### TIPOFF

• Big 12 Conference play begins on New Year's Eve as the No. 22 Kansas Jayhawks head to Stillwater, Oklahoma, to face the Oklahoma State Cowgirls on Saturday afternoon at Gallagher-Iba Arena.

• Tipoff is set for 4 p.m. CT and the game will be televised on Big 12 NOW, with Mike Wolfe and Latricia Trammell on the call. Jayhawk fans can also listen to the game on the Jayhawk Radio Network from Learfield, with Steven Davis calling the action.

• Kansas returns to action for the first time since suffering its first defeat of the season, an 85-79 setback in triple overtime at Nebraska on Dec. 21. The Jayhawks are now 10-1 on the year after putting together the fourth 10-0 start in program history.

• The Jayhawks remain in both national polls for the third-consecutive week, checking in at No. 22 in the Associated Press Top 25 and No. 25 in the USA Today Coaches Poll. The Jayhawks moved into the rankings on Dec. 12 for the first time since 2013, entering at No. 22 in the AP poll and No. 24 in the coaches poll.

• Kansas is led by senior center Taiyanna Jackson, who recorded her seventh double-double in 11 games with 18 points and a career-high 21 rebounds at Nebraska. Jackson leads the Big 12 in rebounding (11.5) and field goal percentage (66.4), ranks second in blocked shots (29) and fourth in scoring (15.8). She is currently seventh on KU's all-time blocks list with 124, two shy of earning a spot in the top five.

• Oklahoma State finished non-conference play with a record of 10-2 after defeating Air force 62-44 on Dec. 20. The Cowgirls have won four straight games and six of their last seven heading into Saturday's Big 12 Conference opener.

• Kansas has faced Oklahoma State 78 times in program history, with OSU leading the all-time series 41-37. Last season, KU swept the season series with OSU for the first time since 1996 by earning a 68-54 victory in Stillwater followed by a 65-56 victory in Lawrence. The Jayhawks are 14-18 all-time in Stillwater following last year's win, which was KU's first at Gallagher-Iba Arena since 2012.

### KANSAS NOTES

• Senior guard Zakiyah Franklin set a new career-high with 27 points in KU's triple overtime contest at Nebraska. That game came on the heels of Franklin being the first Jayhawk since 2019 to be named Big 12 Player of the Week on Dec. 19 after matching her previous career-high with 26 points in KU's 81-62 win over Tulsa. Franklin is second on the team in scoring, averaging 15.7 points per game for the season and she's scored 10 or more points in eight-straight games.

• Kansas got double-doubles from Jackson and senior guard Holly Kersgieter at Nebraska. Jackson got her Big 12-leading seventh double-double with 18 points and a career-high 21 rebounds. Kersgieter had 12 points and 11 rebounds for her second of the year.

• Since the formation of the Big 12 Conference for the 1996-97 season, Kansas is 7-19 in its conference opener. The Jayhawks are 1-6 in Big 12 openers under coach Brandon Schneider, with the last conference-opening win coming over Oklahoma, 74-64, on Dec. 10, 2020.

### UP NEXT

• Kansas returns to Allen Fieldhouse for the first game of 2023 as the Jayhawks host Texas Tech on Wednesday, Jan. 4, in the first of two consecutive Big 12 home games for the Jayhawks. That game will tip off at 7 p.m. CT and be broadcast on Big 12 NOW.

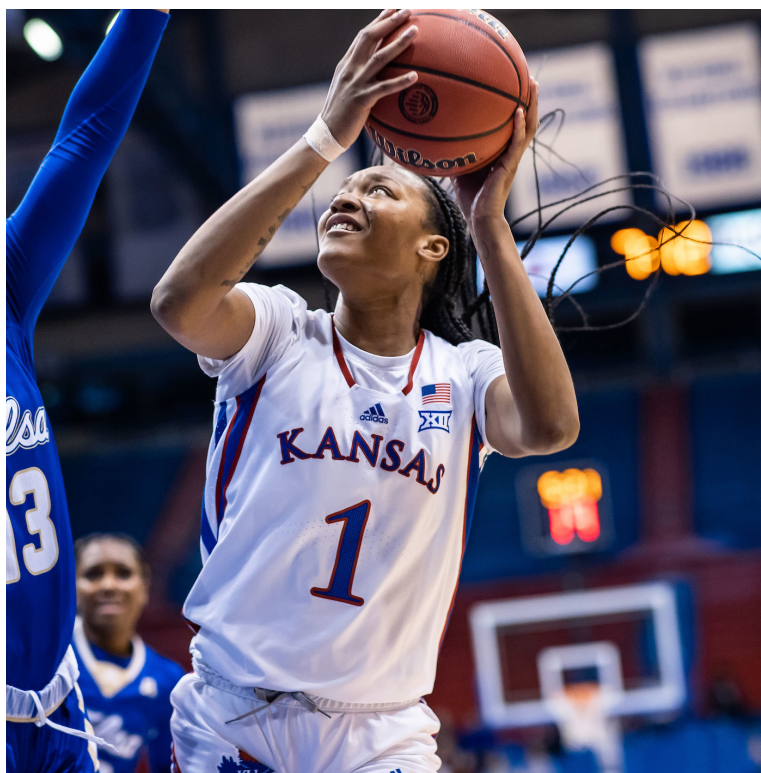

Senior center **Taiyanna Jackson** recorded her seventh double-double of the season and her 11th as a Jayhawk after scoring 18 points with a career-high 21 rebounds at Nebraska. Jackson became the first Jayhawk with 20+ rebounds in a game since Chelsea Gardner in 2015 against West Virginia.



Senior guard **Zakiah Franklin** was named Big 12 Player of the Week on Dec. 19, after matching her then-career-high with 26 points in KU's win over Tulsa. She followed that performance with a career-high 27 points while playing 54 minutes in the Jayhawks triple overtime game at Nebraska.

## ABOUT THE JAYHAWKS

• Kansas is 10-1 on the year and outscoring opponents by 20.2 points per game following its first defeat of the season, an 85-79 setback at Nebraska in triple overtime on Dec. 21. The loss snapped a 10-0 start to the season, which included a streak of seven-straight KU wins by 20 or more points, which was the longest such streak by the Jayhawks since the 1980-81 season. Opponents are averaging 56.5 points per game against the Jayhawks this season.

• The Jayhawks returned four starters from 2021-22, including Preseason All-Big 12 selections Holly Kersgieter, Zakayah Franklin and Taiyanna Jackson.

• Jackson recorded her seventh double-double of the season with 18 points and a career-high 21 rebounds at Nebraska. With that performance, she became the first Jayhawk with 20+ rebounds since Chelsea Gardner in 2015. She currently leads the Jayhawks in scoring (15.8), rebounding (11.5), blocked shots (29) and field goal percentage (66.4). Last season, she was the first-ever Jayhawk selected to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team after setting a new single-season school record with 95 blocked shots. Earlier this season, Jackson recorded her 100th career block and she's currently in 7th on KU's all-time list with 124 blocks as a Jayhawk.

• Franklin again played the leading role offensively for KU at Nebraska, setting a new

career-high with 27 points while also recording five rebounds, two assists and two steals. The Lakeland, Florida, native has scored 10 or more points in eight-straight games, upping her scoring average to 15.7 points per game for the year. On Dec. 19, Franklin was named the Big 12 Player of the Week, becoming the first Jayhawk since November 2019 to earn the award. Earlier this season, Franklin became the 31st player in program history to reach the 1,000-point milestone as a Jayhawk and she has moved to 25th on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,145 career points.

• Kersgieter returned to the lineup at Nebraska after missing the Tulsa game due to illness and she recorded her second double-double of the season with 12 points and 11 rebounds. The Sand Springs, Oklahoma, native is third on the team in both scoring (13.6) and rebounding (6.6) while leading the team with 17 made three-pointers. An All-Big 12 First Team selection last season, Kersgieter has climbed to No. 20 on KU's career scoring list with 1,239 points and sixth in career three-pointers made with 161.

• Wyvette Mayberry has had the largest impact of KU's newcomers this season. The junior transfer from Tulsa is averaging 9.3 points and 2.9 rebounds per game while ranking fourth on the team with 15 steals and 24 assists. Mayberry started 44 games over two years at Tulsa and was an All-Conference Second Team selection in

2021-22 after leading TU in scoring at 14.1 points per game.

• Chandler Prater has scored 10 or more points six times this season and she matched her career-high with 10 rebounds at Nebraska. She's now fourth on the team with an average of 9.4 points per game this season and she's tied for the team-lead with 24 steals. Prater is also one of KU's top threats from the free throw line, shooting 82.6% (38-46) from the stripe, which included 19-of-19 shooting during a three-game stretch prior to the Nebraska game.

## ABOUT THE OPPONENT

• From Stillwater, Oklahoma, the Cowgirls were picked to finish ninth in the Big 12 Conference this season under first-year head coach Jacie Hoyt. OSU has opened the season with a 10-2 record in non-conference play while averaging 79.0 points per game and outscoring opponents by an average of 17.5 points.

• The Cowgirls are led by Naomie Alnatas, who averages 13.3 points per game as one of four OSU players scoring better than 10 points per contest. Other top scorers include Claire Chastain (12.3), Lexy Keys (10.8) and Lior Garzon (10.5). OSU also has the second-leading rebounder in the Big 12 in Taylen Collins, who averages 9.5 boards per game, trailing only KU's Taiyanna Jackson.



## NATIONAL SIGNING DAY RECAP

- Head Coach Brandon Schneider announced the addition of guards **Laia Conesa** and **S'Mya Nichols** on November 9, the first day of the early signing period.
- Both players will join the Jayhawks as freshmen for the 2023-24 season. Conesa is a 5-10 guard coming to Kansas from Barcelona, Spain, while Nichols is staying close to home and joining the Jayhawks from Overland Park, Kansas.
- Nichols, a five-star prospect and No. 22-ranked prospect in the country by Collegiate Girls Basketball Report, becomes the highest-rated high school prospect signed by Kansas in Schneider's tenure.
- On November 15, Nichols was selected to the 2023 Jersey Mike's Naismith Girls High School Player of the Year Watch List. She's one of 50 prep players throughout the U.S. on the list.

## RECORD-SETTING SEASON

- The Jayhawks reached several milestones during the 2021-22 season, which culminated with a 21-10 record and a trip to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2013.
- The 21 wins in 2021-22 was an improvement of 14 wins over the previous season, which is the largest win improvement in school history.
- KU notched the 22nd 20-win season in program history and first since 2012-13, while entering the postseason with 20 wins for the first time since the 1999-2000 season.

## THE SERIES

- Kansas and Oklahoma State have met 78 times all-time in women's basketball, in a series dating back to 1976. OSU leads the all-time series 41-37.
- KU swept the season series against the Cowgirls last season, winning in Stillwater for the first time since 2012 before capping off the sweep with a 65-56 victory in Lawrence.
- The Jayhawks are 14-18 all-time in Stillwater and coming off the first season-sweep of OSU since the 1995-96 season.

**Brandon Schneider** is in his eighth season at the helm of the Kansas Women's Basketball program. He was named the sixth head coach to lead the Jayhawks on April 20, 2015, and he signed a new four-year contract on March 9, 2022, that will keep him in Lawrence through the 2025-26 season.

Schneider guided the Jayhawks to a breakthrough campaign in 2021-22. Kansas finished the season with a record of 21-10, marking the program's first 20-win season since 2012-13, and the Jayhawks had 20 wins during the regular season for the first time since 1999-2000. Schneider was named the 2022 Big 12 Coach of the Year after guiding the Jayhawks to a fifth-place finish with 11 conference victories, the most by a KU team since 1999-2000.

Schneider led Kansas to the 2022 NCAA Tournament, earning a No. 8 seed in the Spokane Regional. The Jayhawks defeated No. 9-seed Georgia Tech, 77-58, in the opening round before falling to eventual regional champion Stanford in the second round. The tournament bid was the 14th in program history for the Jayhawks and first since 2013.

During his tenure at Kansas, Schneider has coached eight players who earned All-Big 12 postseason recognition. The Jayhawks have also had two players named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team and one named to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team along with three Big 12 Players of the Week and three Freshman of the Week. Schneider has also coached 30 players who received Academic All-Big 12 recognition, including a program-best seven student-athletes earning a spot on the team in 2022. Additionally, Schneider's program set a new team-record with a 3.44 Team GPA in the 2021 fall semester.

Schneider increased the Jayhawks win total in each of his first five seasons in Lawrence, which culminated with a 15-14 record in 2019-20. That year, the Jayhawks finished with a winning record for the first time in seven seasons and were set to play in a postseason tournament prior to the COVID-19 pandemic cancelling the Big 12 Tournament and beyond.

Prior to Kansas, Schneider had a five-year stint at Stephen F. Austin, where he returned SFA to the top of the Southland Conference. Schneider guided SFA to three 20-win seasons and the Ladyjacks won back-to-back league titles in 2013-14 and 2014-15. SFA made three postseason appearances under

Schneider, including the WNIT in 2015 after he was named the Southland Conference Coach of the Year. As head coach at Stephen F. Austin, Schneider was 95-66 overall in five years and 57-29 in Southland Conference play.

Schneider was named head coach of the Ladyjacks on April 20, 2010. Recognized as one of the top names at the NCAA Division II level, Schneider went to Nacogdoches after a highly successful 12-year stint at Emporia State.

The Canyon, Texas native is the second all-time winningest head coach at the NCAA Division II level. At Emporia State, Schneider guided the Lady Hornets to a 306-72 (.810) record, and the 2010 NCAA Division II National Championship. The school's all-time leader in wins and winning percentage, Schneider ranks among the all-time top 10 in fastest coaches to 100 victories, and third fastest among women's basketball coaches.

Schneider spent 12 seasons at ESU guiding the Lady Hornets to 11 NCAA Tournament appearances. During that stretch, Schneider's teams recorded two 30-win seasons and nine 20-win campaigns. Along with the 2010 national championship, Schneider coached ESU to four NCAA Division II South Central Regional titles, two Final Four appearances, six regular-season conference crowns and three league tournament titles.

Schneider was the first MIAA rookie head coach to win both the MIAA regular-season and tournament titles. In 2006, the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association of four-year colleges voted Schneider as its coach of the year. He was also a three-time MIAA Coach of the Year.

The 2010 Bulletin Women's Basketball National Coach of the Year and the WBCA South Central Region Coach of the Year, Schneider's players have reaped the rewards of his guidance. He coached seven All-Americans, including two NCAA Division II Players of the Year, eight conference MVPs and seven players who have gone on to play professionally, including one in the WNBA.

A 1995 honors graduate of Wayland Baptist, Schneider was a four-year letterman in men's basketball for the Pioneers and the school's first-ever Academic All-American, capturing the honor three times.

Schneider was raised in a coaching family. His father, Bob, was a member of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2022 following a 40-year coaching career at the high school and collegiate levels. Bob Schneider was one of the most successful women's coaches at the NCAA Division II level, having served as the head coach at West Texas A&M from 1981-2006. They became the first father/son combination to take teams to the Elite Eight. In addition, Schneider's brother, Brett, is currently the head women's basketball coach at Frank Phillips College in Borger, Texas.

Schneider and his wife Ali, have two sons, Cash and Cole.
