percentage (85.6%) last season.
- Jackson claimed a spot on the All-Big 12 preseason team for the first time following a dominant first season donning crimson and blue.
 She became the first-ever Jayhawk selected to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team last season after setting a new single-season school record with 95 blocked shots, which ranked fourth in the nation.
- Kansas also returns junior forward loanna Chatzileonti, who was third on the team in scoring (9.9 points per game) and second in rebounding (5.6 per game) last season.
- Other returners for the Jayhawks include guards Chandler Prater, Mia Vuksic and Sanna Strom, forward Katrine Jessen and centers Chisom Ajekwu, Nadira Eltayeb and Danai

- Joining the roster this season are four new players: transfers Wyvette Mayberry and Breeley Oakley and freshmen Bella Swedlund and Zsofia Telegdy.
- Mayberry projects to have the biggest role of the newcomers after playing the first two seasons of her collegiate career at the University of Tulsa. Mayberry started 44 games over two years at Tulsa and was an All-Conference Second Team selection in 2021-22 after leading TU in scoring at 14.1 points per game.

ABOUT THE OPPONENT

- Jacksonville comes to Lawrence with a 1-0 record following a 109-23 victory over Johnson University on Monday morning.
- The Dolphins had seven players reach double figures in scoring during the season opener, led by Tionna Carter with 17 points while Deshari Graham had 16 and Kyshonna Brown added 15.
- Head Coach Darnell Haney is in his fifth year as the head coach at Jacksonville and his 10th year with the program overall. He has a record of 53-58 as the head coach.

RECORD-SETTING SEASON

- The Jayhawks reached several milestones during the 2021-22 season, which culminated with a 21-10 record and a trip to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2013.
- The 21 wins in 2021-22 was an improvement of 14 wins over the previous season, which is the largest win improvement in school history.

Brandon Schneider is in his eighth season at the helm of the Kansas Women's Basketball program. He was named the sixth head coach to lead the Jayhawks on April 20, 2015, and he signed a new four-year contract on March 9, 2022, that will keep him in Lawrence through the 2025-26 season.

Schneider guided the Jayhawks to a breakthrough campaign in 2021-22. Kansas finished the season with a record of 21-10, marking the program's first 20-win season since 2012-13, and the Jayhawks had 20 wins during the regular season for the first time since 1999-2000. Schneider was named the 2022 Big 12 Coach of the Year after guiding the Jayhawks to a fifth-place finish with 11 conference victories, the most by a KU team since 1999-2000.

Schneider led Kansas to the 2022 NCAA Tournament, earning a No. 8 seed in the Spokane Regional. The Jayhawks defeated No. 9-seed Georgia Tech, 77-58, in the opening round before falling to eventual regional champion Stanford in the second round. The tournament bid was the 14th in program history for the Jayhawks and first since 2013.

During his tenure at Kansas, Schneider has coached eight players who earned All-Big 12 postseason recognition. The Jayhawks have also had two players named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team and one named to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team along with three Big 12 Players of the Week and three Freshman of the Week. Schneider has also coached 30 players who received Academic All-Big 12 recognition, including a program-best seven student-athletes earning a spot on the team in 2022. Additionally, Schneider's program set a new team-record with a 3.44 Team GPA in the 2021 fall semester.

Schneider increased the Jayhawks win total in each of his first five seasons in Lawrence, which culminated with a 15-14 record in 2019-20. That year, the Jayhawks finished with a winning record for the first time in seven seasons and were set to play in a postseason tournament prior to the COVID-19 pandemic cancelling the Big 12 Tournament and beyond.

Prior to Kansas, Schneider had a five-year stint at Stephen F. Austin, where he returned SFA to the top of the Southland Conference. Schneider guided SFA to three 20-win seasons and the Ladyjacks won back-to-back league titles in 2013-14 and 2014-15. SFA made three postseason appearances under

Schneider, including the WNIT in 2015 after he was named the Southland Conference Coach of the Year. As head coach at Stephen F. Austin, Schneider was 95-66 overall in five years and 57-29 in Southland Conference play.

Schneider was named head coach of the Ladyjacks on April 20, 2010. Recognized as one of the top names at the NCAA Division II level, Schneider went to Nacogdoches after a highly successful 12-year stint at Emporia State.

The Canyon, Texas native is the second all-time winningest head coach at the NCAA Division II level. At Emporia State, Schneider guided the Lady Hornets to a 306-72 (.810) record, and the 2010 NCAA Division II National Championship. The school's all-time leader in wins and winning percentage, Schneider ranks among the all-time top 10 in fastest coaches to 100 victories, and third fastest among women's basketball coaches

Schneider spent 12 seasons at ESU guiding the Lady Hornets to 11 NCAA Tournament appearances. During that stretch, Schneider's teams recorded two 30-win seasons and nine 20-win campaigns. Along with the 2010 national championship, Schneider coached ESU to four NCAA Division II South Central Regional titles, two Final Four appearances, six regular-season conference crowns and three league tournament titles.

Schneider was the first MIAA rookie head coach to win both the MIAA regular-season and tournament titles. In 2006, the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association of four-year colleges voted Schneider as its coach of the year. He was also a three-time MIAA Coach of the Year.

The 2010 Bulletin Women's Basketball National Coach of the Year and the WBCA South Central Region Coach of the Year, Schneider's players have reaped the rewards of his guidance. He coached seven All-Americans, including two NCAA Division II Players of the Year, eight conference MVPs and seven players who have gone on to play professionally, including one in the WNBA.

A 1995 honors graduate of Wayland Baptist, Schneider was a four-year letterman in men's basketball for the Pioneers and the school's first-ever Academic All-American, capturing the honor three times.

Schneider was raised in a coaching family. His father, Bob, was a member of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2022 following a 40-year coaching career at the high school and collegiate levels. Bob Schneider was one of the most successful women's coaches at the NCAA Division II level, having served as the head coach at West Texas A&M from 1981-2006. They became the first father/son combination to take teams to the Elite Eight. In addition, Schneider's brother, Brett, is currently the head women's basketball coach at Frank Phillips College in Borger, Texas.

Schneider and his wife Ali, have two sons, Cash and Cole.
